

CHATTOGRAM COLLEGE BCL men continue fighting over posts

Leaders and activists of Chattogram Government College unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League once again locked into a clash yesterday over formation of the 25-member college committee.

And just like Tuesday, a chase and counter-chase took place around noon between the supporters of post-deprived and newly-selected BCL activists on College Road in front of the institution.

During the melee, BCL men from both groups blasted several crude bombs, vandalised vehicles and shops, creating panic among students, guardians and pedestrians.

Traffic movement remained halted on the busy road for around two hours, causing sufferings to people. Police later charged batons and dispersed the BCL men from the spot.

College and BCL sources said Chattogram city unit BCL approved the committee on Monday night making Mahmudul Karim president and Suvash Mallik Sabuj general secretary for the next year.

Protesting its formation, a section of BCL men have been demonstrating since Tuesday morning.

They alleged that outsiders and non-students got posts in the committee, which triggered anger among students. However, party activists, who got selected, claimed that most of the BCL men protesting against the committee were outsiders.

Around 11:30am yesterday, newly-selected leaders came to the college with their supporters. At the same time, post-deprived BCL men also took position in front of the college, creating a tense situation.

Soon, both groups, equipped with sharp weapons, started chasing each other, said students and witnesses. Some BCL men were seen brandishing firearms, they added.

They [BCL men] also blasted several crude bombs, vandalised vehicles and roadside shops, said the witnesses.

Assistant Commissioner (Chawkbazar) Nobel Chakma of Chattogram Metropolitan Police said, "Police dispersed agitating BCL men from the road by charging batons. Additional forces have been deployed in the area to avert any untoward situation."

BRTA resumes scrapping unfit auto-rickshaws

Bangladesh Road Transport Authority (BRTA), Chattogram has resumed scrapping CNG-run auto-rickshaws that are at least 15 years old and plying the port city roads, five months after the High Court dismissed a writ petition filed by vehicle owners challenging the process.

The drive resumed on September 13 and on the day, BRTA had scrapped 47 three-wheelers on its premises in presence of an executive magistrate. The authorities have already scrapped 161 outdated vehicles and till Monday, the mobile courts sent 154 unfit ones for dumping.

BRTA issued a notification on September 11 in local newspapers in this regard.

In April, BRTA took the initiative to scrap auto-rickshaws manufactured in 2002 or earlier.

At that time, they dismantled 412 vehicles in 14 days (till April 26), but the drive was halted as some vehicle owners filed the writ petition. The HC, however, dismissed it the same month but BRTA could not start the drive due to lack of magistrates, said its officials.

With appointment of two magistrates on August 27, BRTA resumed the drive. It is now planning to dismantle 1,280 outdated vehicles as per its list by October 10

in the second phase.

Though BRTA planned to dismantle 80 vehicles a day, the turnout was comparatively poor on the first day as around 50 percent of the listed vehicles were brought to its premises.

The low turnout was due to reasons such as theft of vehicles or some getting damaged in road accidents, suspected BRTA Executive Magistrate

Ziaul Haque Mir.

"Those who could not appear on the allotted day would be given chance to show up later. They don't have any other option as we are also conducting drives on the roads regularly," he said. The turnout eventually increased, he added.

After the appointment of two magistrates, BRTA had been conducting regular drives since August 30. It also halted renewing registrations of the outdated vehicles since 2012.

According to BRTA, around 13,000 registered auto-rickshaws are plying the city roads. Of those, more than 2,000 (registered in 2002) became outdated.

"Most of these vehicles had become outdated in 2011, after

nine years of their manufacturing. But due to the request of some owners' associations, timeframe was extended in two phases, which ended in December last year," said Mohammad SHAHID, deputy director of BRTA.

"We also issued registration numbers to new vehicles against the scrapped ones in the first phase so that our initiative does not cause any sort of transport crisis. We also plan to do the same this time," he added.

Contacted, Nazrul Islam Khokon, convener of CNG Auto-Rickshaw Oikya Parishad, said, "The scrapping process may bring distress to some owners... but it is necessary."

"The cylinders in those have expired and are like live bombs. They can explode anytime...," he added.

He, however, alleged, "The owners take their vehicles to BRTA on allotted days but for some irregularities [of the officials] they were given different dates."

"This is a hassle as they [owners] cannot drive the vehicles. They either have to drag it to BRTA or hire another vehicle to take those there," he added.

BRTA, however, refuted the allegation, saying some owners were given different dates if they did not show up on the assigned day or the officials were unable to complete the process.

Raisul Huq Bahar laid to rest

Veteran freedom fighter and journalist AKM Raisul Huq Bahar, who died of a cardiac arrest on Tuesday night, was laid to rest at Chattogram Port Graveyard yesterday after his namaz-e-janaza held on Chattogram Bandar Bhaban premises after Asr prayers.

Commodore Zulfiqur Aziz, chairman of Chittagong Port Authority, among others, took part in the namaz-e-janaza. Later, a smart contingent of police provided guard of honour to Bahar.

His body was brought to Chattogram Central Shaheed Minar premises in the morning, where people from all walks of life paid tributes to him.

His son Gias Uddin Muhammad Tausif said Bahar had a minor cardiac arrest just before heading out for the office of local Daily Purbokone, where he worked as associate editor, around 6:00pm. He was rushed to Max Hospital, where he suffered a massive cardiac arrest. Doctors declared him dead around 11:00pm, Tausif said.

Bahar was born on April 1, 1952 at Companiganj upazila in Noakhali. He was a guerrilla commander during the Liberation War, and led an operation to

Must use Biman for air trips at govt expense

The Prime Minister's Office has directed government officials for compulsory use of Biman Bangladesh Airlines on the routes where the national flag carrier operates flights, for air trips at government expense.

PMO issued a notification yesterday in this regard.

It says ministers, state ministers, deputy ministers, MPs, those holding constitutional posts, chairpersons, members and officers of the commissions constituted by the government, and officials and employees of ministries, divisions, semi-government and autonomous bodies, statutory organisations, corporations, constitutional agencies and different projects must use Biman for air trips at the expense of government on all routes where it operates flights.

They will be allowed to board flights of other airlines on the routes where Biman does not operate any flight.

'Selling yaba to fund sabotage'

Police arrested a leader of pro-BNP youth organisation Jubo Dal with 223 yaba pills in Chattogram city's Sadarghat area early yesterday, claiming that he was running a yaba business with an aim to collect funds for carrying out subversive activities.

Arrestee Bappu Kumar Das, 27, is general secretary of Raozan College Jubo Dal unit, said Nezam Uddin, OC of Sadarghat Police Station.

"Acting on a tip-off, a team of police raided Bappu's rented house in Alkaran area

and caught him with the pills," said the OC.

OC Nezam said during primary interrogation Bappu admitted that he is a yaba retailer, and used to sell the pills through his associates to "collect fund for carrying out sabotage".

A case was filed, the OC said.

Contacted, Belayet Hossain, member of district BNP convening committee, said, "I have known Bappu for a long time. He is an active Chhatra Dal member. As far as I know, he is not involved in any such [yaba/sabotage] activity."

Belayet termed the case "false and fabricated" and said it was filed to harass their party members.

Railway reclaims land from illegal occupants

Bangladesh Railway in Chattogram yesterday reclaimed around 2.2 acres of its land on Ice Factory Road where a slum had been rebuilt after Railway conducted an eviction drive there in April last year.

During the drive, beginning at 10:00am, the authorities disconnected utility connections of around 300 families living in the area.

For the last four days, railway authorities had been announcing the eviction drive over loudspeakers warning illegal occupants to shift to other places, said Executive Magistrate Touhidul Islam, who led the drive.

He said there was an ongoing legal battle over ownership of some portion of the occupied land and occupants of those parts were not evicted.

Kissinger Chakma, divisional estate officer (DSO) of railway, said, "We demolished more than 350 makeshift houses and establishments. A total of 200 railway workers cleaned up the area and three bulldozers were used."

"We will put barbed-wire fence around the land within a few days so that it cannot be occupied again," he added.

Sub-inspector Nunul Alam of Chittagong Metropolitan Police headquarters said four platoons of police from Sadarghat and Kotwali police stations as well as members of railway police and Railway Nirapatta Bahini were deployed.

While visiting the spot, this correspondent saw occupants salvaging their belongings as much as they can.

Occupant Amena said, "My family has been living here
