Bera UNO gets show cause notice

All Pabna UNOs asked to carry national flag

The Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) of Bera was served with a show-cause notice by Pabna district administration yesterday after the body of a freedom fighter was covered with a chatai (mat made of bamboo slats) instead of national flag during his funeral with state honour on Saturday.

Meanwhile, after publication of a report titled 'Chatai instead of national flag' in the Daily Star on Tuesday, the district administration yesterday ordered all the UNOs in Pabna to carry national flag in their vehicles while giving state honour to a freedom fighter.

"It is a matter of sorrow as nobody cared before giving the state honour," Pabna Deputy Commissioner (DC) Md Jasim Uddin said, adding that the local adminis-

tration cannot avoid their responsibility regarding the mistake.

A show cause notice was served to Bera UNO as he was present on behalf of the local administration during the funeral of freedom fighter Md Tahez Uddin.

As the legal committee of the Muktijoddha Sangsad is not available everywhere the UNOs are the acting chief of the organisation in upazila level, the DC added.

Earlier, the body of freedom fighter Tahez Uddin of Shambhupur village was covered with a chatai instead of the national flag when he was given state honour in the presence of local administration officials and freedom fighters in Pabna's Bera upazila on Saturday.

Alleged rapist arrested

Police arrested a youth on Saturday on charge of raping a Class V schoolgirl in Chunarughat upazila of Habiganj.

The arrestee is Ujjal Mia, 37, a neighbour of the girl. Chunarughat Police Station OC KM

Ajmiruzzaman said Ujjal was arrested from Rema-Kalenga forest area and is being interrogated.

Ujjal drugged and raped the child on May 2 and May 3, when her parents left for a wetland area in search of work, leaving the girl alone at home, locals said.

The victim suffered severe physical complications, including bleeding, following the abuse.

The victim's father filed a case over the incident on May 16, naming Ujjal as the prime accused.

Vegetable, chicken prices soar in Ramadan

At the start of the holy month of Ramadan, prices of almost all the vegetables and other essentials used for preparing iftar items shot up further at different kitchen markets of the district town.

Many consumers alleged that taking the opportunity of weak market monitoring by the officials concerned, some dishonest traders are charging high prices for the essential items.

As a result, within just two to three days of the beginning of Ramadan, prices of various kinds of vegetables increased by Tk 10 to Tk 30 per kg, which badly hit people especially from low and fixed-income groups.

Mohammad Ali, a vegetable vendor at a Faridpur kitchen market, said brinjal was selling at Tk 80 a kg, although the price was Tk 50 only two days ago.

Besides, green chilli was selling for Tk 60 per kg, which was Tk 30, while bitter gourd was selling for Tk 80 a kg compared to Tk 50 only two days ago.

The prices of cucumber went up by Tk 20 a kg, while ladies finger, papaya and snake gourd prices rose by Tk 10 per kg, compared to the previous two days.

Consumer Nasir Lasker of Kamalpur area in the town said, "It is really tough for low and fixed-income group people to buy vegetables at present market prices compared to the previous days."

Meanwhile, prices of chicken went up by Tk 30 to Tk 100 a kg.

Poultry trader Nur Mia said per kg of Sonali chicken was selling at Tk 280 from Tk 180 while poultry chicken is priced at Tk 150 from Tk 120 only two weeks ago.

District Market Monitoring Officer Sahadat Hossain said the essentials' prices have risen due to higher demand in Ramadan.

Croplands, houses under threat as dyke lies broken

Vast tracts of croplands and many homesteads in three unions under Sadullapur upazila will go under water in the upcoming rainy season as the damaged dyke along the Ghaghat river has not been repaired, villagers said.

Residents of Puran Laxmipur village said surging water of the river washed away parts of the dyke during the flood last year, flooding croplands and dwellings. Fear has gripped farmers that they will face a similar situation in the ensuing rainy season as the dyke has not been repaired.

Local people use the dyke as a

road for communication with other unions and the upazila headquarters. A large number of people from adjoining unions cannot go to their destinations due to breaching of the dyke at different points. Even three-wheelers and motorcycles cannot move on the dyke, so people have to use alternative roads, which is time consuming.

"It was not like this even three years ago, when the dyke could be used for communication and controlling floodwater, but erosion weakened it and big sections were washed away by the surging water

last year," said Suruj Jamal, a farmer of Puran Laxmipur village.

Sayed Ali of the same village said huge areas of Damodpur and Kamarpura unions will be flooded through the breached points and croplands and homesteads will go under water in the upcoming rainy season.

"We appealed to the upazila nirbahi officer and the authorities concerned several times to repair the dyke, but no initiative has been taken from any quarter as yet," said Nurul Islam, a teacher in the village.

Kamarpura Union Parishad Chairman Shamsul Alam said

people of three unions suffered a lot in the last flood, but no measure is being taken to repair the dyke despite repeated appeals to the Water Development Board (WDB).

Gaibandha WDB Executive

Engineer Mahbubur Rahman said they have no plan to repair the dyke in Sadullapur. The World Bank will provide funds next year, he said, adding that repair work will start after they get the allocation.
