



## Tazin Ahmed passes away

Renowned actor Tazin Ahmed passed away at 4:15 pm yesterday at Regent Hospital due to a cardiac arrest. The news was confirmed by The General Secretary of the Actors' Equity Bangladesh, Ahsan Habib Nasim. The beloved actor was known for making a mark in many fields as a theatre and television actor, journalist, playwright, TV anchor and director in a career that spanned over 15 years. She first came into the limelight with *Adekha Bhubon* in 2004, directed by Humayun Ahmed. For the past two years, she had been hosting *71 er Shokaal* on Ekattor Tv. "I am having a hard time believing this," says veteran actor Mamunur Rashid. "She acted in numerous plays with my theatre group, Aranyak Nattiyadal. I cannot believe she passed away at such a young age." Media personalities including Azizul Hakim, Masum Reza, Rawnak Hasan and Shahana Khushi also expressed their grief on the sudden demise of the actor. Tazin Ahmed's last televised tele-fiction was *Noashal*, directed by Mir Sabbir. The Daily Star family extends its condolences to the family of the departed soul.
