

People won't allow polls

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Criticising law enforcers, Mosharraf said, "You are public servants, not servants of the Awami League... So, don't harass, arrest or file cases for no reason."

He reiterated the party's demand for resignation of the government before the announcement of the election schedule, reconstitution of the Election Commission and deployment of army to hold the next polls in a fair and credible manner.

Another BNP standing committee member Moudud Ahmed said, "Now, it is not possible to free Khaleda through a legal battle."

"The only way is to take to the streets. We are on a movement and we will intensify it to ensure the government's fall," he added.

Moudud warned that their party will come up with strong action programmes to unseat the government at the right time. He called upon BNP leaders and activists to prepare themselves to make the movement a success.

Prof Emajuddin Ahmed, a former vice chancellor of Dhaka University, ended the token hunger strike by offering water to BNP leaders.

Meanwhile, BNP alleged that at least 120 party men were detained by law enforcers from around the venue.

BNP OFFICE VANDALISED IN CTG

The BNP Chittagong district (south) office was vandalised at Dost Building in New Market area in the afternoon, reports our staff correspondent.

The incident took place after a token hunger strike programme demanding release of Khaleda Zia ended. Some furniture of the office was ransacked.

Jaforul Islam Chowdhury, president of the unit, told The Daily Star that even though their office is in Kotwali area, they

held the programme in Bakalia.

"We held a peaceful programme around noon. Soon after it ended at 2:00pm, we heard about the attack. Some miscreants are out to destabilise the party," he alleged without elaborating or naming anyone.

He said a photo of the party chairperson was vandalised. "If they were party activists, they would never have done that," he claimed.

Meanwhile, some party activists, wishing anonymity, said some Chhatra Dal men who were left out from its Chittagong (south) unit committee, formed last month, were behind the attack.

The mobile phone of Shohidul Alam, president of Chittagong south unit of Chhatra Dal, was found switched off.

Jamir Uddin, its joint secretary, said they heard about the attack but "didn't know who were the behind it".

When asked, Mohammed Mohsin, officer-in-charge of Kotwali Police Station, said they rushed to the spot on information, and found the office vandalised. "No one complained to us about the incident yet. If we get any complain, we will investigate," he added.

PRO-BNP JU TEACHERS DEMAND KHALEDA'S RELEASE

Pro-BNP teachers and staff of Jahangirnagar University observed a token hunger strike on the campus yesterday, demanding release and better treatment of Khaleda Zia.

Some 50 teachers and officials, under the banner of "Jahangirnagar Nationalist Teachers-Officers-Staff Forum" took part in it from 11:00am to 1:00pm, reports our JU correspondent.

The SUTI index is derived from aggregation of ten indicators set by the UNESCAP to help achieve the UN Sustainable Development Goals, namely -- transport plan and infrastructure, modal share, access to public transport service, quality and reliability, traffic fatalities, travel cost, operational cost, investment in public transport, air quality and level of greenhouse emission. The indicators help assess the state of urban transport performance.

"In case of Dhaka city, the land use plan must be such that it would ensure road network grids, or else there will be transportation problems in future," said Prof Shivananda Swami from CEPT University of Ahmedabad, who is regarded the mastermind of bus rapid transit of Ahmedabad, India.

The public space disproportionately occupied by private vehicles should be reclaimed to accommodate public transport system, he said, adding that not one but multiple solutions constitute the public transport system.

It is the plan what matters critically in respect of having a vibrant urban transport system, he said, adding that land use master-plan, city development plan, transport plan and environment conservation plan must be integrated with each other.

ESCAP economic affairs officer Madan B Regmi said, "What is the use of a nice plan if it is not implemented?"

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year, the Police Bureau of Investigation (PBI) filed a charge sheet accusing Ragib and his son in the first case. In the other case, the PBI charged the duo along with Ragib's daughter, son-in-law, a relative and the caretaker.

On August 10 that year, arrest warrants were issued against all six, and on that day Ragib and his son fled to India. Later, on November 12, Abdul Hye was arrested while returning to Bangladesh, and on November 24, Ragib was arrested in India.

They had been in jail until October 29, 2017 when the Supreme Court upheld their bail petition and allowed them to walk out of prison.

In the second case, the caretaker is on bail and the remaining three are on the run.
