MOTHER-DAUGHTER MURDER CMP quizzes relatives, others

Police yesterday interrogated several persons, including two nephews of 94-year-old Monwara Begum, whose body was found along with her daughter's, Meherunnesa, 64, inside a water reservoir of their residence in Ambagan area of Chittagong city the day before.

No one was arrested yet and the two nephews were released from the police station following interrogation, said Sohel Rana, assistant commissioner (Bayezid zone) of Chittagong Metropolitan Police (CMP).

Family members of the victims speculate that the two might have been killed for their property. Speaking to The Daily Star, Abdul Warish, deputy commis-

sioner (DC north) of CMP, said, "Victim Monwara Begum's son Mostafizur Rahman has filed a case with Khulshi Police Station."

So far, police have held several persons in this connection, added the DC.

STOPPING CHILD MARRIAGE

Family, society pose challenges: Report

Obstacles from families and society are still a big challenge to stop child marriage in some areas of the country, says a project report by Girls Not Brides Bangladesh (GNBB).

Findings of the report were disclosed during a programme organised by GNBB at Brac Centre in the capital.

GNBB, an alliance of development organisations, implemented the two-year project "Power of Youth: We Can Stop Child Marriage" in 10 upazilas -- five each under Barisal and

Rangpur districts -- since 2016. Some 16,306 persons, mostly students and youths, were reached during the project.

Its key objective was to build awareness about negative consequences of child marriage on girls' reproductive health, and eliminate the malpractice through applying

knowledge among the population, said organisers. Some 21 member organisations formed an alliance in Rangpur and stopped 18 child marriages. In Barisal, 21 organisations formed similar alliance and stopped 23 child marriages there, says the report.

Habibur Rahman, head of Gender, Justice and Diversity Programme of Brac, which is the secretariat of GNBB, said the challenges reflected that gender-based discrimination is still prevailing in some societies. He said the youths formed school-based watch groups to

fight child marriage. "However, some of them had to meet secretly because of family obligations," he added.

GNBB National Coordinator Anna Minz also spoke.

May 31, 2016, the tribunal on May 7 in 2017 framed two charges against them.

One incident involved looting and arson in 132 houses, killing of 59 people and rape of six women in Rajnagar upazila between May 7 and 8, 1971, investigators said.

Five remanded for rape, molestation

A Chittagong court yesterday allowed police to remand five youths for three days, on charges of raping a college student and molesting another at the victims' rented house in the port city last week.

Chittagong Metropolitan Magistrate Al Imran Khan approved the remand, after police produced them with a five-day remand prayer, said Nirmalendu Bikash Chakraborty, additional deputy commissioner (prosecution) of Chittagong Metropolitan Police. On July 12, father of the

23-year-old rape victim filed a case with Chawkbazar Police Station accusing six local youths of rape, molestation, and loot.

The five remanded are Mohiuddiun, 22, Saimun Islam Sakib, 22, Asif Iqbal, 25, Rajbir Hossen, 25, and Mossaraf Hossain Akash, 22. Another accused is on the run.

On July 9, six youths broke into a flat in Badurtola where the two women were staying, and raped one of them, molested another and snatched phones, a laptop and money from them.

Youths demand immediate repair of city roads

Hundreds of youths took to the streets in Rajshahi yesterday, demanding immediate repair of damaged roads of the

They said movement on most roads of the city has become difficult due to large potholes while dust on them posed threat to human health.

The youths formed a human chain in front of Rajshahi Railway Station, under the banner of Youth Action for Social Change. They held a rally alongside the human chain with the group's president Shamiul Alim in the lead.

Many auto-rickshaw drivers, transport workers and pedestrians joined the human chain.

Speakers at the rally said the three-kilometre road from Railway Station to Talaimari has been in deplorable condition for over three years.

Although the road repair works started, the contractor was dilly dallying in implementing the works, they said.

Many other city roads have potholes and movement of vehicles on the damaged roads have become hazardous, they said.

The demonstrators threatened to go for a tougher programme if initiatives are not taken after the Rajshahi City Corporation election on July 30.
