NEED FOR SPEED

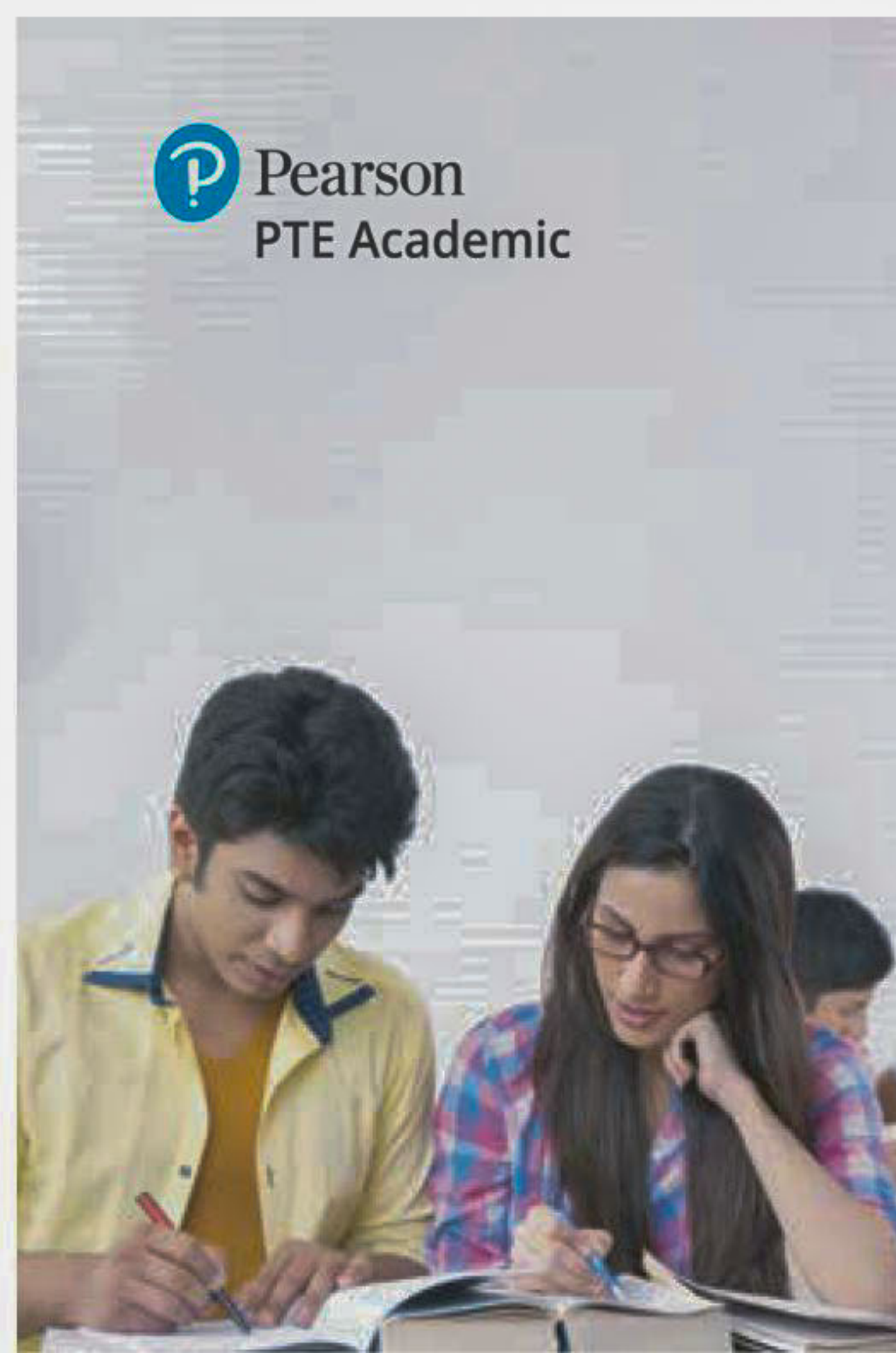
