

# Bridge without approach roads

People of 20 villages suffer

The newly constructed bridge over a canal at Jamalgar village in Sunamganj's Tahirpur upazila is lying unused for couple of months as it does not have approach roads on either side, causing immense suffering to people of nearby villages.

According to Tahirpur Upazila Project Implementation Office, the 40-foot-long and 12-foot-wide concrete bridge was constructed on Tahirpur-Badghat road in May this year at a cost of Tk 30 lakh and 90 thousand to improve communication facilities of the people of nearly 20 villages in the upazila.

Usually, people of several villages, including Badghat, Gazipur and Jamalgar, use the route to go to the upazila headquarters, locals said.

They said the bamboo bridge over the canal was washed away nearly two years ago due to erosion and heavy tidal surges.

Tahirpur Union Parishad (UP) Chairman Md Borhan Uddin said thousands of people, especially stu-

dents and elderly one, of the nearby villages have suffering a lot as the approach roads on either side of the bridge have not been built even a couple of months after its construction.

Although, in the dry season people walk through the dried up canal, in the rainy season they have to depend on other inconvenient alternatives, the UP chairman said.

"I raised the issue at the monthly coordination meeting of the upazila administration on a couple of occasions, but to no avail," he added.

Headmaster of Gazipur Government Primary School Nihar Ranjan Das said a good number of students, mostly girls, of different schools and colleges in the area use the route to reach their institutions in dry season, while they have to walk additional two to three kilometres in the rainy season.

Tahirpur Upazila Parishad Chairman Kamruzzaman said he was aware of the issue and the upazila administration will take necessary steps to solve the problem soon.

# Hakaluki road in bad shape

The awful condition of the two-kilometre-long Rasulganj-Shasarkandi road at Hakaluki haor in Kulaura upazila has been causing great suffering to commuters as vehicles have not been able to use the road since June in 2017.

Locals said thousands of people, including students in the upazila and Fenchuganj upazila of Sylhet, need to use the road every day, overcoming serious problems. The suffering of critical patients is beyond description when they have to go district headquarters.

On a recent visit to the site, this correspondent found a number of potholes on the road. In some places more than 90% of the road had collapsed, creating big ditches.

CNG autorickshaw driver Md Sheful Ahmad told this correspondent that he takes students

and passengers up to the broken section but does not cross it for fear of damage to his vehicle.

Darach Mia of Shasarkandi village said most of the two-kilometre-long Rasulganj-Shasarkandi road collapsed during the flood in 2017, and the carpeting was washed away. Since June in 2017, the water level in Hakaluki haor has risen and many places on the road have become submerged, he said.

Shimul Mia, a trader of Shasarkandi bazar, said accidents occur regularly and many vehicle owners have stopped operating on the road to avoid damage to their vehicles.

Bhukshimoil Union Parishad member Hossain Khan said people of Barkkuri, Kamaura, Bhatara union, Naogaon, Shasarkandi, Bhukshimoil union, Sylhet, Brahmanbazar and Moulvibazar use this road.

He contacted the union parishad chairman and everyone gave assurance that the road will be repaired, Hossain said, adding that no action has been taken in 14 months. The roads have been so badly damaged that there is no scope for the villagers to repair it, he said.

"The road connects Bhatara union with Bhukshimoil union. I have erected bamboo fencing on different parts of the road to protect it from waves, but to no avail," said Bhukshimoil Union Parishad Chairman Azizur Rahman.

The road has become unfit for vehicular movement due to lack of repair, he added.

"We tried to protect the road with sand-filled sacks, but it could not be saved. This road will require site protection," said Kulaura upazila Local Government Engineering Department Deputy-Assistant Engineer Shariful Haque.

# Missing teenager found dead

The decomposed body of a missing teenage rickshaw-van puller, who had been missing since Friday, was recovered from a bamboo cluster in Saltha upazila on Monday.

The deceased was Azizul Kha, 15, son of Afzal Kha of Dhopadanga village under Chandpur union in Sadar upazila.

Chandpur Union Parishad Member Md Imrul Hossain said Azizul went to pull his rickshaw-van on Friday morning and remained missing since then.

"Some children found a decomposed body in a bamboo bush while they were playing football near the bush," he said.

# EMBEZZLING MOBILE COURT MONEY Bench clerk, his wife jailed

A Faridpur court yesterday sentenced a bench clerk of a mobile court of Shariatpur Deputy Commissioner's office to 28 years imprisonment and his wife, also a clerk at the same office, to eight years.

The court gave the verdict in a case taken over by the Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) over misappropriating of about Tk 89,94,024 realised by the mobile court as fine.

Judge Md Motiur Rahman of Special Judge's Court in Faridpur delivered the verdict against Md Imam Uddin, 45, a clerk at general management department of the DC's office and also a bench clerk of the mobile court, and his wife Kamla Akter, 38, also a clerk of the department, said ACC lawyer Majibar Rahman.

"The court fined Imam the amount that he embezzled, in default, to serve seven months and 15 days more in jail and Kamla Tk 20,000, in default, to serve one month and 15 days more," Majibar added.

"Imam embezzled Tk 89,94,024 with the help of his wife Kamla".

The then Assistant Commissioner and Magistrate Jiniya Jinnat of Shariatpur Deputy Commissioner's office lodged a case with Palong Police Station accusing Imam and his wife Kamla in June 18, 2015," Majibar said.

# BGB rescue 3 BSF men, 2 boatmen from Dharla river

The Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) rescued three Indian Border Security Force (BSF) members and two Indian boatmen unhurt after their boat went inoperative on the Dharla river amid strong current at Mogolhat border in Lalmonirhat Sadar upazila around 11:30pm on Monday.

The BSF members and boatmen were sent back to India safely yesterday morning.

Three members of 38 BSF Battalion's Gidaldah camp under Dinhat Police Station in Cooch Behar district under West Bengal were performing their duty riding a boat run by two boatmen on the Indian side of the Dharla river on Monday night, BGB officials said.

The engine of the boat suddenly got inoperative in the mid river, leaving the five people helpless.

As the BSF Battalion's commander sent a phone message to Commanding Officer (CO) of BGB 15 Battalion Lt Col Golam Morshed in Lalmonirhat in this regard, the latter informed Mogolhat BGB camp members who rushed to the spot on a speedboat, rescued the five people and brought them to Bangladesh territory.

The Indian boat, which floated away due to strong current in the river, was recovered by BGB members from the river at Kathalbari of Lalmonirhat, around 40 kilometres in the downstream, yesterday.

"When we got the message from India, it became our duty to save the BSF members and boatmen. We are very happy to rescue them unhurt. The BSF Battalion commander gave thanks to BGB for the task," said Lt Col Golam Morshed, CO of BGB 15 Battalion.
