CLASH OVER TOLL HIKE Over 600 people sued

A case was filed against 31 named and 600 unnamed people Saturday night in connection with Friday's violent clash between transport workers and police over toll hike on First Bangladesh-China Friendship (Buriganga-1) Bridge, that left one person dead and scores hurt.
Sub-inspector of South Keraniganj Police Station

Ashrafur Alam Talukder filed the case on charges of assault, Officer-in-Charge of the police station, Mohammad Shahjaman, told The Daily Star.
Names of some people who were injured in the incident are also mentioned in the case, the OC said.
However, one was arrested till filling this report around 8:00pm yesterday.
Earlier on Friday, Sohail Hawlader, 25, helper of a truck

driver, was killed after police opened fire during a clash with transport workers and locals. Over 100 others were injured during the clash, including 25 policemen.
Mosharraf Sarder, father-in-law of Sohail, said they are still in Barishal to complete Sohail's burial. "We will hopefully reach Dhaka today and will file a case," he said.
Since the incident, toll collection on the bridge has remained suspended.

Drug-carrying jailer now suspended

Prisons authorities yesterday suspended Sohail Rana Biswas, jailer of Chattogram Central Jail, who was arrested with over Tk 44 lakh, fixed deposit receipts (FDRs) worth Tk 2.50 crore and Phensedyl from Kishoreganj on Friday.
"We were waiting for the First Information Report (FIR) filed by police. Once it reached of us, we suspended him immediately," Brig Gen Syed Iftakhar Uddin, inspector general of prisons, told The Daily Star yesterday.
A three-member probe body headed by Deputy Inspector General (Barisal Range) of Prison was also formed to investigate the incident, he said. It was directed to submit a report by November 12, he said.
Sohail was travelling to his hometown Mymensingh from Chattogram by train when police, acting on information, raided it at Bhairab Railway Station at around 1:30pm. They recovered 12 bottles of Phensedyl from his bag.
Sohail was later produced before a Kishoreganj court with a seven-day remand prayer on Saturday. The court fixed today (Monday) to hear the remand prayer, said court inspector Toufiq Ahmed.
Sohail is currently in Kishoreganj jail.

ATTACK ON GONOSHASTHAYA, LIMON ASK demands action

Ain o Salish Kendra (ASK) in a press statement yesterday strongly condemned police's refusal to register any case following the attack on Gonoshasthaya Kendra and physical assault on Limon Hossain.

small distance intervals while coming to Cumilla from Chandina. It cost me Tk 200, whereas the normal bus fare is Tk 30," said Monirul Islam, 55, a bank employee.

No buses set off from three inter-district bus stations in Cumilla, on the Dhaka-Chattogram highway, Cumilla-Sylhet highway, and Cumilla-Chandpur and Cumilla-Noakhali regional highways since morning.

Transport workers along with some other seemingly-enthusiastic people occupied the roads. This correspondent saw some of them harassing commuters and pedestrians, while in some places highway police were seen just standing by. No additional enforcement of police was found at any important points on the highways.

The agitating transport workers could not show any valid ID when the newspaper asked which organisation they were representing.

Kazi Motaher Hossain, general secretary of district transport workers' union, said, "The transport workers are abstaining from work to press home their eight-point demand including corrections of the road transport act. If the government doesn't accept our demands within 48 hours, we will go on strike for an indefinite period until our demands are met."

MYMENSINGH

Like elsewhere, commuters in Mymensingh had to suffer due to the ongoing strike.

Hawa Begum managed to arrive at the

Mymensingh court for some urgent work as she left home early in the morning yesterday.

After getting her work done, she tried in vain for about an hour -- with her six-month-old baby in her arms -- to find a transport to return home in Shaheed Kachari area of Mymensingh Sadar upazila.

She was just one of many others who remained stranded on the road due to shortage of transport.

Jahangir Alam Khan from Phulpur upazila was waiting near Shambhuganj bridge. He said he had to come to Mymensingh city for an urgent medical test at Mymensingh Medical College Hospital. But without any vehicle on the road, he wondered how he would go back home.

"I had to spend around Tk 350 to reach the hospital, which usually costs Tk 50. I had to travel on a rickshaw-van, an auto-rickshaw and a motorbike," he said.

The train station also witnessed a huge rush of passengers.

Meanwhile, a number of commuters and auto-rickshaw drivers told this correspondent that many transport workers were stopping and harassing vehicles at different points.

Ali Hossain, publicity secretary of Mymensingh District Transport Workers Union, said transport workers were only picketing at different points to press home their demands. He, however, claimed that the workers were not obstructing movements of rickshaws, rickshaw-vans and battery-run auto-rickshaws.
