YOUTUBE COMMENTS

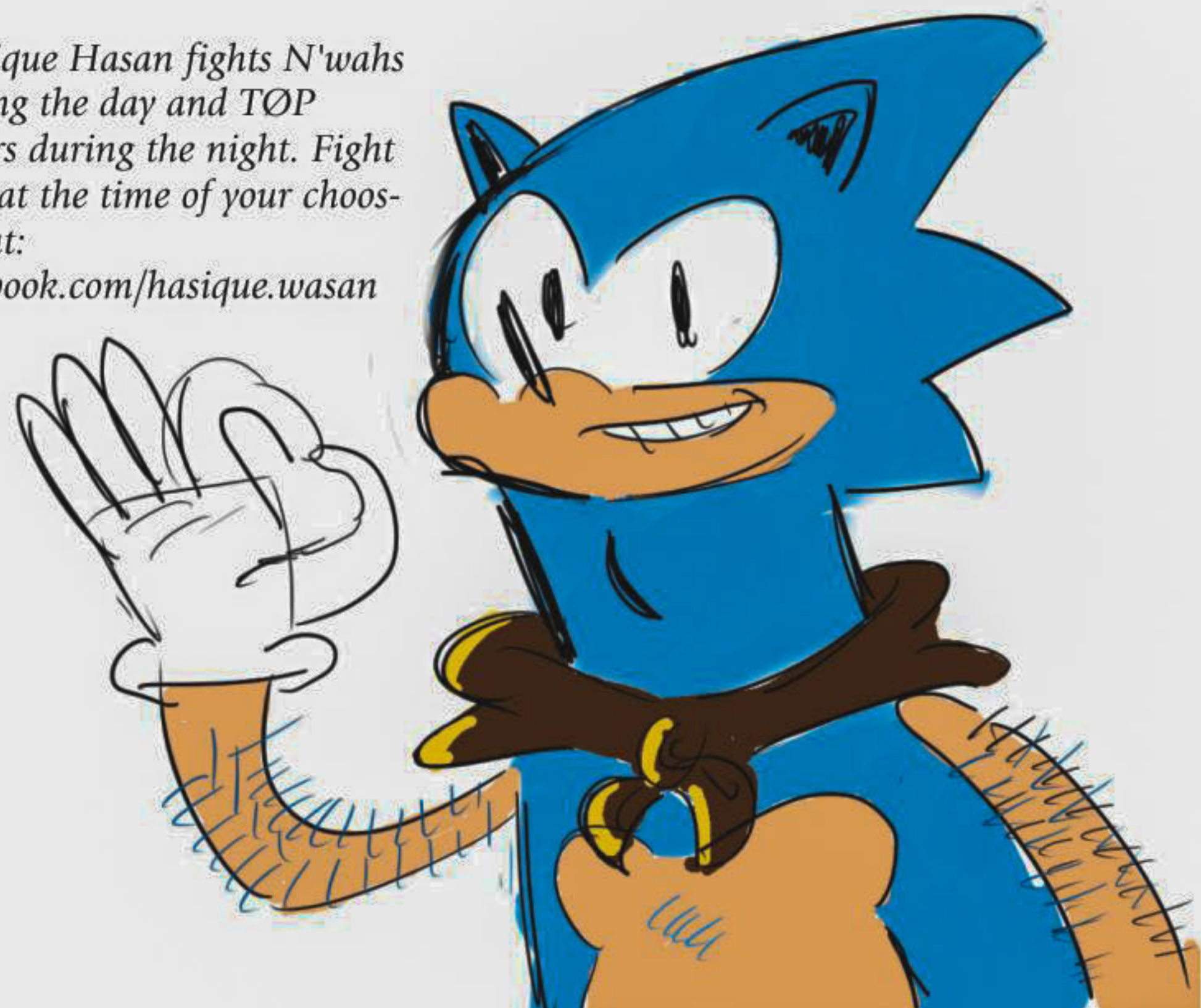
