Meanwhile, Planning Minister AHM Mustafa Kamal yesterday told parliament that as per the latest population census, the country's estimated total population is nearly 15 crore.

The minister said this while responding to a query made by treasury bench lawmaker Bazlul Haq Haroon.

According to the latest Population and Housing Census of 2011, the country's total population is 14,97,72,348, he said. Of them, some 7,49,80,375 are men and the rest are women.

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during the current tenure of her government but no one could raise any significant question against any election.

In another reply, the PM said a second nuclear power plant will be constructed in the country's southern region. "I have already collected photographs of different chars in southern region.... And I asked for more."

She also mentioned various mega projects including construction of an international airport, deep sea port, Asian highway and inclusion in the Trans-Asian Railway.

In a scripted answer, the PM said a huge quantity of illegal drugs, arms and ammunitions were recovered during the anti-narcotics drive going on across the country since May 18.

She said 15,333 cases were filed so far and 20,767 people arrested in drug-related cases. Moreover, 1,289 people were given

jail sentences by mobile courts during the drive, the PM said.

Focusing on different measures taken by her government for women's protection and empowerment, Hasina said it was possible to carry out these development activities as the democratic process is continuing in the country.

She said Bangladesh has been able to make huge progress and women got opportunity in all sectors because of the continuation of the government through the 2014 election.

Replying to Jatiya Party lawmaker Kazi Firoz Rashid (Dhaka-6), Hasina said if her government assumes power through the next election, Bangladesh will become a peaceful, developed and prosperous country in South Asia.

She said her government will turn every village into a town so that people can enjoy urban facilities staying in rural areas.

Later, he became a close associate of Rahmani and used to circulate extremist ideologies. He also founded a publishing house and published Rahmani's extremist lectures and write-ups, the Rab official said.

Ishak distributed the books to different madrasas of the country for free, the official said. "We have also found out that Ishak visited the Rohingya camp in Cox's Bazar a couple of times, distributed several lakh taka there and tried to motivate its residents to join extremism."

Rab also said Ishak's brother Rakib, now in jail, is an active member of Hizb-ut Tahrir.

A terrorism case was filed with Singair Police Station against Ishak, Rab added.

Nurses hurt as plaster falls off

Two nurses of Noakhali General Hospital were injured as plaster came off the ceiling and fell on them on the first floor of the old building yesterday.

The injured are senior staff nurse Swapna Rani Majumder, and student of Noakhali Nursing Institute Rani Akhter. Both were admitted to the hospital.

Swapna was injured in the head and needed eight stitches. The doctor also asked her to have a CT scan. Rani Akhter suffered minor injuries in the hand and hip.

The injured nurses said the incident occurred at ward-8 around 4:00am, when they were taking rest after giving necessary medicines to the patients. It created panic among patients, they said. Earlier, the plaster of the emergency department fell off, leaving a nurse injured.

Superintendent of the 250-bed hospital Dr Md Khalilullah said the three-storey building is old and was declared abandoned more than one year ago, but they are forced to continue treating patients there because new buildings are still under construction.

elected uncontested. They were declared winners unofficially on July 10, the date for finalising the candidate-list.

They are AL-backed Liakat Ali Khan Lavlu of ward 15, Mosharraf Hossain Badsha of ward 16, Gazi Noimul Hossain Litu of ward 19 and BNP-backed Ayesha Touthida Luna of ward 4 (general wards 10, 11 and 12).

BNP's Zakir Hossain Jelal, former councillor of ward 15, alleged that he had to withdraw his nomination paper due to "pressure". He, however, refused to elaborate his claim.

Sumon Haldar Ashish, a BNP-backed councillor candidate in ward 19, also alleged that he was "pressurised by an influential quarter". His nomination paper was later cancelled due to some discrepancies.

Rafikul Alam, secretary of Shujan in Barisal, said, "This trend of being elected uncontested will affect the democratic process."

Echoing him, Advocate Manabendra Batobayal, former president of Sachetan Nagorik Committee, said, "The election has now become a selection process."

Blame game begins

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Liton said Awami League is a large party and they took preparations for the election months in advance.

"This is why it has been possible for our men to cover the city areas with our posters and festoons".

He termed the BNP's allegation of hindering their campaign "baseless".

"BNP men began propaganda against us, instead of campaigning. They resorted to propaganda, being sure of their defeat in the election," Liton said.

Liton handed over his election manifesto among the businessmen.

Other than Liton and Bulbul, three other mayoral candidates and 212 councillor candidates are also participating in the election.

Independent mayor candidate Murad Morshed began his campaign by paying homage to martyrs of the Liberation War.
