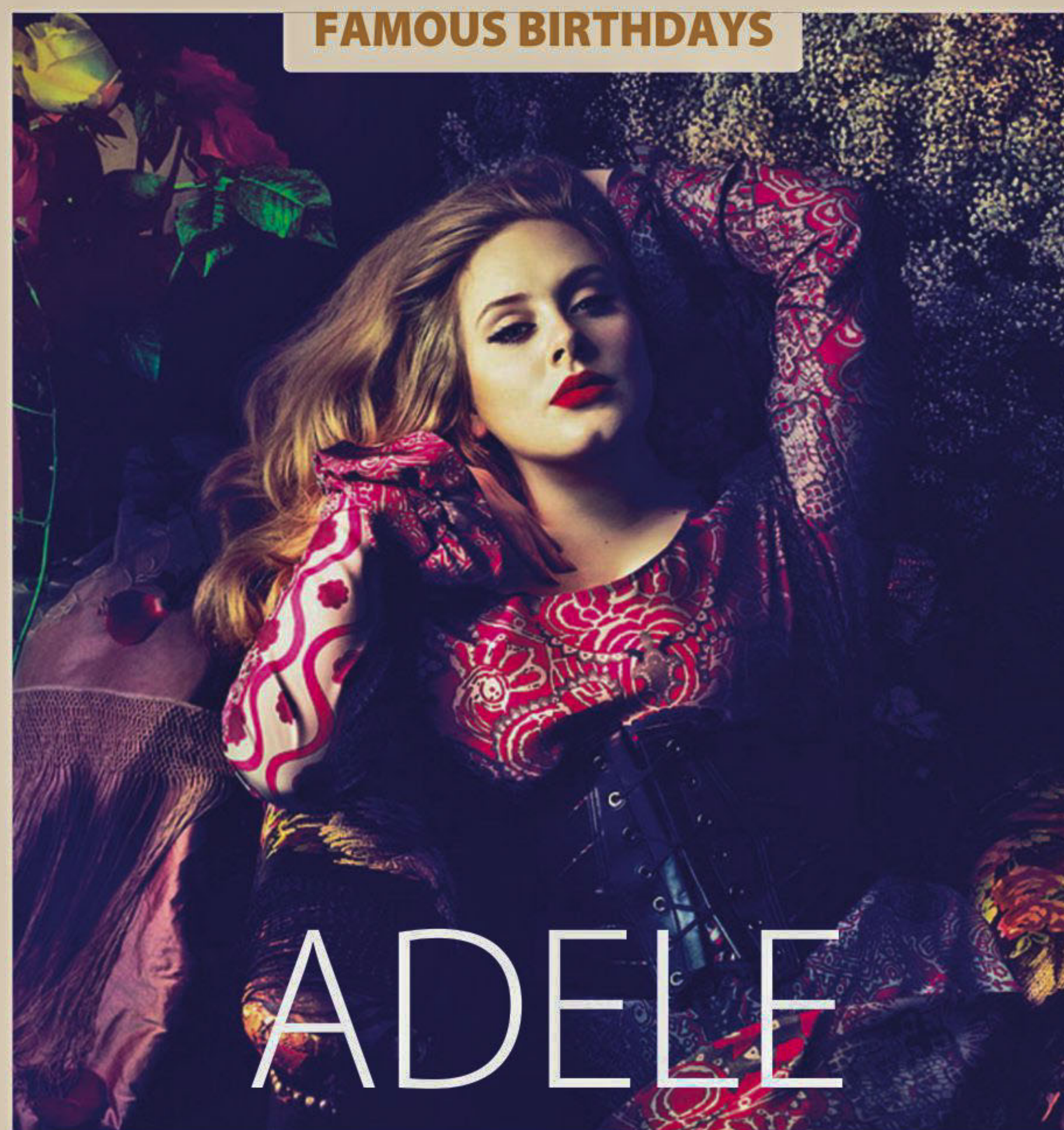


Superman in 'Mission: Impossible'?
