The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MOHFW) has been implementing Health, Population and Nutrition Sector Program (HPNSP) 2017-2022. National Institute of Population Research and Training (NIPORT) under Medical Education and Family Welfare Division of MOHFW intends to apply a part of the allocated fund under Training Research and Development (TRD) Operational Plan of HPNSP for procuring services under the following package:

Package: NPS-22: Utilization of Essential Service Delivery (UESD) Survey 2016

To complete the abovementioned package primary data collection, data editing, data entry, analysis etc. for the 2019 UESD Survey will be needed. Activities of the package need to be completed by June 2019.

NIPORT now invites eligible consultants (firms) to submit their Expression of Interest (EOI) for the abovementioned package services. Interested consultants (firms) are invited to provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar operating conditions, availability of appropriate professional qualification and experience among staff). The EOIs would be reviewed on the basis of the following:

- Age of business of consultant (firm)
- Availability of key professional staff (list of management and key personnel)
- Turnover of the consultant (firm)
- Experience of the consultant (firm) in similar field specially in large scale data collection
- Experience of the consultant (firm) in other works/assignments (activities done in similar process)
- Support service of the consultant (physical facilities, equipment, HR of firm)

Consultants (firms) may associate to enhance their qualifications, but should clearly mention whether the association is in the form of a "Joint-Venture" or of "Sub-Consultancy". In the case of a joint venture, all members of such "association" should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment and it is preferable to limit the total number of firms including the associates to a maximum of four.

Special Instructions:

- Incomplete/partial EOIs will be rejected.
- Interested firm(s) must provide focused information demonstrating that they are qualified to perform the services.
- EOI proposal should be organized by presenting every required documents in separate chapter with reference and page number in the overview/index.
- Proposal will limit maximum 150 pages.
- The authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the EOIs, or annul the EOI process at any stage without assigning any reason(s) whatsoever and without incurring any liability to the affected applicant(s).

Selection of the consultant will be done following PPA-2006 and PPR-2008.

Interested consulting firm(s) is required to submit EOI for the package along with relevant supporting documents (2 copies) in a sealed envelope to the address indicated below by 4:00pm on September 12, 2018. EOIs submitted through emails should also reach the e-mail address mentioned below by 4:00pm on the same date.

Request for Expression of Interest (REOI)

Consulting Firm Selection (National)

Subject: Consulting Services for Developing Citizen Portal and integrating with present CPTU website, Upgradation of CPTU Mobile App and Social Media Engagement including Maintenance under DIMAPPP (Contract Package # CPTU/S-29).

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received finance from the World Bank toward the cost of the Digitization Implementation Monitoring and Public Procurement Project (DIMAPPP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

2. The consulting services ("the Services") include:

- Design, develop, install and maintain a Citizen Portal on public procurement for CPTU, upgrade CPTU Mobile App and social media.
- Explore options for Citizen Portal to integrate innovative ICT tools in the form of a monitoring and feedback that would help to promote dialogue to ensure transparency and accountability in public spending vis-a-vis better service delivery. Link the portal to various Citizen Engagement tools including Open Contracting initiatives.
- Reflect current global trends in web development, international good practices based on examples of similar web platforms, and relevant web/new media-based tools and resources in the designs.
- Coordinate and maintain effective engagement/liaison to collect data for the Portal from different social accountability and Citizen Engagement activities related to public procurement. These include activities such as the Government-Tenderers' Forum (GTF) being implemented by the Strategic and Behavioural Change Communication Consultant; community/local level citizen's monitoring activities being implemented by the Citizen Engagement Consultant.
- Redesign and update the Public Procurement Mobile App as per CPTU's requirement and enhance it to global standard in terms of appearance and functionality.
- Production of digital content such as write-ups/messages, video clips, success stories on public procurement, info-graphics, etc. to be shared over different social media channels.

3. The Central Procurement Technical Unit (CPTU), Implementation Monitoring and Evaluation Division (IMED), Ministry of Planning, Dhaka, Bangladesh now invites eligible institutions/organizations ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the services. The shortlisting criteria are:

3.1 General Experience: Consultant Firm must be a legal entity in Bangladesh; The consultant firm must have 5 years of proven experience of designing high quality interactive and scalable website/web applications. Previous experience with open data portals or mobile applications a plus. Familiarity with user-centered approaches is a plus.

3.2 Specific Skills and Experiences:

- Proven and solid knowledge and experience in providing similar services to national and international organizations preferably Government institutions;
 - Knowledge in developing proprietary CMS from scratch would be an added advantage;
 - Solid knowledge on website security and website hosting services;
 - Familiarity with W3C web standards for web design, development, content and accessibility and the latest development trends;
 - The development team should have senior and experienced resources in the field of graphics design (HTML, CSS), Web Programming, Database design and administration and website security;
 - Solid knowledge and experience in developing mobile application;
 - Solid knowledge and experience in producing digital contents for social and new media platforms;
 - Familiarity and/or experience in managing and marketing social media contents for regional and/or global platforms/institutions would be an added advantage;
 - Good understanding of development/public expenditure issues with experience in preparation of digital media/web contents/success stories and info-graphics etc.
5. The attention of interested consultants is drawn to paragraph 3.17 of the World Bank Regulations for IPF Borrowers (Regulations), July 2016, setting forth the World Bank's requirement on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Consultant Qualification Selection (CQS) method set out in The Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers of the WB. The assignment has two consecutive phases; first six months for design, development and installation and then 36 months or up to 30 June 2022 (whichever occurs earlier) for operation and maintenance.
6. Expression of Interest (EOI) must be submitted within 5pm by 16 September 2018 either in sealed envelope clearly marked "EOI for Developing Citizen Portal, Upgradation of CPTU Mobile App and Social Media including maintenance" or through email sent to Director General, CPTU. Late submission will not be considered. The CPTU reserves the right to accept or reject any or all EOIs.
