

'Kidnapped' boy found dead in Gazipur

A 10-year-old boy was found dead in Sreenagar upazila of Gazipur yesterday, six days after he was allegedly kidnapped.

The boy -- Sadman Iqbal Rakin, son of a Shamim Iqbal -- had appeared for primary education completion examination from Faugan Government Primary School this year.

Informed by locals, police recovered his body from a bamboo grove in Faugan area.

Sreenagar Police Station Sub-Inspector Shahidul Islam said the boy might have been strangled.

Sadman was missing since he went to a mosque near his home in the area for evening prayers on December 5, said his uncle Jahidul Islam.

An hour later, the boy's father received a phone call from his wife's number, of which the SIM card had been lost previously. The caller demanded Tk 10 lakh for his son's release, said Jahidul.

Afterwards, the phone was found switched off, he added.

Sadman's father filed a case in connection with the incident, said SI Shahidul.

A half-baked solution

In DSCC, the total length of road medians is 46.14 kilometres. DSCC has so far erected barbed wire fences on 17.6 kilometres of medians. Median crossings are still open in some places, while some are fenced with iron rods and pipes.

According to DSCC estimates, about Tk 10 lakh was used for fencing 9 kilometre long median in zone-1, Tk 8 lakh for three kilometres in zone-2, Tk 3.5 lakh for 1.3 kilometres in zone-3, Tk 6.31 lakh for two kilometres in zone-4 and Tk 3.27 lakh for 2.3 kilometres in zone-5.

DSCC carried out the work through contractors, who were awarded frame-

work contracts for one year.

WHY THE RUSH?
In August, the country saw unprecedented student protests for road safety. Thousands from various schools, colleges and universities took to the streets for nearly a week, after two college students were run over by a recklessly-driven bus in the capital.

Following the incident, Principal Secretary to the Prime Minister, Md Nojibur Rahman, sat with high-ups of DSCC at the latter's headquarters.

At that meeting, DSCC was given a number of directives to ensure road safety. Of those, one was of sealing road medians to stop random road crossing by pedestrians.

Later, in a hasty move, DSCC

installed bamboo sticks and tangled barbed wires on the median strips.

"PMO gave us directives to stop it [jaywalking] immediately, even if it was by using barbed wire and bamboo stumps," said DSCC's Additional Engineer Asaduzzaman.

"At least, we've managed to stop haphazard road crossing," he claimed. "If properly maintained, these will last for about four years," Asaduzzaman said, adding they will replace these in future.

Talking to The Daily Star, PM's Principal Secretary Nojibur Rahman said, "Durable materials need to be used, otherwise it [the road median fencing] will not bear any fruit."

"We'll instruct them not to use anything that is not durable," he added.

3 die after drinking rectified spirit

Three persons died at Chattogram Medical College Hospital (CMCH) after they drank rectified spirit yesterday, according to police inquest reports.

Hanif, 61, Abdus Sattar, 62, and Arbindu Guha, 72, were hospitalised after they fell sick in Sharikait area of Sandwip upazila, said Sandwip Police Station Officer-in-Charge Mohammad Shahjahan.

Sub-Inspector Prabhat Babu, who prepared the inquest report, said their family members refused to talk about their deaths. The inquest reports were made following primary inquiry and medical reports.

The bench of Justice Krishna Debnath and Justice Shahidul Karim delivered the verdict after hearing the death reference and appeals filed by the accused challenging the trial court's judgement.

Kalidas Boral, also the former chairman of Chitalmari Upazila Parishad and a local Awami League leader, was shot dead by miscreants in Bagerhat in 2000.

In June 2013, a Bagerhat court sentenced five people to death while three others to life imprisonment in the case.

Meanwhile, Deputy Attorney General MA Mannan Mohan said that the government will move an appeal before the apex court challenging the HC verdict directing the acquittals.

Two toddlers drown in water tank

Two toddlers died in the capital's Mohammadpur last evening, after falling into a water tank while playing.

They are three-year old Habib, son of Mostafa; and three-and-half-year old Maria, daughter of Moni Mridha.

They fell into the tank at Dhaka Udyan area while they were playing nearby, Officer-in-Charge Jamal Uddin Mir of Mohammadpur Police Station told The Daily Star.

Police recovered the bodies around 8pm and rushed them to Shyamoli Children's Hospital where doctors declared them dead.

Md Shah Alam, technical head of Brac's Humanitarian Crisis Management Programme, said they carried out the study to assess the needs and preparedness of the Rohingya community for winter under the Communication for Development project.

"Earlier, we studied the monsoon preparedness in Rohingya camps and got good results after taking steps based on it."

If all aid agencies and take preparations to provide services, it would make the camp comfortable for Rohingyas, he added. Refugee, Relief and Rehabilitation Commissioner Mohammed Abul Kalam said, "We got assurance from the Indian government that they will provide blankets for one lakh Rohingya families. We are taking initiatives in coordination with donor agencies to find a way to deal with winter needs."

He said they have, in a small scale, started distributing warm clothes among Rohingya families and hope to receive the Indian assistance this week.
