She said that strikes around the world are an instrument of labour movement, but in the third world they are being used as a political tool.

The daily Samakal's publisher and former FBCCI president AK Azad said that businesses are the main victims of hartals.

National University Vice Chancellor Professor Harun-or-Rashid, former State Minister for Foreign Affairs Abul Hasan, The Daily Observer Editor Iqbal Sobhan Chowdhury and others also spoke at the book launch.

Speakers were of the view that hartals have long been a means to protest and realise democratic demands in the subcontinent and Bangladesh, in particular, during the struggle for independence. But while hartals used to be enforced peacefully and observed spontaneously in the past, they mostly turn violent now.

In pre-independent Bangladesh, hartals used to be called over pro-people issues and people observed those willingly because they could connect with the call. But now, on most occasions, political parties have to carry out subversive activities to create panic among people, they added.

4 'JMB operatives' sent to jail

A court in Jamalpur yesterday sent four Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) members, arrested by Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) in Mymensingh on Wednesday, to jail.

The arrestees -- college student Siam Al Mahmud, 19, Nasreen Akter alias Joaira, 21, Md Shaheen Islam alias Mahbub Islam, 22, and Md Shakhawat Karim, 36 -- were produced before the Jamalpur Sadar Court with a seven-day remand prayer, said Taposh Chandra Pandit, officer-in-charge of Government Railway Police in Jamalpur.

The court sent them to jail after no hearing on the remand prayer was held, he added.

The four met through Facebook and were planning to travel to another country for training, Rab-14 Commanding Officer Lt Col Md Afteker Uddin said at a press briefing on Thursday.

EU awards Erasmus grant to three univs

The European Union has awarded its prestigious "ERASMUS+ Capacity Building in Higher Education" grant of USD 1 million to three universities in Bangladesh.

The institutions are Brac James P Grant School of Public Health, Brac University; International Centre for Climate Change & Development, Independent University of Bangladesh (IUB), and Asian University for Women (AUW).

A signing ceremony was held in this regard at Brac Centre Inn in Dhaka on Wednesday, said a press release.

The tripartite partnership will implement the "Transformative Competency-Based Public Health Education for Professional Employability in Bangladesh's Health Sector" project, from 2019 to 2021.

The universities will design and offer competency-based public health curricula to ensure professional skills development and address the skilled-workforce shortage in the health sector.

The technical partners are Maastricht University, Netherlands, and Institute of Development Studies, University of Sussex, UK.

of the university. Instead, it was assigned only two small rooms, which can accommodate 60 students in total, at RU Central Stadium.

Those rooms are inadequate for the number of students enrolled in the department and the location is not suitable for conducting classes or examinations, complained many students.

Third-year student Biplob said the two rooms cannot fit all students. Every day, when a class is in operation for one batch, another batch has to wait outside.

With an additional 30 students, who started their class under 2018-19 session, the total enrolment at the PESS department will reach 120. And this is likely to worsen the situation, he also said.

Rayhan Ahmed, another PESS student, said, "It's really difficult for us to continue our classes and exams in a noisy environment right beside the stadium where different sports activities are held all year round. We suffer the most during our final exams."

Contacted, M Shahidul Alam, chairman of the department and also a guest teacher, said many times in the past, he had informed the university authorities of the department's issues related to resources shortage. But they paid no heed.

After the correspondent reached RU Vice Chancellor (VC) Prof M Abdus Sobhan for his comment over the difficulties faced by students of the PESS department, he said, "We have to fulfil some basic criteria, including [ensuring adequate] classrooms and teachers, before opening any new department. However, the past administration launched the department without [completing] these things."

"As a result, students are suffering now," he added.

When asked how he plans to resolve the situation, the VC said the RU planning committee has submitted a report, recommending recruitment of teachers for the department. The authorities will soon publish advertisements, seeking applications from prospective teachers.

Regarding allocation of classrooms, he said within two to three months, the PESS department will be relocated to Fourth Science Building on the campus.

secretary of CU unit of BCL, said due to absence of Cucus representatives in the Senate, the authorities deprive students of their basic rights. It is high time for holding Cucus election, he added.

Contacted, Mainul Islam, a former professor of CU economics department, said it is very disappointing that Cucus election has not taken place for 29 years.

Students' representation has to be ensured in decision-making process, he said, emphasising that the Cucus election should be held on a regular basis.

CU Vice Chancellor Prof Iftekhar Uddin Chowdhury said they are thinking about Cucus election. He did not elaborate further.

The Cucus election was held only six times since the university's inception in 1966.

The university authorities suspended the election in 1990 after Sarbodolio Chhatra Oikya leader Farukuzzaman was killed in a clash with Islami Chhatra Shibir. Since then, the Cucus has remained inoperative.
