At this time five policemen including OC (Investigation) Alamgir Kabir and two sub-inspectors were injured."

"Fifteen people were detained for their suspected involvement with the clashes. Police filed a case against 65 named and unnamed 100 to 150 people as locals attacked cops on the spot. A police team has been deployed at the village to avert further clash," he said.

"They were laughing at us. We waited till 5:00pm and then returned home on foot. My daughter died around 7:00pm," said a sobbing Hamida, who has two other school-going children.

Hamida's husband died a year ago and her mother-inlaw, who works as a house help, is the sole breadwinner of the family.

She fears that filing a case over the matter might get her into more trouble.

Shukria is not the only child to have died during and allegedly because of the strike. Two other infants -- one in Moulvibazar and the other in Sunamganj -- died on their way to hospitals as alleged transport workers obstructed them during the two days.

The deaths triggered outrage on social media. Many were shocked that transport workers not only took away people's right to movement but also their right to access healthcare.

Many transport workers' leaders were quick to wash their hands of the incidents.

The families have demanded justice while investigation in one case was initiated after the family concerned filed a case.

Akbar Ali, uncle of a victim, filed a murder case with Baralekha Police Station against 160-170 unidentified people on Wednesday night. His seven-day-old niece

died in Chandgram of Moulvibazar on the first day of the strike as alleged transport workers held the ambulance carrying the girl to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital. Sayera Begum, mother of

the girl, is yet to recover from the shock. "They took away the ambulance key and beat up the driver," recalled Sayera at her Ojmir village home in Baralekha. The third victim is a two-

day-old boy who reportedly died on the same day at

Dakshin Sunamganj upazila in Sunamganj. Moinul Islam, father of the

baby boy, said his devastated wife had to be hospitalised. Most leaders of Bangladesh Road Transport Workers Federation that

called the strike denied that their men were behind the incidents.

However, Selim Ahme Fotik, president o Bangladesh Road Transpor Workers Federation (Sylhe division), has demanded punishment of the transpor workers who obstructed th vehicles. He assured that h organisation would no support workers foun guilty of the offences.

After a writ petition wa filed with the High Court ove the deaths of the three chi dren, the court on Wednesda issued a rule upon the inspec tor general of police to tak action against the peopl responsible for the deaths.

Kamrul Ahsan, deput inspector general (Sylhe range), said the IGP's office was yet to issue an instruction following the HC directive bu investigation was on in th case that has been filed b Akbar Ali.

The DIG, however, said h was not aware of the other incident reported Baralekha. "As far as I know the infant in Dakshi Sunamganj upazila died home. We will take action the family files a case."

Smuggling of illegal drug on rise

16,500 ampoules of buprenorphine seized in Joypurhat in 9 months

Different points of bordering district Joypurhat sees massive smuggling of illegal drug buprenorphine (also called suboxone), much to the worry of law enforcers and conscious citizens.

Police, Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) and Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in the district seized at least 16,500 ampoules of buprenorphine injection from different places of Joypurhat and arrested several people in this connection during the last nine months.

The drug used in treatment of opioid in a few countries, is a banned item in Bangladesh, said officials of law enforcement agencies.

But with its current availability, it is being abused mostly by cocaine takers, they said.

Flow of different intoxicants including cocaine, Phensidyl and ganja have gone down with the start of antinarcotic drive across the country a couple of months ago, but the relatively new drug buprenorphine seem to be coming from India through different border areas as its small ampoules can be easily

carried, said Rab and police official in

On August 13, one Zia Uddin was arrested with 375 ampoules of

buprenorphine. In September, 649 ampoules of buprenorphine was seized from across the district.

Abul Khayer, commanding officer of Joypurhat Crime Prevention Camp of Rab, said most of the drug peddlers in the area have gone into hiding as they are active to prevent the spread of such

illegal drugs.

The police are conducting drives in the district to nab the illegal drug traders, said Rashidul Hasan, superintendent of police of Joypurhat.

Members of BGB are also active in the border areas, said Rashed Mohammed Anisul Haque, commanding officer of Joypurhat BGB 20 Battalion.

Mahbubur Hossain, director of Udoy Rehabilitation Centre in Joypurhat, said around 20 percent of the patients coming for drug abuse treatment were takers of buprenorphine.

Dr Habibul Ahsan Talukdar, civil surgeon of Joypurhat, said takers of buprenorphine face the risk of heart and kidney diseases.

Buprenorphine is banned in Bangladesh as an A category drug under the Narcotics Control Act enacted in 1990, said Mohammad Shahidul Mannaf Kabir, former assistant director of the Department of The elite force arrested Tarazul Islam Narcotics Control in Dinajpur (now posted in Panchagarh).

"However, it is used for anti-drug Panchbibi upazila of Joypurhat on treatment in a few countries. In some other countries, it is used as a medicine Another Rab team arrested Rezaul Islam for animals," he added.
