



## AAA holds 17th AGM and Election 2018

The election of the Executive Council of American Alumni Association of Bangladesh (AAA) for the term 2018-20 was held on April 28, 2018. The Association has elected Nusrat Feroz Aman, CEO of Ayat Skills, Director of Aman Group and Board Member of Presidency University, as its first female President. Arefeen Syed, Actor and Director of Ganges Group, and Rita Lohani, Country Director of Institute for Sustainable Communities were elected as the Secretary and Treasurer respectively. 
## ULAB and BRACU jointly organise seminar on RMG sector governance

Center for Enterprise and Society (CES) of University of Liberal Arts Bangladesh (ULAB) in conjunction with Economics and Social Sciences (ESS) Department of BRAC University (BRACU) organised a seminar titled "Governance after Rana Plaza: Reviewing the Ready-made Garments Sector after the Rana Plaza Disaster" at the ULAB Auditorium on April 23, 2018.

The seminar started with a presentation on research findings by Dr. Kazi Mahmudur Rahman, Associate Professor, ULAB, and Dr. Shahidur Rahman, Associate Professor, BRACU. The research focused on the state of the RMG sector with respect to labour safety and working conditions and progress made since Rana Plaza.

## CMED Health from UIU AIMS Lab wins Seedstar Innovation Prize in Switzerland

CMED Health, the Dhaka-based preventive healthcare startup, has won the Innovation Prize by TAG Heuer at Seedstars Summit 2018 in Switzerland. This is the first time a startup from Bangladesh has won at a Seedstars competition. CMED Health initiative is a research outcome of Advanced Intelligent Multidisciplinary Systems Lab (AIMS Lab) of United International University (UIU), which is a great example of research commercialisation from academia to industry in Bangladesh.

"We are selected as the most innovative and revolutionary startup in line with how revolutionary TAG Heuer has been on the worldwide watch-making sector. This is a glorious moment for both CMED and Bangladesh," said Dr. Khondaker Abdullah Al Mamun, Founder and CEO of CMED in a statement. As the winner of Innovation Prize, CMED will receive a USD 50,000 equity investment from Seedstars World and join their growth programme.

Seedstars World runs the world's largest seed-stage startup competition in over 66 countries to source top talent and provide them with value added service such as mentoring, networking, and access to funding. This year, 66 innovative startups from 66 countries participated in the Global Summit from April 9-12 in Lausanne, Switzerland. CMED was selected among the top 12 startups and finally won the top innovation prize.
