JU expels three, suspends two BCL men

The Jahangirnagar University (JU) authorities yesterday expelled three Bangladesh Chhatra League activists and suspended two others over beating and mugging students on the campus.

Sohel Rana, Mustafizur Rahman and Ya Rafiu Sikder Apon of public administration department were expelled while Md Sajib Kazi and Asif Ahmed of Bangla department were suspended for two years.

The syndicate presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof Farzana Islam took the decision as per recommendations of JU disciplinary committee, said Acting Registrar Rahima Kaniz.

On Sunday, the five men mugged Zahidur Rahman Arnab, a student of Institute of Business Administration at JU and his companion in Botanical Garden area.

After hearing the incident, the five were handed over to the university authorities, said JU BCL President Jewel Rana. However, he claimed that the five are not BCL activists. "We demand the highest punishment for the accused," he added.

Earlier in September, Sohel, Mustafiz and Rafiu allegedly beat up a reporter and mugged two others on the campus.

Enact law to protect people's right to food

Speakers urge political parties at roundtable

Political parties must pledge in their election manifestos to formulate a law that will protect people's right to food, said speakers at a roundtable discussion yesterday.

They said the act will help ensure food security of the poor and play a significant role in reducing malnutrition. Bangla daily Prothom Alo in association with Right to Food Bangladesh, a platform of food security campaigners, and ICCO Cooperation, a Netherlands-based organisation,

held the roundtable on "election manifesto and food rights act" at the newspaper's office in Dhaka. Citing recent government statis-

tics, Right to Food Bangladesh General Secretary Mohsin Ali said about 3.55 crore people in the country are poor. Of them, 2 crore are extremely poor.

dren are the worse sufferers of the situation, he said in his keynote presentation.

"If the next government enacts such a right to food act and implement it properly, we will be able to achieve the sustainable development goals (SDGs) within 2030, said Mohsin, adding that the act will also help the country become a middle-income one.

Within a couple of minutes, they were nowhere to be found, he said.

Omar Faroque, officer-in-charge of Motijheel Police Station, said the claim of procession in the area was only a rumour as no such incident took place there.

A similar procession was brought out in Dhanmondi near Road 15 around 5:00pm.

It recommended the state to ensure that appropriate information is disseminated among women to make them aware of resources and channels to safely file legal complaints and grievances.

Speaking at the programme, ActionAid Bangladesh Country Director Farah Kabir said situation of violence against women did not improve much in the country over the years.

A "socially accepting attitude" towards gender violence was instrumental for this prevalence, she said.

Women's rights activist Khushi Kabir said violence against women in the country reached a level where its recurrence does not "surprise" anyone.

She said people are more concerned about violent incidents and justice.

"However, such violent incidents are the last stage of a 'controlling attitude' towards women that prevails due to patriarchic structure of the society," she added.

Meanwhile, ActionAid Bangladesh opened a three-day cartoon exhibition, "#FemiToon", at Drik Gallery on the theme of violence against women and featuring works of young cartoonists from different parts of the country.


