number is 71.1 percent among married women in urban areas. This year's data, until now, from rights body Ain o Salish Kendra and 9 newspapers gives a grim picture too.

In the last 10 months, 40 girl children and 1,420 women have been raped, 112 girls and women have faced sexual harassment, and 22 have suffered acid violence. Moreover, 160 women have been subjected to domestic violence while 152 have been tortured and killed for dowry.

Speakers at the rally said implementation of existing laws and awareness at all levels are necessary to stop incidence of violence against women.

Men should also come forward to ensure a society where women would have the courage to speak up against any kind of violence and harassment perpetrated against them, said MJF Executive Director Shaheen Anam at the rally.

Khulna gets a brand new train station DIPANKAR ROY, Khulna

train station in Khulna yesterday morning around 8:40am. On March 3, 2018 Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurated the station but some technical and administrative work caused the delay in starting formal operations.

Dhaka-bound "Chitra Express" left the newly-constructed

Rail service first began in Khulna on February 16, 1884 Trains from the station went to different parts of the then East Bengal (now Bangladesh) as well as Kolkata.

Commuters had been facing difficulty to board trains as the platform was 42 inches high. People of the region were demanding a modern rail station in Khulna.

Md Majibur Rahman, managing director of Bangladesh Railway (West Zone), officially inaugurated the operation at the new railway station while local high-ups and public representatives were present.

Construction of the project started in April 2015 - after Ecnec approval on January 26, 2014 - at a cost of Tk 56 crore. However, the cost finally went up to Tk 61 crore and 27 lakh. The three-storied railway station building has six ticket counters, waiting rooms, room for assistant station manager on

the first floor; a room for station manager, restaurant, branches of banks, food court and rooms for staff on the second floor; and rooms for railway engineers on the third floor. The station comprises of three platforms that can accommodate six trains at the same time. Besides demarcation

wall, 4,000 square metre of car parking space, link corridor, footpath and roads were constructed. The station can accommodate 10,000-12,000 passengers

Arrest all rapists, stalkers

Women's rights activists demand at M'singh press conference after filing of a case with Trishal Police Station the

was arrested in the case till date.

Terming rape and sexual harassment crimes against humanity, women's rights activists at a press conference in Mymensingh yesterday said such crimes are on the rise, and demanded immediate arrest of perpetrators. Mymensingh unit of Bangladesh Mahila Parishad

organised the programme at the city's press club. Reading out a written statement, Parishad

Secretary Fahmida Yeasmin Runa presented 10 incidents of crime that took place in different parts of Mymensingh in the last eight months. In one of the incidents, a 13-year-old girl with physical disability was raped by her neighbour in

Gafargaon upazila on November 11 but the accused still remain on the loose. On September 16, a second-grade schoolgirl was raped in Paranganj area of Sadar upazila. No one

On September 14, a 12-year-old schoolgirl was gang raped by five youths in Trishal upazila. So far,

following day, only two of the accused were arrested. On August 29, a young mother was raped by ten

youths in Kolapara. Her husband filed a case the next day, but only one accused has so far been arrested. On August 19, a schoolgirl was stabbed by her

stalker in Baghmara area of the town as she rejected the attacker's consecutive proposals. After her father filed a case, police arrested all four accused including the prime one Sajjad Hossain. On July 29, an 11-year-old speech-impaired girl

was raped by her neighbour in Tarakanda upazila. The accused is now on bail. Among others, Parishad president Monira

Begum Anu, vice president Lila Roy and former president Ferdous Ara Mahmuda Helen were present at the press conference. Contacted, SA Newazi, additional superinten-

dent of police (crime) in Mymensingh, said, "Police have already arrested many of the accused in the above-mentioned cases. Drives are on so all the accused can be arrested soon."

Petition challenges polls schedule with parliament intact

A Supreme Court lawyer yesterday filed a writ petition with the High Court, challenging the legality of announcing schedule for the 11th parliamentary election before dissolving the parliament.

Advocate Eunus Ali Akond filed the petition, seeking a stay on the schedule that was issued on November 12 by the Election Commission (EC) for holding the election on December 30.

In the petition, he said as per article 123 (3) of the constitution, the general election has to be held within 90 days after the parliament is dissolved. However, the EC has announced schedule for the election on December 30, while the current parliament is still undissolved.

The petition also stated that as per article 12 of the Representation of the People Order (RPO) and article 66 (2)(f), a person holding the post of profit in government service cannot be qualified for contesting the parliamentary election.

Many members of the current parliament, who are receiving remuneration from the state, are reportedly contesting the upcoming parliamentary election. Hence, the upcoming polls cannot be held keeping the current parliament intact, the petition said.
