BUDDHIST TEMPLE DESTRUCTION Probarana celebration muted in Khagrachhari

Protesting the attack on Buddhist temple in Kukichhara, the Yongdha Buddha Bihar of Khagrachhari town yesterday suspended some celebrations of Probarana Purnima.

Mahendha Mahathero, a senior monk at the century-old temple, said they did not observe lighting of candles, floating clay lamps in the river, and flying sky lanterns as traditional observances.

However, some programmes took place in the morning, as the decision was taken in the afternoon, he said.

"The holy Prabarana Purnima is a happy day for the Buddhist community. We don't have words to protest the brutal attack," he added.

Neong Marma, convener of Prabarana Purnima Udjapon Committee at the temple, said they supported the decision made by monks.

Miscreants vandalised Jatobon Buddhist Temple and a seven-foot Buddha statue at Kukichhara village in Guimara upazila on Monday night, a day before the Prabarana Purnima, one of the biggest religious occasions of Buddhists.

Panic gripped local Buddhists who were taking preparations to celebrate the religious festival.

Kala Marma, a member of Hafchari Union Parishad in Guimara, said local public representatives and government

officials including Kongjari Chowdhury, chairman of Khagrachhari Hill District Council, yesterday held a meeting with locals in Kukichhara over the incident. Meanwhile, Chattogram Hill Tracts Commission yesterday

condemned the "barbaric" incident, and demanded that the perpetrators be identified and brought to book immediately.

In a statement, it urged the government to form a fair and impartial body to probe the incident.

Found microbus had been stolen: police

The microbus which was recovered with four bullet-hit bodies in Narayanganj recently had been stolen four days beforehand, police claimed yesterday.

A general dairy (GD) was also filed regarding the theft with Rampura Police Station in Dhaka, said Monirul Islam, assistant superintendent of police (administration) of Narayanganj.

That same evening some plainclothes men allegedly picked up three of the four from Purinda area in Narayanganj's Araihazar, according to family members. The four bodies were found beside the

road in Araihazar upazila on Sunday. They all bore bullet wounds in the back of their heads from a shotgun fired at close range, say autopsy reports.

The four are Faruk Hossain, 35, his friends Jahirul Islam, 24, and Sabuj Sarder, 24, of Pabna Sadar upazila and microbus driver Lutfor Mollah. Another youth, Liton Hossain, was also picked up, claimed family members. He is still missing. ASP Monirul Islam said a smart registra-

tion card of the microbus was found inside the vehicle. The card bears the name of one

Station M Abdul Haq said microbus owner Rafique once called him to report the missing car. When police contacted him later, Rafique said the vehicle was stolen on October 17, and he filed a GD on October 19, the OC said, adding the phone has been found switched off since then.

Reshma Akter, wife of microbus driver Lutfor, said her husband left their Rampura home with the vehicle around 6:00pm on Friday. When she did not hear from him till 1:00am on Saturday, she filed a GD with Rampura Police Station later that day, she said.

Families claimed that the four were arrested by people identifying themselves as police.

Meanwhile, police formed a three-member committee, led by Additional Deputy Inspector General (DIG) Abu Kalam Siddique of Dhaka Range, to investigate the "negative news reports" published in newspapers regarding the deaths of the four "unidentified" men.

The committee was asked to submit an "objective report", according to an order signed by Chowdhury Abdullah Al Mamun, DIG, Dhaka Range.

Quoting family members, the media reported that four youths were picked up by plainclothes police and that the wife of one of the deceased men met him in police custody before they were found dead.

Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology, Dhaka-1000 | Half of world's Irrawaddy dolphins in Bangladesh: survey

The Sundarbans and its adjacent areas are one of the major sanctuaries of two globally-endangered river dolphins, Ganges River Dolphin and Irrawaddy Dolphin, an ongoing

survey has found. Six hotspots and some semi-hotspots of the two species of dolphins have already been identified there. The hotspots and semi-hotspots cover an area of around 982 square kilometres.

Findings of the survey, which will be concluded in 2019, were shared at the inauguration ceremony of International Freshwater Dolphin Day yesterday, at Liberation War Museum in Dhaka. Forest Department, United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) jointly conducted the survey under a project titled "Expanding the Protected Area System to Incorporate Important Aquatic Ecosystem (EPASIIAE)".

ABM Sarowar Alam, project manager of IUCN and a researcher of the survey, told The Daily Star that the Irrawaddy dolphins are in better conditions in Bangladesh than any other parts of the world.

"Irrawaddy dolphins are critically endangered. Their global population is around 7,000, and at least half of them are currently living in the country, which is remarkable," said Sarowar.

Monirul H Khan, a professor of Jahangirnagar University who led the survey, said dolphins are threatened here, but they could survive as the country has many estuarine and sufficient fish to eat in rivers.

Incidental killing by fishing nets, poison fishing, decrease of freshwater flow and siltation are major threats to dolphins, he said.

The survey also found that seven species of dolphin currently inhabit Bangladesh. Apart from the aforementioned two, the other species are found in Bay of Bengal.

Environment Minister Anisul Islam Mahmud and Deputy Minister Abdullah Al Islam Jacob also spoke at the event.

leave within three days of informing the authorities. If the factory authorities do not allow her to go on leave, they will be fined Tk 25,000.

Besides, if a worker works during any festival, they will get a one-day leave and wage for two days after the festival.

Both owners and workers will be sentenced to one-year jail with a fine of Tk 10,000 for misconduct, which was two years in the previous law.

In case of natural death, family of the worker concerned will get Tk 2 lakh as compensation, which was Tk 1 lakh in the previous law. In case of injury, compensation will be Tk 2.5 lakh, which is currently Tk 1.25 lakh.

The support of 51 percent workers is needed (against present two-thirds of total workers) to call a strike. Illegal enforcement of strike will also be considered misconduct. If anyone is found to be a member of multiple trade unions

simultaneously, they will be sentenced to one month's imprisonment, which was six months in the previous law.

2 killed, 30 hurt as bus veers off road 4 more die in road

allegedly racing another in Rangpur's Pirganj upazila on Tuesday night, killing two people and injuring at least 30 others. Swaraj Chandra, officer-

in-charge (OC) of Pirganj Police Station said a Dhaka-bound bus of United Paribahan hit a bus of GR Paribahan before skidding off the road, killing one person on spot and injuring 31 passengers. Another victim succumbed to his injuries on the way hospital, he said, adding that others were being treated in different hospitals in Rangpur.

In Bogura, a three-yearold boy died after being hit by a human-haulier in Sariakandi upazila yesterday, reports our correspondent. Police said a case was filed.

In Joypurhat, Gopal Chandra, 67, died after being hit by a three-wheeler in Akkelpur upazila on Tuesday, local police said. Meanwhile, two people

were killed as a speeding bus hit their motorbike in Santhia upazila of Dhaka-Pabna highway on Tuesday. The accident took place at Rajapur rail gate area, said OC of Santhia Police Station. Another passenger was injured in the incident.
