Inaugurating the event, she hoped that the state would be more attentive towards ensuring the rights of indigenous people, and the majority [Bengalis] would be "sensitive and responsible".

Criticising the government for not recognising the day nationally, columnist Syed Abul Maksud said, "Only one out of 365 days has been dedicated for indigenous people but the country's majority are not generous enough to celebrate it." "It is shameful," he added.

A trust-based relationship between the administration

and indigenous people has to be nurtured so that they do not feel forced to leave the country, he also said.

Information Minister Hasanul Haq Inu admitted that some clauses of the CHT Peace Accord have not been implemented. The government is "aware and cautious" about the matter, he said.

The minister urged indigenous people to look at the progresses made so far and assured that the remaining problems would be solved through discussions.

Manusher Jonno Foundation Executive Director Shaheen Anam said indigenous women have been subjected to different forms of violence, including rape, while perpetrators could avert punishment due to a culture of impunity.

Theatre personality Mamunur Rashid urged indigenous people not to engage in internal conflict for the sake of their own existence.

Prof Mesbah Kamal of Dhaka University, lawmaker Fazle Hossain Badshah, and BAF General Secretary Sanjeeb Drong, among others, spoke.

BUS OWNER'S CONFESSION Meanwhile yesterday, Shahadat Hossain, owner of Jabal-e-Noor Paribahan, confessed to a magistrate that he was gravely wrong to not scrutinise the license of the driver who ran his bus over the students.

Metropolitan Magistrate Golam Nabi recorded the statement at his chamber for over three hours, after Kazi Shariful Islam, inspector of Detective Branch of police, produced Shahadat before the court.

In his statement, Shahadat told the magistrate that he appointed the driver Masum Billah in good faith at the recommendation of Bus Owners Samity, but after the accident he learnt that Masum was not qualified to drive a heavy vehicle.

TK 165CR AB BANK SCAM

HC adjourns hearing till Oct 11

The High Court (HC) yesterday adjourned the hearing on a suo moto (voluntary) rule that questioned the legality of the bail granted to two former officials of AB Bank in the Tk 165 crore money laundering case, till October 11.

The HC bench of Justice Moyeenul Islam Chowdhury, Justice M Enayetur Rahim and Justice Md Ashraful Kamal fixed 2:00pm on October 11 for resuming the hearing.

On January 25, a Dhaka court granted bail to M Wahidul Haque, former chairman of AB Bank and Abu Hena Mustafa Kamal, former head of financial institutions and treasury of the bank.

Later, on January 31, the HC bench issued a suo moto rule asking the government, Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) and the two bank officials to explain why the bail should not be cancelled. The bench also issued a travel ban on the duo in this regard.

On April 4, the HC bench sent the documents regarding the suo moto rule to the chief justice for constituting a special bench for settling this issue.

The ACC, on January 25, arrested Wahidul, Abu Hena and businessman Saiful Haque in connection with the case.

"vandalism and attacks on police".

Addressing the programme, President of JU Cultural Alliance Md Ashikur Rahman said, "Students wanted safe roads but they were remanded in return. The students are facing physical and mental torture in police custody, which might put their lives in danger."

spread through rumours, and it has hampered the movement, but the rumours are not being spread from one side only.

The platform's demands also include release of the students held under ICT Act for allegedly spreading rumours, considering their age and the validity of the movement.

HRFB urged the government to ensure that teachers or law enforcers do not harass the innocent students who were involved in the recent movement for safe roads.

They also called upon the government to materialise the nine-point demand placed by the student protesters and take short and long-term measures to ensure that irregularities in the transport sector are resolved.

Condemning the arrest and alleged torture of renowned photographer Shahidul Alam, HRFB said the way Shahidul Alam was picked up from his home does not conform to the existing law of the country.

Leaders of HRFB also asked the government to explain why they did not take any action to protect the students, after conjecturing that various antigovernment forces might try to create anarchy.

"How were helmetwearing persons able to attack students in front of law enforcers, and harass female students?" asked Tamanna Haque Riti, who read out the statement. Sheepa Hafiza, execu-

tive director of Ain o Shalish Kendra moderated the programme.
