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added. A solution to reduce its adversity can be making the provisions in question including 25 and 28 of the proposed bill "non-cognisable", he said while presenting a paper. If a provision is non-cognisable, police would not be able to arrest any person without a court order.

Also, it has to be made sure that no one would be able to file a case without government permission, he said.

"A safety net is required for all,

including journalists," he added. Tanjib further said the govern-

ment declared to abolish section 57 of the Information and Communication Technology Act but its essence has been merged in some provisions of the proposed digital security bill.

The government on several occasions said section 57 of the ICT Act would be removed. The section deals with defamation, hurting religious sentiments, causing deterioration of law and order and instigation against any person or organisation through publishing or transmitting any material on websites or in electronic form.

It stipulates maximum 14 years in prison for the offences.

The digital security bill, 2018 splits these offences into four separate sections (21, 25, 28 and 29) with punishment ranging from three to 10 years in prison.

Bhorer Kagoj Editor Syamal Dutta moderated the discussion while CJA Bangladesh chapter Vice President Abdur Rahman Khan presided over it.

MRDI Executive Director Hasibur Rahman also spoke.

# Road crashes kill 14

At least 14 people were killed and seven others injured in road accidents in last two days.

In Dhaka, two persons were killed as their motorbike overturned in Hatirjheel area early Tuesday, reports UNB.

The dead were Hedayet Ullah, 25, and his friend Habibullah, 24, of Gazipur.

In Jhenidah, four people were killed and five others injured yesterday when a truck hit an auto-rickshaw at Maidia on Dhaka-Khulna highway, UNB added. The dead were Aslam, 40, Kamal, 35, Mahbub, and one Hazera Khatun.

In Rajbari, two youths were killed when a truck ran over their motorbike in Kalukhali upazila on Tuesday. The victims were Roki Islam, 17, and Tuhin Mondal, 19.

Four people were killed and two others were injured when a Mymensingh-bound bus crashed into a stationary truck on Dhaka-Mymensingh highway yesterday. One of the dead was a bus helper while three others were passengers.

In Chittagong, a youth was killed when a pick-up van knocked him down on Dhaka-Chittagong highway in Sitakunda upazila early yesterday. The deceased was Robiul Islam, 25, of Chittagong.

In Tangail, truck helper Mannan, 23, was killed as a truck ran him over in Basail upazila yesterday.
