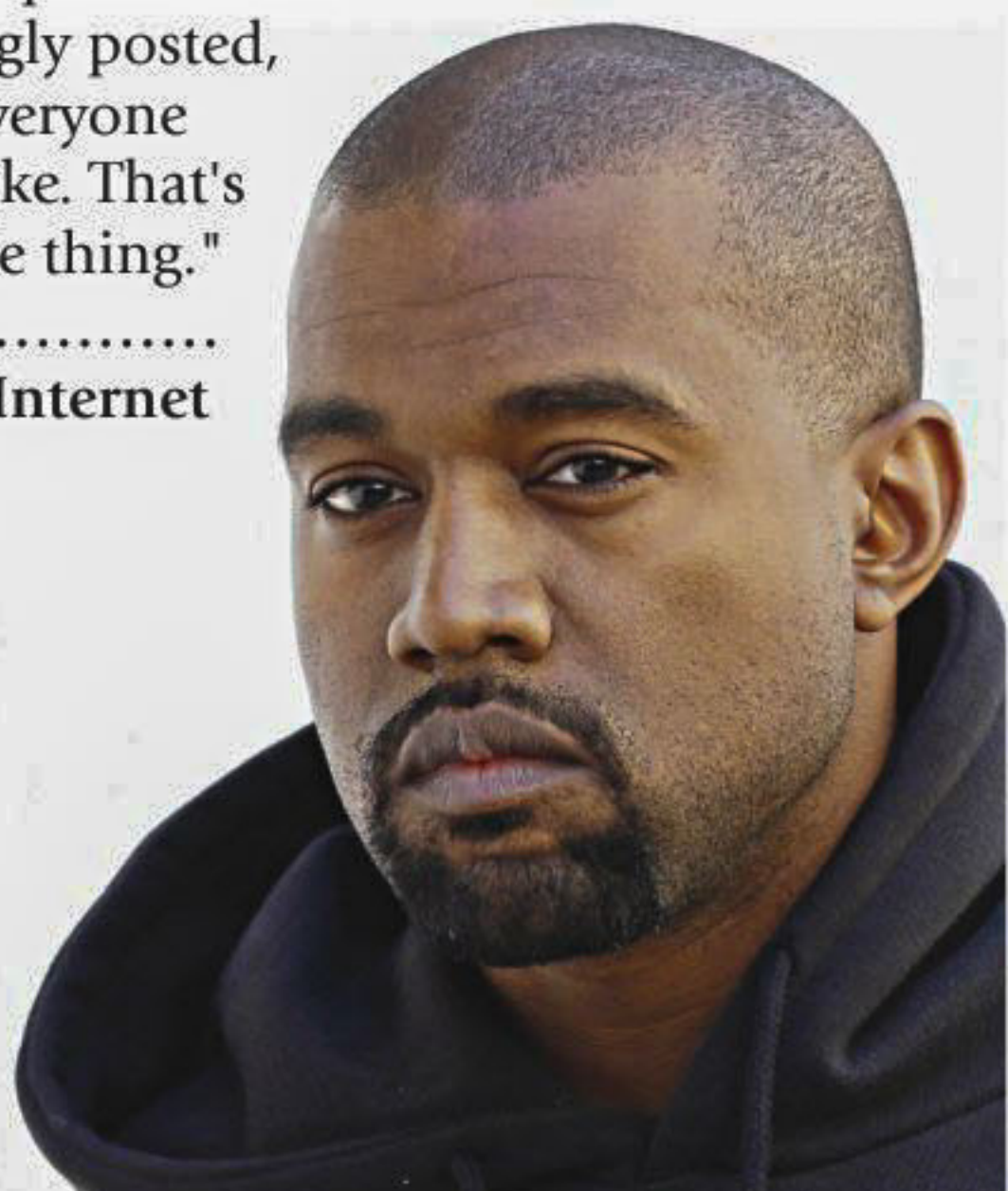


WEST'S 'Instagram' ousting
