However, they will face a stern test from Cristiano Ronaldo's (R) Real Madrid, who will be hoping to inflict a defeat on their archrivals to stop them from taking another step towards La Liga's first unbeaten season.

'We won't give them a guard of honour'

Real Madrid will not give La Liga champions Barcelona a guard of honour when the sides meet in El Clasico, coach Zinedine LaLiga Zidane said on Saturday.

Barcelona wrapped up the title last weekend and face European champions Real on Sunday.

"After the Club World Cup they didn't want to do it for us," Zidane told a news conference. "They might have said they didn't do it because they weren't in the

competition, but that's not true. You've got to win the Champions League to play in it and we're both in the Champions League. "It's not up to me to decide about the

guard of honour but they didn't do it. We, with respect, won't do it for them because they didn't. "We respect what Barca have done in

winning the league, which for me is the most difficult and nicest thing you can do. But these things happen; if they'd have given us one, we weren't going to break the tradition of doing so."

The incident Zidane was referring to

happened before the Clasico on Dec. 23 when, having returned from the United Arab Emirates as Club World Cup winners, Barcelona elected not to give Real a guard of honour as is traditional in Spain. Barca won

Real, third in the table, secured their place in this month's Champions League final on Tuesday and are aiming to win the trophy for the third year in a row but Zidane is planning to name a full-strength side against Barcelona.

"While the game won't change the league positions, we still want to play well

and do everything we can to win," he said. "If there's players who still feel knocks, they won't play, but we've got a lot of options to replace them. (Raphael) Varane and Isco should be fine to travel."

Sunday's meeting will be the final time Barca midfielder Andres Iniesta plays in the fixture having announced he will leave the Catalans at the end of the season.

"He's a player we admire, not just any other player, and we all know how he is as a person," Zidane said. "We'll shake his hand, congratulate him and wish him luck for the future."

Wenger's last ride at Emirates

Arsene Wenger will bid farewell to a stadium he helped to build in more ways than one when he leads Arsenal at the Emirates for the final time at

home to Burnley on Sunday. Wenger's final season after 22 years in charge is destined

to end in disappointment after Thursday's Europa League semi-final exit to Atletico Madrid. Sixth-placed Arsenal are already out of the running for a top-four finish, and could even finish below their visitors this weekend in seventh with a poor return from Wenger's final three games in charge. Tributes will be paid to the Frenchman at full-time on

Sunday with Arsenal's players even embarking on an end of season lap of honour. Once again, though, it will be a parade without a trophy as it often has been since Arsenal moved to the Emirates in 2006. The success Wenger produced in his first decade at the

Premier League triumph in 2003/04, created the demand to move to a 60,000-capacity stadium from Highbury. However, whilst the Emirates was intended to give Arsenal the financial resources in the long term to compete

club, winning two doubles and 'The Invincibles' unbeaten

with not just England's, but Europe's elite, it significantly hampered Wenger's ability to challenge in the short term. Wenger claimed it was his commitment to remain with the club that helped to secure bank loans needed to build the sta-

dium. He was so tied to the move, Wenger even helped in the design of some parts of the stadium such as the dressing rooms. "In 2006 the most difficult period of my life started. We had restricted finances, we had to pay back a huge amount

of money and we had to sell our best players," Wenger told BT Sport ahead of last season's FA Cup final. "That was, for me, the biggest period of pressure between 2006 and 2014. If you told me today I'd do that again I would say 'no thank you, I'll leave that to someone else." By the time Arsenal were ready to join in the arms race in the

last four years, the Gunners were playing catch up and Wenger too far stuck in his ways to enact the change that was needed.

Palace condemn Stoke

Stoke City were relegated from the League Premier League after crashing to a 2-

1 defeat against Crystal Palace on Saturday. Paul Lambert's side are second bottom, three points from safety, with only one game remaining.

With fourth-bottom Swansea and thirdbottom Southampton playing each other in midweek, it is impossible for Stoke to collect enough points to avoid slipping into the Championship.

Stoke have spent 10 seasons in the Premier League, but a run of 13 games without a victory ensured that streak will come to an end.

Stoke goalkeeper Jack Butland was in tears at the final whistle and City fans were just as emotional as the realisation of their

rassing FA Cup third round defeat against fourth tier Coventry.

The Potters won their first match with Lambert in charge against Huddersfield, but that was a false dawn as they remained deep in trouble for the rest of the season.

Hughes could suffer the indignity of


