T-Mobile, Sprint say \$26b deal would give US tech lead over China

T-Mobile US Inc and Sprint Corp said on Sunday they had agreed to a \$26 billion all-stock deal and believed they could win over skeptical regulators because the merger would create thousands of jobs and help the United States beat China to creating the next generation mobile network.

The agreement capped four years of on-and-off talks between the third and fourth largest US wireless carriers, setting the stage for the creation of a company with 127 million customers that will be a more formidable competitor to the top two wireless players, Verizon Communications Inc and AT&T Inc.

lenged in court AT&T's \$85 billion deal to buy US media company Time Warner Inc, are expected to grill Sprint and T-Mobile on how they will price their combined wireless offerings.

Verizon has 116 million US wireless customers, according to a spokesman, customers, as of the first quarter.

Their first round of merger talks ended unsuccessfully in 2014 after the administration of then-US President Barack Obama expressed antitrust concerns.

The new deal will create the highestcapacity US network, lower prices, create jobs and improve service in rural areas, said John Legere, the chief executive of T-Mobile and the new head of the proposed combined company.

The combined company, which will be called T-Mobile, will invest \$40 billion over the next three years to upgrade its networks to accommodate the next generation 5G wireless technology, which is expected to have the speeds necessary to power drones and self-US regulators, who have chal- driving cars, Legere said in a statement.

"This isn't a case of going from four to three wireless companies - there are now at least seven or eight big competitors in this converging market," Legere said, referring to cable companies as wireless competitors. Other companies also would be forced to accelerate their investments in the face of a combined T-Mobile-Sprint, the companies added.

A spokeswoman for Federal Communications Commission Chairman Ajit Pai declined to comment on Sunday on the proposed merger. Large-cap shares drag Dhaka stocks down

"The quarterly earnings of some listed companies have hurt investors' expectation, leading some of them to reshuffle portfolio," said Md Moniruzzaman, managing director of IDLC Investments.

He, however, said there is nothing to worry because many companies saw a rise in their earnings too. "So, the market will revive very soon."

Market insiders said the DSEX was pulled down by the huge sell pressure of ACI shares. In the January to March quarter, consolidated EPS of ACI was down shares of the textile sector rose 0.14 percent. 72.09 percent year-on-year to Tk 0.96.

In fact, it had been in the declining mood in the previous quarter as well, when the EPS fell 29.18 percent year-onyear to Tk 3.44.

"Overall, the quarterly earnings of the listed companies are not that bad. But at the time of earnings declaration, the index normally remains downturn," said Mir Ariful Islam, head of research of Prime Finance Asset Management Company.

Yesterday, the market started the day on a negative note, which continued until the end as investors remained cautious and adopted the wait-and-see approach, said EBL Securities in its daily market review.

The review said earnings declarations from several listed companies failed to meet investors' expectation.

Of the traded issues, 73 advanced, 227 declined and 37 closed unchanged.

Beximco dominated the turnover chart with its 1.53 crore shares worth Tk 48.54 crore changing hands, followed by Brac Bank, Square Pharma, Navana CNG and United Power Generation. Among the major sectors, banking dropped 1.7 percent, pharmaceuticals 1.47 percent and engineering 1 percent. Conversely, the

Queen South Textile was the day's best performer with a 9.97 percent gain, followed by Navana CNG, Miracle Industries, and Western Marine Shipyard. Bank Asia was the worst loser, shedding 12.44 percent.

As yesterday was the first trading day for the private bank after the record date of dividend declaration, there was no cap on how much it can go up or down.

Other major losers include Sonargaon Textile, Tosrifa Industries, Premier Leasing, Aramit Cement and ACI. Chittagong stocks also fell yesterday as the bourse's key index, CSCX, shed 138.37 points or 1.3 percent to finish at 10,697.73.

"The young generation pays tax willingly and their age limit is about 40 years. I think I will provide tax cards to all taxpayers. The higher taxpayers will get a tax card of a different colour," he said.

The minister said he plans to bring a good reform in the tax system on the basis of the young taxpayers. On tax evasion, the finance

minister said it happened not only in Bangladesh but also around the world. But the number of people evading tax is high in Bangladesh.

He also hinted at reviewing the interest rate of savings certificates as there was a big gap between bank deposit rates and that of savings certificates. At present, savings certificates offer an average interest rate of 12 percent while the bank deposit rate is 5.18 percent.

"Normally the savings certificate interest is one percentage point higher or slightly more than the bank deposit rate. But this time the difference is very large," he said, blaming the sudden liquidity crisis in banks for the gap.

The minister said the government was putting emphasis on large infrastructure projects, including those in the power sector.

About China Harbour Engineering Company Ltd, Muhith said the government debarred the company from the Dhaka-Sylhet four-lane construction project for corruption. The company was engaged in corruption on getting the contract, he said.

The minister, however, said, "Though we have debarred China Habour from the Dhaka-Sylhet highway project, we could not debar it from other projects due to engagement of many parties."

On investment, he said investments were still dependent on the banking system which was wrong.

He put emphasis on the capital market for investment as currently no specialised bank for investment existed in Bangladesh.

The DCCI president placed a budget proposal before Muhith, saying, "Our investment to GDP ratio needs to be increased from existing 29 percent to nearly 35 percent to accelerate development."

Liquefied natural gas is a shortterm solution for meeting energy needs and its price must be fixed keeping in mind the competitiveness of industries and businesses, he said.

"We have settled hundreds of disputes from the BGMEA arbitration cell over the years," Rahman said, adding that the workers themselves have been going to the labour courts for resolving disputes.

However, the BILS in its survey did not mention how many dispute cases were settled either by the BGMEA arbitration cell or by the labour courts, he said. The BILS also did not mention how

much money was realised by the arbitration cell and by the labour courts so far to settle the disputes in the garment sector. The Department of Labour, which is responsible for industrial dispute resolu-

tion, cannot act independently for different reasons, said Syed Sultan Uddin Ahmed, executive director of BILS. In many cases, workers are not aware of

the dispute mechanism or they do not know where to go for settling disputes. He acknowledged the efficacy of the

BGMEA arbitration cell. "But it has been settling disputes at the

individual level and not at the national level. Besides, dispute mechanism in the BGMEA arbitration cell despite being well recognised has no legal base." Subsequently, he called for making the

labour directorate effective such that workers of all industries can turn to for dispute resolution.
