

Evaluate health of Barrister Mainul

HC directs BSMMU

The High Court yesterday directed Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University (BSMMU) to form a medical board to evaluate the reports on the health of Barrister Mainul Hossain, and submit a report before it on November 28.

The court also asked the government to provide adequate security to Mainul Hossain while being produced before the courts concerned, in connection with cases against him.

The court also set November 20 to pass an order over the treatment for Mainul, his lawyer Advocate Khandker Mahbub Hossain told The Daily Star.

The HC bench of Justice Syed Refaat Ahmed and Justice Md Iqbal Kabir passed the orders, after hearing two writ petitions filed by Mainul's wife Saju Hossein on November 2.

In one petition, Saju challenged government's "failure and inaction" to provide adequate security to Mainul, to prevent a recent attack on him at Rangpur court.

In another petition, she sought an HC order on the authorities to admit Mainul, a former caretaker government adviser, to a specialised hospital in Dhaka, saying he is suffering from diabetes, heart and kidney ailments.

Khandker Mahbub Hossain said Rangpur Medical College Hospital (RMCH) had earlier submitted a medical report to the HC, saying that Barrister Mainul's health condition is stable.

"We have also submitted some medical documents to the High Court saying that Barrister Mainul Hossain has been suffering from different health complications including heart problems. So, he needs to be admitted to a hospital," he said.

Mainul was arrested on October 22 in a case filed for defaming journalist Masuda Bhatti on a television talk-show.

to quit the habit of using rivers as a "junk bean or dumping ground" through frequent garbage disposal.

Chairman of National River Conservation Commission (NRCC) Muzibur Rahman Howlader said, "It is a fact that our elected lawmakers, their relatives and close people are involved in the grabbing of river land."

He said no one, not even the country's president, is authorised to acquire or lease the land of the river.

Urging the deputy commissioners (DCs) of all districts to prevent grabbing, Muzibur said, "One week is enough to reclaim the grabbed parts of the rivers if the DCs want to

do so."

Nodi Bachao Andolon's Joint Organising Secretary Prof Amirul Islam said a group of people, under the umbrella of the ruling quarter, extract sand illegally from near the riverbank.

As a result, the river starts to flow close to the bank, instead of through the middle, and causes erosion, he said, demanding a stop to such sand extraction.

The platform's President Prof Anwar Sadat said political goodwill is a must to protect the rivers.

Writer-columnist Syed Abul Maksud urged people to raise their voice against river grabbing and pollution.

reached 3,800 households with mobile money transfers in a test of the system's ability to disburse cash rapidly in the event of a disaster.

This partnership with Koica follows the successful implementation of the three-year Saemaul Zero Hunger Communities Project (2014-2017) with a contribution of US \$3 million. Under this project, communities engaged in disaster risk

reduction work received cash grants and allowances to build their economic resilience.

"These activities were designed based on the Saemaul Undong principle of self-help, diligence, and cooperation with participation and contribution based on Korea's community development experience," said Joe Hyungue, Koica country director for Bangladesh.

Sonali Bank's decision to reschedule the loan.

The issues regarding the Adalat's order was not challenged in the writ petition, on which the HC has stayed the loan rescheduling, the lawyer added.

Following a writ petition filed by Patuakhali AL President Ziaul Haque, the HC on November 22 stayed the banks' decisions.

The HC also issued a rule, asking the Sonali Bank and the BB authorities concerned to explain why their failure to discharge duties in accordance with the law over rescheduling of the bank loans should not be declared illegal.

Barrister M Amir-Ul Islam argued for Feroz, while Barrister Rakanuddin Mahmud, Barrister Ajmalul Hossain and Barrister Mainul Islam appeared for the writ petitioner.

BNP leader Rafiqul Islam hospitalised

BNP standing committee member Barrister Rafiqul Islam Miah was taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) yesterday evening from Keraniganj Central Jail, after he fell sick.

He was admitted to the hospital around 5:50pm, said DMCH police outpost ASI Abdullah Khan, adding that the veteran BNP leader has been suffering from diarrhoea, diabetes and high blood pressure. He was receiving treatment at DMCH's medicine department, the ASI said.

On November 20, Rafiqul Islam Miah was arrested by plainclothes police hours after a Dhaka court had sentenced him to three years' jail in a graft case.

Mahatab Uddin, 50, and Abdul Kader, 65, were killed and 2 others injured as a bus they were in plunged into a ditch on Kushtia-Rajbari highway in Khoksa area, reports UNB.

In Mirpur upazila, motorcyclist Masud Hossain, 50, was killed as a bus hit his bike in Botoila area.

Masudur Rahman, sub-inspector of Kushtia Model Police Station, died when a truck hit his motorbike on Kushtia-Jhenidah highway in Kushtia Sadar upazila.

In Shariatpur, Al-Amin, 22, helper of a bus driver, was killed after being run over by the vehicle as he fell down from it on Shariatpur-Madaripur highway.

In Bagerhat, motorcyclist Zahid Hossain, 40, was killed and another injured after the bike was hit by a human haulier on Khulna-Mawa highway in Fakirhat upazila.

sociology of DU, and AL's nomination aspirant for Bhola-4 constituency, claimed that the university is run by the DU Ordinance 1973, which does not impose any such legal bar for teachers to run in the polls.

According to Article 56 (2) of the 1973 ordinance, "...Provided if a teacher or other salaried employee of the University seeks election as a Member of Parliament, he shall before the date for filing nomination resign from the service of the University."

The Jagannath University Ordinance 2005 also states a similar provision.

Other AL nomination aspirants are Chairman of DU's oceanography department Jobaer Alam; Institute of Business Administration's (IBA) Prof Abu Yusuf Mohammad Abdullah for Satkhira-3; law teacher Dr Selim Mahmud for Chandpur-1; and Jagannath University's Islamic his-

tory and culture department teacher Dr Shamsul Kabir for Laxmipur-4.

BNP nomination hopefuls are DU's physics professor ABM Obaidul Islam for Bagerhat-4 and biochemistry and molecular biology professor Dr Mamun Ahmed for Laxmipur-1.

DU's political science professor Nurul Amin Bepari, also president of a portion of Bikalpa Dhara Bangladesh, wants to contest under the banner of the BNP-led alliance.

The Daily Star talked to six of the aspirants. All of them echoed each other, saying that the university ordinances, not RPO, should be applicable for them.

One of the aspirants, Dr Selim Mahmud, demanded an amendment to RPO so that university teachers can run the election immediately after resigning from their post while filing nomination papers, and the three year-timeframe does not apply to them.

and Children Affairs Meher Afroze Chumki inaugurated the fair as chief guest. It was organised by Ministry of Women and Children Affairs in association with UNFPA and UN Women, Bangladesh.

According to the VAW (violence against women) survey 2015, conducted by Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS), three out of four ever-married women (73 percent) experienced some form of violence by their husbands.

Among those women and girls, only 2.6 percent took legal actions while the rest did not due to fear of their dignity, privacy, confidentiality, security and protection from harm or retribution.

"In order to eliminate gender-based violence, we have to nurture our girls properly. We have to stop dominating their choices, dreams and visions. They should be given the freedom to be their own person and should be taught to be strong and independent as opposed to being shy and submissive," said Nasima Begum, secretary of the ministry, at the event.
