



# What can election data tell us about voting patterns and the last election itself?

The % of votes received by each candidate is an indication of the political fault-lines of a community. In these five constituencies, the % of votes received by the winning candidates did not exceed 50% during the 2001 and 2008 elections. Yet, for the 2018 election, that number was as high as 93%.

In the 11<sup>th</sup> national general election, candidates getting nearly all the votes was not unheard of. In fact, in 68 seats, the % of votes received by the winning candidate was over 95%. Data analysis shows that in 200 of 299 \*\* seats, the winning candidate took home at least 80% of the votes.
