Two city corporation vehicles, which were vandalised by workers, were taken to the police station, the police officer added.

Talking to The Daily Star, Milton Kazi, manager (compliance) of Bando Apparels Ltd, said the injured female worker was sent to Shaheed Suhrawardy Medical College Hospital for treatment. They shut the factory for the day following the incident.

"I got stranded for around two hours at one spot. Finding no way, I started walking to come to Dhaka," said Anisur Rahman, a college student, who was traveling from Savar to Dhaka.

CUCSU ELECTION

BCL issues one-month ultimatum

A faction of the dissolved Chittagong University unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) yesterday issued a one-month ultimatum to university administration, to hold CU Central Student Union (Cucusu) election.

It came up with ultimatum at a human chain formed at Cucusu building, threatening to launch a tougher movement if their demands are not met within the time.

Addressing the programme, former CU BCL General Secretary Fazle Rabbi Sujon said, "The university authorities have been depriving students from their basic rights for a long time. As there is no elected representative at the senate, the authorities impose their unfair decisions on students."

an invitation to TSC-based social and cultural organisations to discuss in this regard on January 17.

Leaders of student organisations spoke to The Daily Star about their proposals.

Rajib Das, general secretary of Chhatra Union's DU unit, said the DU VC, as a nominated president of Ducusu, has been given power to dissolve the executive body at any time as per article 5(a) of the constitution. No court verdict will be implemented over the decision of VC regarding the election results; such rules are curbing democratic values.

"We have proposed curtailing the VC's power to ensure a balance among other post holders, including vice president and hall union leaders," he said.

Leaders from other organisations, including Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), also suggested establishing a balance of power among all posts, sources from the respective organisations confirmed.

Chhatra Union and JCD also proposed installing separate polling stations for residential and non-residential students to ensure their right to vote.

JCD's DU unit president Al Mehedi Talukder said he had proposed to contain an article ensuring presence of all organisa-

tions on campus, prior to the election.

JCD also proposed to install closed circuit cameras on campus to ensure security of its activists.

"If our activists are arrested during campaigning, it will be difficult to participate in the election. We demand that law enforcers play an unbiased role," said Mehedi.

Bangladesh Student Federation's (BSF) DU unit President Umme Habiba Benjir also demanded a level playing field.

Awami League-backed BCL proposed ensuring participation of regular students in Ducusu up to master's and imposing a ban on politics of any organisation involved in serving the interests of war criminals, said Saddam Hossain, general secretary of BCL's DU unit.

He also proposed to create a new post titled "Liberation War Affairs Secretary" in Ducusu and ensure women's empowerment in the executive body.

Ducusu was dissolved in 1998. Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal's Amanullah Aman and Khairul Kabir Khokon panel won the last election and continued to be leaders of the student body until its dissolution. Later, several attempts were made to hold the Ducusu election but DU blamed probable political unrest on the campus for holding the election.

QUALITY OF BOTTLED WATER

HC gives BSTI another week to submit report

The High Court yesterday extended for a week its earlier order that asked authorities concerned to check the quality of water sold in plastic bottles and other containers across the country.

It also directed Bangladesh Standards and Testing Institution (BSTI) and law enforcement agencies to examine the water and submit test reports in a week, and fixed January 21 for passing an order.

The bench of Justice Sheikh Hassan Arif and Justice Razik-Al Jalil passed the order after Deputy Attorney General Mokhlesur Rahman submitted a report from BSTI, saying that BSTI has formed several committees to examine the water sold in plastic bottles and other containers.

The committees are supposed to submit the reports by January 17; so, BSTI needs time to place the test reports to the court, he said.

Following a writ petition, the HC bench on December 3 ordered BSTI and law enforcers to immediately check quality of such water and submit the test reports to it by yesterday.

The court also issued a rule asking the authorities to explain why they should not be directed to ensure the supply of safe drinking water through authorised means and why their failure to this effect should not be declared illegal.

Petitioner's counsel Md JR Khan Robin earlier told The Daily Star that a total of 287 factories are authorised to produce plastic bottles, jars and other containers.

More than 3,000 factories are unauthorised, he added.

Woman killed in road accident

A woman was killed and her brother-in-law injured in a road accident on Kishoreganj-Khilpara road in Khilpara area yesterday.

The deceased was identified as Jannatul Ferdous Urmi, 19, wife of Al Jaber Baten of Uttar Payrabhanga area in Kishoreganj Sadar upazila, said Abu Bakar Siddiq, officer-in-charge of Kishoreganj Police Station. The accident took place when a human haulier hit a motorbike Urmi and her brother-in-law Abu Obaida were riding on, leaving the woman dead on the spot, the police official said quoting locals.

Abu sustained serious injuries and was rushed to Kishoreganj General Hospital by locals, while Urmi's body was sent to the hospital for an autopsy.

The driver managed to flee with the vehicle, the OC said, adding, a case was lodged in this connection.

Bus catches fire in Ctg

A Chattogram-bound local bus caught fire at Banskhalhi upazila in the district yesterday, police said.

The incident took place when the driver, despite several attempts, failed to start the engine of the vehicle, said Kamal Hossain, officer-in-charge of Banskhalhi Police Station.

Around 8:30am, upon the driver's request, all passengers got off the vehicle and started to push the bus, while the driver was still sitting holding the steering, trying to start the engine.

After a while, the bus caught fire and the driver instantly got off the vehicle, the OC added.

On information, a team from Banskhalhi fire service rushed to the spot and doused the blaze after an hour.

The fire might have originated from overheating of the engine, said Abdur Rahim, team leader of the fire station.

Nobody was hurt in the incident, as they all managed to get off before the fire spread, OC Kamal also said.

gates closed and only stop at the selected bus stoppages.

Regarding pedestrian movement on footpaths, Rezaul said that they had already taken initiatives to go for a drive, jointly with the crime division, against illegal occupancy of footpaths.

Police will also focus on increasing filing of video cases for traffic rule violations. The DMP database shows, a total of 99,417 video cases were filed in the first nine months of 2018.

Some other plans include awareness building through leaflets, placards and guides, programmes at important intersections in the city, attaching rover scouts and other volunteers with traffic department, installing zebra crossings and road markings.
