Rider electrocuted at Comilla city-run amusement park

A university-level student died from electrocution while taking an amusement ride at Dharmasagar City Park in Comilla on Saturday night.

The deceased, Raihan, 22, was a second-year honours student of Comilla Lalmai Degree College and resident of Comilla city. The body was handed over to his family.

Shafiq, a tea stall owner and witness, said, "A youth screamed after he got electrocuted while riding the magic boat. His friends who were also taking the ride jumped off and took him to Comilla Medical College Hospital."

He was declared dead at the hospital. Dharmasagar is a decades-old park, but at least 11 amusement rides including Ferris wheel, toy train, and merry-go-round were installed in the last six months. It is owned and operated by Comilla City Corporation.

Soon after the accident, the ride

operators went missing, and the authorities declared the park shut.

Abul Fazal Mir, deputy commissioner of Comilla, said the park would not resume operation until experts declare it safe.

Superintendent of Police of Comilla Syed Nurul Islam visited the park yesterday.

Abu Salam Mia, officer-in-charge of Kotwali Model Police Station, said a murder case was filed against Abul Kashem and Sharif, who are peons of the city corporation and assigned to operate the magic boat ride.

Anupam Barua, chief officer of the City Park, said, "Comilla City Corporation suspended all types of ride until further notice."

When asked how the rides were installed and who operate those, he did not give an answer.

This correspondent called Comilla city Mayor Monirul Haque Shakku several times, but his phone was switched off.

an average 0.59 year longer, and the benefit of reaching this stringent target would be especially large in countries with the highest current levels of pollution, with approximately 0.8-1.4 years of additional survival in countries such as Egypt, India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, China and Nigeria.

For the case of Bangladesh, if the PM2.5 levels were to be reduced from the current 98.6 microgrammes per cubic metre to 10, the study estimated that the potential increments in life expectancy would be 1.33 years, also the biggest improvement in life expectancy among all affected countries.

For the 2016 population, 95 percent of the global population are exposed to levels of PM2.5 that exceed the WHO's recommended level, according to the researchers.

"For much of Asia, if air pollution were removed as a risk for death, 60-year olds would have a 15 percent to 20 percent higher chance of living to age 85 or older," lead author Joshua Apte was quoted by Science Daily web site as saying regarding the study.

The importance of groundwater is further strengthened by the observation that sea-level rise will lead to higher salinity which will only be exacerbated with more seawater intrusion or flooding.

Dr Himmelsbach recommends groundwater governance to minimise the threats to freshwater reserves in coastal aquifers.

A case was lodged with a Mymensingh court yesterday against cricket player of the Bangladesh national team, Mosaddek Hossain Saikat.

Saikat's wife Samina Sharmin Samia lodged the case with the Cognizance Court-1 of Mymensingh, accusing Mosaddek and his mother Parul Begum.

Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate Rozina Khan accepted the case and ordered women's affairs official of Mymensingh sadar upazila to investigate, said Rezaul Karim Khan Dulal, who pleaded for the complainant.

Mosaddek married his cousin Samia some six years ago. He had been making demands but they could not meet up the demand due to financial constraints, alleged Samia, a final year student of BA class.

Saikat demanded Tk 10 lakh on August 15 to start a business, she added.

The objective of the overall engagement is to develop a comprehensive approach to managing earthquake risk through a structured process of knowledge development, education, and planning that involves a wide range of stakeholders to increase their capacity and to build ownership. The specific objective of the project is to enhance national-level and local-level DRM facilities and agencies in Dhaka and Sylhet to effectively plan and respond to urban disasters. This will be achieved by developing disaster response systems, including emergency operations center, interoperability communication systems, rescue and search equipment, and related training and drills etc.
- The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh (GoB) has received a credit for the "Urban Resilience Project (URP)" from the International Development Agency (IDA) and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to pay for procurement of services from national consultants for the role of a Procurement Specialist. As part of his/her duties, the Consultant will assist the Project Management Unit (PIU) in procuring goods, works and services under the project following World Bank guidelines as well as Public Procurement Acts/Rules of the Government of Bangladesh.

The scope of this Consultancy services include, but not limited to:

- Preparing and updating the Project's Procurement Plan (PPP); preparing and publishing all procurement related notices in newspaper, relevant websites etc.
