'WELCOME BACK TO OLD **TRAFFORD**'

Sir Alex Ferguson made an emotional return to Manchester United on Saturday for the first time since the club's legendary former manager had emergency brain surgery. Ferguson, who managed United for 27 years, was left fighting for his life after being rushed to hospital in May. But the 76-year-old Scot has made a good recovery and was pictured arriving at Old Trafford ahead of United's Premier League clash with Wolves. Ferguson's return reached a crescendo when he arrived in the main stand six minutes before kick-off and received a thunderous 60-second standing ovation from supporters. "I'm really good. Obviously it's been a long journey and I'm gradually making steps forward, doing what my son tells me and what the doctors tell me, so, yeah, I'm really good," he said. "It's great to go back to the stadium and it's going to be quite emotional for me when the game starts, things like that. -AFP



Vietnam test for girls

Hosts Bangladesh will look to seal a place in the second qualifying round of the AFC Women's Under-16 Championship Qualifiers with a win against Vietnam in the last match of Group F of the first qualifying round in Dhaka

today. The match will get underway at the Birshreshtha Shaheed Mostafa Kamal Stadium in Kamalapur at 3:30pm. BTV will telecast the match live from the

Bangladesh, who emerged as group champions to qualify for the final round in 2016, have a slightly tougher test this time as they will have to win against a strong Vietnam team in the final matchday.

Both teams go into the game with nine points each from three games played and have the same goal difference (+25). Hence a draw in this match would take the game to tiebreakers to decide the group winners.

However, Bangladesh coach Golam Rabbani Choton is confident of pulling off a victory in regulation time.

"We are confident. The team is fully prepared for the match and everyone is quite fit and ready to play," the veteran coach told The Daily Star yesterday. Bangladesh had a chance to improve their goal-margin when they beat

UAE 7-0 in the second match on Friday after Vietnam had inflicted the same margin of defeat on Lebanon earlier in the day. However, despite taking a 5-0 lead in the first half, Bangladesh could not add more than two goals in the second half, courtesy of a few wasted opportunities by the forwards. One more goal in that match would have put Bangladesh in pole position and they could have qualified with only a draw in the last match.

"The girls tried their best. It is unfortunate that they could not score more, but they did try to score all the time," the coach said, defending his players.

Anuching Mogini scored three goals of the seven while Shamsunnahar, Anai Mogini and Ilamoni scored the others. The other was an own-goal. Bangladesh had rested skipper Maria Manda in that match.

The Bangladesh coach knows Vietnam are a strong team and wasting opportunities could come back to haunt them in this match. Hence he worked specifically on finishing during the final practice session on Saturday.

"We worked on those mistakes. We know how important this match is. We have our own gameplan against Vietnam which I don't want to disclose. However, they have a few good players like the captain and the No. 10, who can cause us trouble. We will have special plans for those players," Choton

A defeat might not entirely rule out Bangladesh's chances of qualification, but a win would see them emerge group champions. The six group champions and the two best runners-up teams will play the second qualifying round after being split into two groups, from which the top two teams of each group will qualify for the final round, which will be held in Thailand in September next year.

Bashundhara show their power

Maldives Premier League champions New Radiant SC at the Sheikh Kamal Stadium in Nilphamari on Friday. The Championship League winners of the last season, who are emerging as the new powerhouse of local football, dispatched the Maldivian giants with a clinical performance in front of an around 15,000 strong homecrowd.

Ousmal Jallow and local forwards Tawhidul Alam Sabuj and Mahbubur Rahman Sufil scored one goal apiece in this international club friendly, which was organised by the Bashundhara Kings as part of their build-up for the upcoming season in topflight football.

Bashundhara Kings, coached by New Radiant's former coach Spaniard Oscar Bruzon, opened the scoring when Belfort flicked home a cross from Colindres. The lead was doubled four minutes later when Sabuj headed home Belfort's cross from the right.

The Maldivian giants, who Haitian forward Kervens came here with only 13 players,

Belfort, Gambian forward had a great opportunity to reduce the margin in the 32nd minute, but veteran Ali Fasir blasted his spot-kick way off target.

The home side made it 3-0 six minutes after restart, with substitute Jallow scoring from a Colindres cross before another substitute Sufil took the game away from the Maldivians with a fourth on the hour-mark.

Radiant's Ugandan forward Atuheire Kipson reduced the arrears three minutes later, thanks to a fumble from Bashundhara's substitute goalkeeper Anisur Rahman, but the home side comfortably held on to the three-goal lead to grab a morale-boosting victory.

Volleyball team finish fourth

Bangladesh volleyball team finished fourth in the AV 1st Asian Men's Volleyball Challenge Cup after losing in straight sets against hosts Sri Lanka in the third-place playoff on Friday.

The men in red and green lost the match by 25-16, 25-17, 25-17 points against the Lankans, who finished third. Iraq won the title, beating Saudi Arabia in the final.

Bangladesh started this eight-nation event with a defeat against Iraq before bouncing back with wins over UAE and Mongolia to emerge group champions. They thrashed Hong Kong in straight sets in the quarterfinals before losing by 3-1 sets against Saudi Arabia in the semifinals.
