




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CGS-FES Fellowship-2018 on the "Futures of Education"
Centre for Genocide Studies (CGS), University of Dhaka, in collaboration with Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung (FES), Bangladesh, will be offering 4 (four) CGS-FES Fellowship on the "Futures of Education" for national and international scholars and researchers. The fellowship is designed to explore the challenges, opportunities, innovations, changes, and futures in the field of education in Bangladesh. Eligible fellows will contribute to the research on the futures of education with a special focus on policies, strategies, institutions, and methods.

Eligibility of Fellowship Applicants

- Applicant must hold a graduate degree. Preference will be given to those with a PhD.
- Application must have scholastic achievement and experience to complete the project successfully.
- The proposal ought to be relevant to the theme of the Fellowship.
- This is an equal opportunity Fellowship irrespective of gender, religion, and nationality.

Value of Fellowship Award

The fellowship will be offered to four awardees. The value of the award will be between BDT 150,000-BDT 200,000 (approx. USD 1,800-USD 2,400).

Selection Process

Fellowships will be awarded based on the relevance and merit of the theme after a rigorous review process by engaging prominent academics. Only short-listed applicants will be contacted for an interview.

The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received financing from the World Bank towards the cost of the approved Bangladesh Regional Connectivity Project-1, and intends to apply part of the proceeds thereof for relevant consultancy services.

The consulting services ("the services") include:

a) Review and validate the design and construction supervision of the designated works at Ramgarh, Sheola, Bhomra, and Benapole.

b) Post-construction phase monitoring and supervision (1). Inspect the works at appropriate intervals during Defects Notification Period and issue instructions for rectification if any; 2. Ensure that the contractors' demobilization is as per the agreed Mobilization Plan; 3. Check and certify As-Built Drawings prepared by the contractors before issuance of Taking-Over Certificates; & 4. At the completion of the works, assist the Employer in preparing a consolidated Project Completion Report in the format as prescribed by World Bank.

Expected date for commencement of the services is January 2019 and completion by June 2021. The tentative duration of the entire assignment is about 30 (thirty) months.

The Bangladesh Land Port Authority (BLPA), under the Ministry of Shipping, Government of Bangladesh now invites eligible Consulting Firms ("Consultants") to express their interest in providing the abovementioned services as described in Para 2. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the proposed services with support of relevant documents. The short-listing criteria are:

- adequate experience in supervision of infrastructure projects;
- have experience in the fields of environmental and social assessment/safeguards/risk analysis, monitoring and management;
- have experience in solid waste management, bio-engineering, hydrology, material study; and
- Corporate Capacity of the Consultants (Annual Turnover, Financial Information for last 5 years, but no audited financial statements in this regard).

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to the Section III, Para 3.14, 3.16 and 3.17 of the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, July 2016," setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, but should indicate clearly whether the association is in the form of a joint venture and/or a sub-consultancy. In case of a joint venture, all the partners in the joint venture shall be Jointly and Severally liable for the entire contract, if selected.

A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method set out in the Procurement Regulations. Shortlisted Consultants will be invited to submit their Technical and Financial proposals as per the Request for Proposal (RFP) document to be issued to them.
