On Saturday morning, transport workers went berserk at Axle Load Control Station at Bara Darogar Hat, protesting a driver being "beaten up" by a staff of the station.

The angry workers also put barricade on Chittagong-Dhaka Highway in the area triggering a tailback of around 25 kilometres from Bhatiari union of Sitakunda to Bariar Hat area of Mirasari upazila in Chittagong from 10:30am to 1:30pm, said eye witnesses.

The incident ensued when the staff of the Axle Load Control Station, an institution of Roads and Highway Department (RHD) and operated by a private organisation, allegedly beat up a truck driver Humayun Kabir over "realising extortion".

According to DNC officials, Ishtiaq is wanted in at least 16 cases, Fazlul in 15 separate cases, Nasir in 11 cases, Rahima in 14 cases and Raju in 13 separate cases. The DNC has started a 15-day long special drive to arrest these 37 top drug traders.

Mukul Jyoti Chakma, deputy director (Dhaka Metro) of DNC, said, "We are hopeful that we can arrest them but we often face

difficulties as we have no armed manpower and these yaba traders are armed with guns and ammunition."

Jamal Uddin Ahmed, director general of DNC, said their drive was always on but they have become more vigilant as the PM recently instructed to go tougher against narcotics.

Besides the DNC list, Dhaka Metropolitan Police (DMP) also prepared a list of around 100 top drug dealers of the city to bring them to book as part of the on-going special anti-narcotics drive.

Employment, said 127 countries will attend this year's ILO conference where the Bangladesh government will try to raise its labour-related issues.

Bangladesh has made significant progress in improving workers' condition and emerged as a labour-friendly country, he said. He stressed the need for changing mindset to tackle workplace harassment.


Lawmaker Shirin Akhter said issues of workplace harassment, including those against women workers on public transports, have to be included as agenda in the meeting of related parliamentary committee.

Prabodh Devkota, assistant country director of CARE Bangladesh, said an incident of harassment creates negative impact on the worker and his or her family.

"Commitment from policymakers will be required to tackle workplace harassments," he said.

Bangladesh government needs to focus on implementing different labour-related international conventions which it ratified earlier, said Khondaker Golan Moazzem, research director of Centre for Policy Dialogue.

Jatiya Sramik League President Sukur Mahmud also spoke at the event.
