Jihad's parents finally receive Tk 20 lakh compensation

Parents of Jihad, the four-year-old boy who died after falling into a 300ft shaft in Dhaka's Shahjahanpur area in 2014, have received Tk 20 lakh in compensation from the government.

Bangladesh Railway and Bangladesh Fire Service and Civil Defence provided the money as per a High Court directive.

Supreme Court lawyer Barrister Abdul Halim, who moved a writ petition before the HC for the compensation, told The Daily Star that Jihad's parents confirmed receiving Tk 20 lakh on Monday.

Barrister Abdul Halim said he also received the bank statement to this effect. Yesterday, the lawyer informed the HC about the payout to Jihad's parents.

After hearing statements from Barrister Halim, the HC exonerated the director general of Bangladesh Railway from contempt of court rule.
