Forgery gang runs rampant at Ctg port

4,000 consignments released thru' scam by nexus of C&F agents, importers; one suspect arrested

A gang consisting of clearing and forwarding (C&F) agents and importers had at least 4,000 consignments released from the Chattogram port through forgery on over the last two years.

The gang stole and misused the identities of two former customs officials of the Chittagong Custom House for the crime, CIID officials said. One of the two officials was on retirement while the other had been transferred.

The Customs Intelligence and Investigation Directorate officials said they identified seven active members of the gang. One of them was arrested from the capital's Kakrail area yesterday.

The arrestee is Mizanur Rahman, owner of M/S MR Trade International and Chakladar C&F Agent Limited.

CIID officials said they found evidence that the criminals entered the customs' server using the IDs of former revenue officer DAM Muhibul Islam, who went on retirement in 2015, and Fazlul Haque, currently working at the Dhaka Custom House.

Both the officials were posted to the Chittagong Customs House from 2013 to 2016 and they discharged various duties, they said, adding that the scam that surfaced had

'Criminal' killed in 'gunfight' with cops

An alleged criminal was killed in a "gunfight" between police and his accomplices in Karar Beel area of Narail Sadar upazila early yesterday.

The deceased, 28-year-old Rumman Hossain Romeo, was accused in 13 cases for murder, robbery and other crimes, police said.

The bullet-hit body of an Awami League (AL) activist has meanwhile been found in Satkhira. Police claimed Maizuddin Ahmed Tulu, the 40-year-old AL activist, was killed in an internal fight of drug traders yesterday.

On the "gunfight", Ilias Hossain, officer-in-charge (OC) of Narail Sadar police, said a team of law enforcers raided Karar Beel on information that a criminal group was hiding there.

Sensing the presence of police, the criminals opened fire on the team, forcing them to retaliate.

Amanullah Kabir passes away

Veteran journalist Amanullah Kabir died at a city hospital early yesterday. He was 72.

The journalist, who had been suffering from various diseases, breathed his last at Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University (BSMMU) around 1:00am.

Amanullah was admitted to the intensive care unit of the BSMMU on January 2 with complications in kidney and liver.

He left behind his wife,

20 missing as boat sinks in Meghna

At least 20 people are feared dead after a sand-laden boat sank in the Meghna river early Tuesday.

Officials said the boat carrying 34 labourers capsized after it collided with an oil tanker near Charjhaptia area of Munshiganj.

Of the missing people, 17 are from Bhangura upazila of Pabna, one from Sirajganj's Ullapara and two others are yet to be identified, said police.

Rescuers of police, coastguards, Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authorities and fire services tried to find the missing people from dawn to dusk yesterday, said Faruk Ahmed, upazila nirbahi officer of Munshiganj.

In Bhangura, grieving family members yesterday said the authorities had not started the rescue operation when there was time.

Quoting survivors, UNO Faruk said the boat was going to Narayanganj's Boktaboli from Cumilla's Daudkandi.

After it capsized, 14 people managed to survive.

Habibur Rahman, another survivor, told reporters that he and several others had swam for almost an hour before they were rescued by another boat.

Another survivor Mahmud Ali said, "If police and administration took prompt action, some people could have been rescued."

Harun-or-Rashid, officer-in-charge of Munshiganj's Gazaria Police Station, said police from Pabna first informed them about the incident.

"We informed it to the river police. But river police in the evening told us that they did not find any such incident.

"Around 9:00pm today [yesterday], a survivor named Shah Alam came to me and told me about the incident. But we could not start a search operation at night," he said.

Ashfaquzzaman, additional superintendent of police in Munsiganj, said they started the rescue operation around 8:00am.

Human rights bodies reject NHRC report

Local OC suspended

The Human Rights Forum Bangladesh (HRFB), a platform of 20 rights and development organisations, yesterday called for the cancellation of the National Human Rights Commission report that failed to find a correlation between the Subarnachar rape incident and the December 30 polls.

Terming the failure "mysterious" and "suicidal" for the commission, the forum also demanded that the commission's chairman accepts the failure and makes an apology in this regard.

Meanwhile, Officer-in-Charge of Noakhali's Char Jabbar Police Station Md Nizam Uddin has been withdrawn for "negligence in duty" over the rape incident, reports our district correspondent.

Elias Sharif, superintendent of police (SP) in Noakhali, said Nizam was withdrawn and attached to the district's police lines on Tuesday night following the

Dogs detect blood sugar crashes

Dogs trained to sniff out life-threatening blood sugar crashes in people with type 1 diabetes have been shown to effectively spot the condition, which can render patients unconscious, in the first large-scale trial of its type.

The University of Bristol research found medical detection dogs were able to spot 83 percent of more than 4,000 episodes of hypoglycaemia (low blood sugar) and hyperglycaemia (high blood sugar), minimising the risk of harmful health complications.

They can be particularly effective in monitoring patients who might have unexpectedly low glucose levels at night or for young people who are less able

4-year-old 'raped' in Sunamganj

A four-year-old girl was allegedly raped by a man in Sreepur area of Sunamganj's Tahirpur upazila Tuesday evening.

The accused is Haris Mia, 50, a neighbour of the child.

The girl was going to one of her relative's house, a few yards away from her home, around 4:30pm. On her way, Haris allegedly picked her up and raped her in his house, police said, quoting locals.
