

Lawyer sues 5 cops over detention, assault

Police say he was found drunk on road

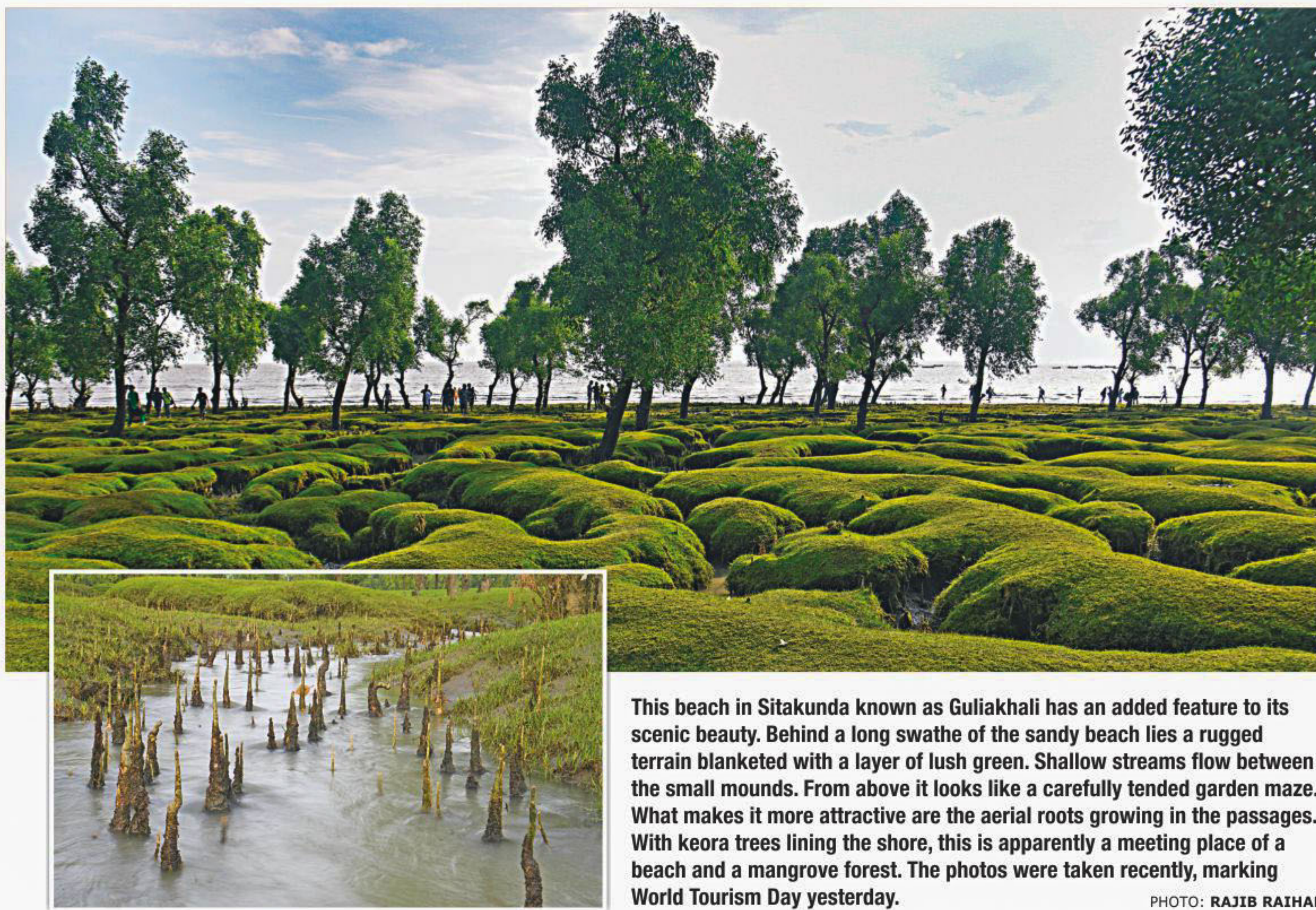
A Chattogram lawyer yesterday filed a case against five police personnel of Patiya Police Station for allegedly detaining and assaulting him on September 17.

Advocate Rigan Acharjya filed the case with the court of Chattogram District and Sessions Judge Md Ismail Hossain, accusing two sub-inspectors, two assistant SIs and a constable, said advocate Selim Chowdhury, who filed the case on his behalf.

The accused are SI Saju Mia, SI Khorsheed, ASI Basir, ASI Masum and constable Humayun.

"After taking the case into cognisance, the court ordered Anti-Corruption Commission to investigate into the case. The court also

Ex-BCL leader beaten up by juniors at DMCH

A former central leader of Bangladesh Chhatra League, the student wing of Awami League, was allegedly beaten up by activists of the same body in the early hours of yesterday at Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH).

BCL activists of different hall units of Dhaka University beat up Ruhul Amin, vice president of recently-dissolved central committee, in presence of its DU unit president Sonjit Chandra Das, over boarding a lift.

According to witnesses, Ruhul, his elder brother and sister-in-law went to the new building of DMCH, to receive the dead body of his brother's mother-in-law, and boarded the elevator at around 12:30am.

A few seconds later, Sonjit's brother and his wife also boarded the elevator along with some of Sonjit's followers.

Ruhul then asked Sonjit's brother to get off the elevator to make room in the crowded lift, and locked into an altercation with him over the matter.

Around 40 minutes after the incident, nearly 100 BCL activists, including Muzahid and Solaiman of Shaheed Sergeant Zahurul Haq Hall, Mariam Sohan of Surja Sen Hall, Mehedi Hasan Shanto of Bangabandhu Shiekh Mujibur Rahman Hall, Hridoy Hasan Sohan of Haji Muhammad Mohsin Hall went to the eighth floor of DMCH and started beating up Ruhul Amin. Sonjit was present during the assault.

The BCL men dragged him to second floor. Ruhul was injured severely in the attack and admitted to DMCH later.

Ruhul, also former general secretary of BCL's Sir A F Rahman Hall unit, held Sonjit responsible for the assault, alleging that Sonjit himself beat him up and tried to label him as "Shibir activist", despite Ruhul introducing himself.

Contacted, Sonjit said he did not know who assaulted Ruhul Amin. "My brother went to DMCH with his wife but Ruhul Amin pushed my brother while boarding the elevator.

Jubo League leader killed in road crash

Rashedunnabi Jewel, president of Rangpur district unit of Jubo League, was killed and two others were injured in a road accident on Bangabandhu Bridge east link road in Tangail yesterday.

Moshraf Hossain, officer-in-charge of Bangabandhu Bridge East Police Station, said Jewel was going to Dhaka from Rangpur in his car.

His SUV collided head-on with a cement-laden truck coming from the opposite direction, near Bhupur link road at 5:30am, leaving all three people on board the vehicle injured, he said.

Police rushed them to Tangail General Hospital where on-duty doctors declared Jewel dead.

Injured driver Sanjit and the other passenger Biplob were referred to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Police seized the truck but its driver and helper managed to escape, the OC added.

ZIA CHARITABLE TRUST GRAFT CASE

Khaleda seeks stay on trial

BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia yesterday filed a revision petition with the High Court (HC) seeking a stay on the proceedings against her in Zia Charitable Trust graft case.

The BNP chief challenged the legality of a trial court decision to continue the proceedings in her absence, and prayed to issue a rule on Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) and the government to explain why the lower court's decision should not be scrapped.

Trial cannot continue if the accused is

sick, her lawyer Barrister Kaiser Kamal said, adding, that setting up a court in old Dhaka jail is unlawful and unconstitutional.

On September 20, a Dhaka court decided to continue the trial of the case inside old Dhaka central jail in her absence.

Meanwhile, a Dhaka court yesterday fixed October 24 for framing charges against Khaleda in cases filed for undermining the national flag and observing "fake birthday" on August 15.

Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate Asaduzzaman Nur set the date. Both the cases were filed in 2016.

Bus kills BADC official in Farmgate

A man was killed after a bus hit him in the capital's Farmgate area yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Sirajul Islam, 55, an assistant accountant of Bangladesh Agricultural Development Corporation (BADC), police said.

"A bus of Shikar Paribahan hit Sirajul," Sub-inspector Amirul Islam of Tejgaon Police Station said.

The incident took place at 8:00am when a bus hit Siraj while he was standing near Ananda Cinema Hall, said his brother-in-law Shafiqur Rahman, leaving him seriously injured.

Locals rushed him to a nearby hospital from where he was taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital, where doctors declared him dead around 11:45am, said Sub-Inspector Bachchu Mia, in-charge of DMCH police outpost.

Sirajul used to live with his family in East Rajabazar area, Shafiqur added. Police seized the bus and detained the driver and a case was filed in this connection.

Bangladesh needs sustained support for Rohingyas: WB

World Bank Vice President for South Asia Region Hartwig Schafer yesterday said the world needs to provide sustained support to Bangladesh, to meet the urgent needs of the Rohingyas as well as the host community in Cox's Bazar.

After visiting Rohingya camps in Cox's Bazar district, including the Kutupalong camp – the world's largest and most congested refugee camp – Schafer praised the government and the people of Bangladesh for their generous efforts that saved thousands of lives as the Rohingyas fled violence in Myanmar.

"Despite its own challenges, Bangladesh shelters nearly one million Rohingya, mostly women and children. Bangladesh has also ably coordinated humanitarian support and provided for basic needs," he said as he concluded a weeklong visit to the country.

"But the need is much larger... The global community cannot afford to become distracted from this crisis and needs to provide more support," he said.

During his visit, Schafer also visited the Ghorashal power plant, where the World Bank is helping improve efficiency and double electricity generation capacity.

In Dhaka, he participated in the launch of a World Bank report entitled "South Asia's hotspots: the impact of temperature and precipitations changes on living standards".

He also met the finance minister, the water resources minister and other senior government officials.

Suspected robber killed in 'shootout' with police

A suspected robber was killed and five members of police were injured in a "gunfight between a group of robbers and police" in Uttar Kattoli embankment area of Chattogram city early yesterday.

The man was identified as Mohammad Sabuj alias Pichchi Sabuj, 25, son of Mohammad Ibrahim from Shapla residential area of Akbarshah.

Following the gunfight, police arrested another suspected robber, Kayes Uddin Opu, 25, and recovered four firearms

including two pistols, two light guns and bullets, said police.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) Sadip Kumar Das of Pahartoli Police Station told The Daily Star that the injured members of police including Sub-Inspector Ornab, ASI Mitu Das and Constable Belayet Hossain were given primary treatment after the incident.

The gunfight took place around 12:45am when police went to Uttar Kattoli beribadh area of Pahartoli to arrest a group of armed robbers who were preparing to commit robbery, he said.
