

Cattle farming brings him solvency

Once struggling to make both ends meet, Abdul Latif of Shibram village of Kanthalbari union in Kurigram Sadar upazila is now a source of inspiration for success through cattle farming.

Latif, 38, who could not continue study after the HSC due to poverty, received training on cattle rearing from Youth Development Department in Rangpur in 2001.

The next year, he began cattle farming, starting with two cows at his home, alongside working as a vet in his area.

During a recent visit, this correspondent saw four cows worth Tk 2 lakh and 25 goats worth Tk 50 thousand in his farm.

"After buying ordinary cows from Kanthalbari haat for low prices, I rear them in my farm, making them fat through providing proper food and treatment. Then I sell them for good prices and buy new cows," said Latif.

"I began goat rearing in 2014. This year I have constructed a cattle shed with Tk 4 lakh.

"Last year I made a garden with guava,

latkon and mango trees on 1.5 acres of land. I have already sold guava of Tk one lakh.

"Now my average monthly income stands around Tk 45 thousand. Now I am living well with my five-member-family," said Latif.

With the money saved from his earning, he bought 58 decimals of land in 2005, 22 decimals in 2010 and 40 decimals in his area in 2014. Besides, he has constructed tin-shed rooms at his house.

"I think people can gain solvency by agricultural work like cattle farming and fruit cultivation. I have a plan to expand my farm and work for jobless youths in my area," Latif said.

Atiqur Rahman, 25, of the area said, "Inspired by Latif, I got involved in cattle farming, besides selling drug at a pharmacy in Kanthalbari Bazar. Now I am able to maintain my four-member family well."

Kurigram Sadar Upazila Livestock Officer Dr Habibur Rahman said, "I visited Abdul Latif's cattle farm. People like him can serve as model for the local youths struggling for livelihood."

Youth gets life for rape, two others for murder

A court in Natore yesterday sentenced a man to life imprisonment for raping a physically challenged girl while another court awarded the same punishment to two others for killing a man.

The convicted rapist is Alal Uddin, 35, son of late Saibullah of Jangli Mandalpara village in Natore Sadar upazila.

Judge of Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal Mohammad Mainul Islam pronounced the verdict. The judge also fined Alal Tk 50,000.

Alal took the 13-year-old physically challenged girl to his room on September 9 in 2008 and raped her.

The victim's father lodged a case with Natore Sadar Police Station on September 10.

Another court sentenced Sumon Ali, son of Motahar Ali of the village, and Abdul Alim, son of Kala Mian of Tebaria village, to life imprisonment for killing a man at Ramnagar village in 2014.

District and Sessions Judge Rezaul Karim pronounced the verdict. The court acquitted three other accused.

The convicts hacked Arman Ali to death at Ramnagar village on September 13 in 2014.

Arman's father Babul Uddin Member lodged a case with Natore Police Station, accusing five people, including Alal.

Man arrested with Yaba in Mymensingh

A man was arrested with Yaba at Pailabo village in Bhaluka upazila yesterday.

The arrestee was identified as Md Sona Mia, 40, son of late Amjad Ali of the village.

On information, a team of detectives, led by Sub-Inspector Mobarak Hossain, raided the area and detained Sona Mia and recovered 200 Yaba pills from his possession, said Shah Kamal Akanda, officer-in-charge of Detective Branch of Police in the district.

Sona Mia was produced before a Mymensingh court that sent him to jail yesterday afternoon, the OC said.

ATTACK ON CHRISTIAN FAMILY

Victim's family under threat by accused on bail

All the eight arrestees came out on bail on Tuesday and are threatening a minority Christian family in Jessor's Sharsha upazila of dire consequences.

Victim Solomon Das, 55, of Gilapole village, alleged that the eight accused, arrested in connection with a case filed for attacking his house and looting valuables on Saturday night, came out on bail and are threatening his family members.

Fearing attack, one of his daughters stopped attending her college, he said.

"As the gang keeps threatening us continuously we are feeling very insecure," Solomon said.

Meanwhile, a group of human rights activists from Jessor and Sathkhira visited Solomon's house yesterday and talked to his family members.

Several villagers, on condition of anonymity, said Tariqul Islam Milon, a member of Ward No 1 under Ulashi union, has been

demanding money from Solomon in a bid to grab his land.

As Solomon refused to pay the money, a group of men loyal to Milon, attacked Solomon's house on Saturday night and looted valuables and gold ornaments.

The gang also harassed Solomon's father, wife and two daughters, villagers said.

Later, following a case filed by Solomon with Sharsha Police Station against 17 people around Saturday midnight, police detained the eight on Sunday morning.

In 2016, the same gang tried to kill his sister-in-law Maya Maria Karmaker by setting her on fire, Solomon said, adding that none of the seven accused in the case have been arrested yet.

Ulashi Union Parishad Chairman Alhaj Aynal Haque said Milon and his men illegally rule a local park where almost all types of anti-social activities occur.

He has always been protesting their illegal activities, the chairman said.

200 sacks of rice for poor seized

Police seized 200 sacks of rice, meant for the ultra-poor people, from different areas at Joka village in Sadar upazila of the district on Tuesday night.

Each sack contained 30 kg of rice, said Inspector Tipu Sultan, in-charge of Narundi Police Station.

On information, a police team conducted a drive at the village around 9:30pm.


At one stage of the drive, the team seized 87 sacks of rice from the house of Bilu Miah of the village, 95 sacks from Abdul Kalam's house and 18 sacks of rice from a grocery shop belonging to Solaiman, neighbour of Bilu, said the inspector.

While conducting the drive, Bilu, Kalam and Solaiman managed to flee the scene, said the police official.

Sadar Upazila Food Officer Tarapada Chakrabarti later filed a case, accusing Bilu, Kalam and Solaiman, with Sadar Police Station yesterday.

The government started the programme of sale of rice at Tk 10 per kg to help the ultra-poor through dealers across the country in early September, said the food officer.
