On July 6, a nine-year-old boy was stopped at Damdama check post in Cox's Bazar by the BGB, upon receiving information that Rohingya women and children were being used as drug mules.

They searched the child but found nothing initially. It seemed to be another false alarm. That is until they took off his shoes and found an extra sole. Stowed away beneath it were 2,000 pieces of yaba, the crazy medicine.

The child told the BGB men he was given these new shoes and asked to wear them to Cox's Bazar, until he met another

List of drug dealers given to Myanmar

They fled to the neighbouring country amid anti-narcotic drive, BGB says

Bangladesh has handed over a list of drug dealers to Myanmar who fled to the neighbouring country amid the ongoing nationwide anti-narcotic drive.

"We have handed over a list of those criminals to Myanmar and subsequently have negotiations and an understanding to take necessary action against them," said Brig Gen Majibur Rahman, additional director general (operation and training) of Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB).

Rashed 'admits' taking money from Rony

Video clips give new twist to feud between Ctg coaching centre owner and ex-BCL leader

In a new twist in the "feud" between Chittagong-based coaching centre businessman Rashed Mia and former Chhatra League leader Nurul Azim Rony, Rashed has "admitted" that Rony was his business partner.

He also "admitted" that Rony invested in his coaching centre named Uniaid, according to three video clips posted on Rony's Facebook page.

Earlier in April, Rashed filed a case against Rony, claiming that the latter

assaulted him for not paying Tk 20 lakh in extortion money.

The video of the assault went viral on social media on April 19, which led to Rony's resignation from the post of BCL general secretary of Chittagong city unit.

Rony has repeatedly denied that he demanded any extortion money and insisted he only wanted his investment money back from Rashed, who refused to do so.

The latest videos were posted on Rony's Facebook page at 2:53pm on Wednesday. The

Official says Khaleda's legal adviser had 'no valid visa', wanted to 'create problem' between Dhaka, Delhi





Blackmailers behind it

Detectives find after quizzing an accused

Inspector Mamun Islam Khan was killed by a gang of blackmailers, detectives said yesterday.

Quoting suspect Rahmat Ullah, detectives said Mamun was killed on Sunday in a party at a Banani flat where they had gone together.

Rahmat also said he was a friend of Mamun.

At one stage, several other suspects

attempted to blackmail Rahmat by taking revealing pictures of him with some women present at the party, a number of officers told The Daily Star, wishing anonymity.

As Rahmat and Mamun tried to protest, the suspects started to beat them up.

When Mamun revealed that he was a police officer, the suspects beaten him to death, officers said.
