International Islamic University Chittagong: at a Glance

1. Preamble: International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) is one of the top graded government approved private universities in Bangladesh. Having fulfilled the requirements as laid down in the Private University Act of 1992, and after obtaining the necessary clearance from University Grants Commission (UGC) and the permission of Government of Bangladesh (GOB), International Islamic University Chittagong (IIUC) started functioning on February 11, 1995. The credit for the idea of establishing this University goes to Islamic University Chittagong Trust (IUCT).

IIUC framed its own Statutes, Ordinances and Regulations with a view to governing the manifold activities of IIUC i.e. academic, administrative, financial, student welfare, discipline etc. as per the Private University Act, 1992, 1998 and revised Act, 2010. Most statutory bodies were formed under the provisions of the Act.

2. Permanent Campus: Unlike most private Universities in Bangladesh, IIUC is blessed with a beautiful campus situated at Kumira, Chittagong-4318, Bangladesh, surrounded by gentle hills that carry a message of protection and perfection where both Teachers (fulltime ~307) and Students (male-female~ 10,000) get congenial environment to devote themselves to create knowledge. This campus is 22 kms away from the Chittagong city comprising an area of 45 acres of land beside the Chittagong-Dhaka highway. There are about 36 buildings having floor space ~500,000 sft. One unique feature of IIUC is the arrangement of a separate teaching facility for the female students. Currently, about 4000 (four thousand) female students are studying at IIUC in a conducive environment in the Female Academic Zone. The University has a Disciplinary Committee for taking precautions and actions against any sort of unexpected incidents in the campus. It has also established an Anti-Militancy and Anti-Terrorism Cell as per Govt. Act-2016.

3. The Mission, Vision, Objectives and Motto of IIUC:

3.1 The Mission of the University is to produce properly trained manpower to contribute to socio-economic development and moral upliftment of the society and to cultivate expertise among the students as well as sensitivity, intelligence and an ability to think freely beyond their areas of study so that they can sustain justice in all walks of life. 3.2 The Vision of the University is to make this University as the Centre of Excellence in different areas of scholarship, like Shari'ah and Islamic Studies, Business Studies, Social

regardless of race, region and religion. This university cherishes the dream of becoming one of the highest seats of learning and creating knowledge in the South East Asia. 3.3 The objectives of the University: To create a new generation of competent youths, who will be equipped with academic excellence, professional expertise and adorned with

Science, Science & Engineering, Arts & Humanities, Law, and such other faculties that will be introduced in future. Its door is open to the admission seekers from all over the world,

3.4 The Motto of the University is to "Combine Quality with Morality".

4. Morality Development Program (MDP): IIUC incorporates studies on the value of mutual respect and peaceful co-existence in the practical world under the courses of "Morality Development Program (MDP)" which is mandatory for all students

5. Co-Curricular and Extra-curricular activities: IIUC supports student participation in a broad array of Co-Curricular and Extra-curricular activities. These programs mainly include leadership training, cultural, environmental, recreational and social activities, debating and public speaking programs, intellectual discussions, games and sports, excursion and study tours at home and abroad. All Co and Extra-curricular activities are run by 11 clubs of students named after the Departments such as Computer club, Business club, ELLS etc.

6. Academic Guidance and Counseling Service: IIUC provides Academic Guidance and Counseling Service by the Student Academic Advisor of the respective section of students under each Semester. The students' Academic Guidance and Counseling Service is an integral part of the academic programs at IIUC.

7. Programs of Study: International Islamic University Chittagong has been conducting its academic programs at the Bachelor and Master levels under the following six faculties: . Faculty of Shari'ah & Islamic Studies, ii) Faculty of Science & Engineering, iii) Faculty of Business Studies, iv) Faculty of Arts & Humanities, v) Faculty of Law and vi) Faculty of Social Sciences. 8. Number of faculty members: The number of regular faculty is 307 and adjunct faculty is 85 (as on December 31, 2017). Among the regular faculty the number of

Professors is 19, Associate Professors 55, Assistant Professors is 249, Lecturers is 79, Assistant Lecturers is 6, PhD holders is 40 and on Study Leave is 47. At present, teacherstudent ratio at IIUC is 1:25. 9. Number of Graduates of IIUC in the 4th Convocation: The number of graduates of IIUC eligible for the 4th Convocation-2018 is 22,895 (Graduates from 2006 to 2015)

and the number of registered graduates is 2,576. Number of Gold Medalists in the 4th Convocation is 266. Among the 2,576 Registered Graduates of 4th Convocation (2006-20015) about 90% is employed. 10. Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at IIUC: As per the instruction of the University Grants Commission (UGC), Institutional Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was

generating awareness about Outcome Base Education (OBE) at IIUC, the IQAC of IIUC has already arranged more than 40 view- exchange programs and workshops with Teachers, Students and Staff (during April 2017 to June 30, 2018) focusing on creating the culture of Academic Quality Work and the process of Self-Assessment.

11. Center for Research & Publication (CRP): The Center for Research & Publication (CRP) coordinates PhD/higher degree programs for teachers and officers aboard and

annual publication of the following peer reviewed journals: i. IIUC Studies (English). ii. Dirasal al-Jamiah Al-Islamiyyah al Alamiyyah (Arabic). iii. IIUC Business Review (English).

12. IIUC Central Library: IIUC has a fully automated and web-based digital library enriched with about 85,500 books of 15,000 titles, 1,750 journals, and 515 audio-visual materials. Access and download facilities of about 35,000 online journals, 15,500 eBooks, and four million e-Theses are available here. 13. Laboratories: 38 standard labs equipped with instruments from abroad are available for the students of the programs under the Faculty of Science and Engineering.

Besides this, the University has 13 computer laboratories for different programs with internet facilities for the students. 14. Web & IT Facilities: IIUC has a resourceful website (www.iiuc.ac.bd) for its user. Visiting the Websites, the students can have access to all relevant information regarding

registration, payment, academic performance and other relevant information. There are 1,080 computers connected with internet.. It has Wi-Fi connectivity throughout the campus. 15. Membership, recognition and MoU with of prestigious organizations/ universities:

IIUC has membership of prestigious organizations such as:

■ Federation of the Universities of Islamic World (FUIW) under ISESCO and Association of the Commonwealth Universities (ACU).

British Council Satellite Library has been established at IIUC.

Undergraduate programs of CCE, CSE and EEE have been accredited by the Board of Accreditation for Engineering & Technical Education (BAETE).

Pharmacy program has been accredited by Pharmacy Council, Bangladesh.

◆ IIUC has recently entered into an MoU with IEEE and successfully opened an IEEE Students Branch (Male and Female) under the Faculty of Science and Engineering.
