

ALL SCORERS TO FEATURE ON FA CUP FINAL BALL

The names of 137 goalscorers from this season's FA Cup campaign will feature on the ball that will be used for Saturday's final between Manchester United and Chelsea on Saturday, the English Football Association (FA) said on Tuesday. United playmaker Alexis Sanchez and Chelsea winger Willian are among the names to be included as part of the FA's 'Ball for All' initiative to celebrate players from different divisions across the country that took part this season - the 137th edition of the competition. "Over 3,000 goals have been scored in this season's competition, from all levels of the football pyramid," FA's director of professional game relations Andy Ambler has said. "The 137 goalscorers from across the country are representative of all who have contributed to this season's competition." Liam Pullen, a player for Chipping Sodbury Town, scored the National League Step 6 side's first ever FA Cup goal this season and has also been named on the ball, which he will present ahead of kickoff at Wembley on Saturday. — REUTERS

NEUER IN, GOETZE OUT

Injured Manuel Neuer was named in Germany's extended 27-man World Cup squad on Tuesday, but there was no place for Brazil 2014 winner Mario Goetze.

Neuer, Germany's captain and goalkeeper, has not played since September and still has to prove his fitness at a fortnight-long training camp in northern Italy, which starts next week.

The 32-year-old Bayern Munich star is one of four goalkeepers named by head coach Joachim Loew, who will have to cut four names when the final 23-man squad is submitted for the World Cup finals, which start on June 14 in Russia.

"Manuel is getting back into full training this week at Bayern Munich, that assures us that he can tolerate the full load in the training camp," explained Loew.

"Then we want to get a full idea, talk to him frankly and honestly, asking 'is it possible to play at the World Cup?'"

There is no place in Loew's squad for Goetze, who scored the winning goal in the 2014 World Cup finals, after an erratic season at Borussia Dortmund.

However, Loew pulled a surprise by handing a first call-up to Freiburg striker Nils Petersen, 29, the topscoring German in the Bundesliga this season with 15 goals.

Yet there is no place for striker Sandro Wagner, Robert Lewandowski's back-up at Bayern Munich, who helped

Germany win the Conferderations Cup in Russia last year.

Loew has also selected Mesut Ozil and Ilkay Gundogan despite the pair landing in hot water with the German FA over the weekend after the Premier League stars posed for pictures with Turkey President Recep Tayyip Erdogan.

Ozil is in the squad despite suffering from a back injury while Bayern Munich defender Jerome Boateng has also been called up even though he is currently sidelined by a groin injury.

Germany open their Russia 2018 campaign against Mexico in Moscow on June 17, the defending champions also facing South Korea and Sweden in Group F.

ARGENTINA INCLUDE ICARDI, DYBALA

Inter Milan striker Mauro Icardi and Juventus playmaker Paulo Dybala were given a World Cup boost after being included in a 35-man pre-selection squad for Russia 2018 on Monday.

Argentina coach Jorge Sampaoli included most of his big stars including Lionel Messi, Sergio Aguero and Angel Di Maria and will whittle his choice down to 23 names for May 21 when he will officially announce his 23-man travelling party.

Argentina are in Group B, which includes Iceland, Nigeria and Croatia.

LOEW EXTENDS **CONTRACT UNTIL 2022**

Joachim Loew has extended his contract as Germany head coach until

2022, the German FA (DFB) announced on Tuesday.

In the post since 2006, Loew, 58, who steered Germany to their 2014 World Cup triumph, has signed a two-year extension to take him through to the 2022 World Cup in Qatar.

NO COENTRAO, RENATO IN PORTUGAL SQUAD

Fabio Coentrao and Renato Sanches were missing from Portugal's 35strong pre-World Cup squad named Tuesday by coach Fernando Santos.

The squad, which will be cut to 23 before the June 14-July 15 tournament in Russia, included Real Madrid star Cristiano Ronaldo and other mainstays of the team that won Euro 2016, such as Pepe, William Carvalho, Joao Moutinho, Nani and Ricardo Quaresma.

Sanches, who became the youngest player to lift the Euro title, has endured a disappointing season, the 20-year-old loaned to Swansea, who were relegated from the English Premier League, from Bayern Munich.

Coentrao, one of the revelations of the 2010 World Cup in South Africa and currently on loan at Sporting from Real Madrid, had ruled himself out of selection on Monday, saying he had had an "exhausting" season.

Portugal will face Spain, Morocco and Iran in Group B, and will play warm-up matches against Tunisia, Belgium and Algeria.

China or Japan for Iniesta?

The Spanish midfielder added: "Next week, when everything is over, we'll decide. Then, there's the World Cup, I want to get this resolved so that I can focus. "One option is more

New Italy coach Roberto Mancini on Tuesday said he wanted to restore pride in the national side six months after their shock failure to qualify for the World Cup.

"Not going to the World Cup is difficult for those who, like us, have always been cheering for the national team," Mancini

told a press conference at the national training centre at Coverciano, near Florence. "I feel the need to do something for the national team and think it's the right time for me. I want to build something for the years to

come and bring Italy back to the top." Italy have been without a permanent coach since Gian Piero Ventura was sacked after the four-time world champions failed to qualify for the World Cup for the first time since 1958.

Former Manchester City and Inter Milan coach Mancini signed a two-year deal on

His first match in charge will be a friendly on May 28 against Saudi Arabia in Switzerland.

Mancini said there would be "room for everyone" in his squad and that he planned to recall in-form Nice striker Mario Balotelli, whom he coached at Inter and Manchester City.

Balotelli has not played for his country since the 2014 World Cup. "Even in difficult times, Italy can boast of

having players of great quality. I will certainly also speak with Balotelli," said Mancini. "He's a player that we want to see at the

level he had during the Euro (2012 when Italy reached the final)." He also said he would talk to recently retired Italy great Andrea Pirlo about joining

his coaching setup. In Mancini, Italy have a coach with a solid track record as a title-winner, with 13 trophies in club football.

He led Manchester City to their first English league title in 44 years in 2012, and won three Serie A crowns with Inter. He also won the Italian Cup with Inter, Fiorentina and Lazio.

The contract, reportedly worth two million euros (\$2.3 million) a year, will see Mancini lead Italy's bid to qualify for Euro 2020. If successful, it will be automatically extended until June 2022, ahead of the World Cup in Qatar.

The Italian federation had been looking for a prestigious coach to rebuild an Azzurri side decimated after their play-off defeat to Sweden in the San Siro last November.

Mancini will give up a reported 13 million euros in wages over the two remaining years on his Zenit contract to do national service.

"Mancini gave up significant financial opportunities to do so. This is testimony to his complete determination and desire to take on this job," said Italian FA commissioner Roberto Fabbricini.

Since leaving England in 2013, Mancini coached Galatasaray, whom he lead to a Turkish Cup success, and returned to Inter before joining Zenit last June.

But this will be his first international coaching job.

"I don't know if this will be my most difficult challenge, if you coach a club and you don't win everyone is angry with you, here there are 50 million people.

"That's beautiful too, though, because if you win something important there's huge satisfaction. It's not an easy challenge, but nothing is easy."

Mancini, a former Lazio and Sampdoria forward, never became a regular during a love-hate relationship with Italy over a 10year international career that gleaned just four goals in 36 caps.
