Nurul Alam Chowdhury, former lawmaker and president of Chattogram (north) district unit Awami League, passed away yesterday at a hospital in the port city. He was 73.

The freedom fighter was suffering from old-age complications, said Abdus Salam, general secretary of Chattogram (north) district unit AL.

He left behind his wife, two sons and a daughter to mourn his death.

Nurul Alam was elected lawmaker from Chattogram-2 in 1973 and 1986. In

1996, he became director of Rupali Bank and in 2010, he was appointed Bangladesh ambassador to Oman.

Nurul's first namaz-ejanaza will be held today at 10am and the second one will take place at Fatikchhari College ground after Zohr prayers. He will be buried with state honour after a third janaza in Fatikchhari.

DMC forensic chief terms death of sub-registrar in train accident 'mysterious'

Sub-registrar Mahbub Alam did not die in train accident; he was murdered, claimed his family members.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Medical College Forensic Department chief Sohel Mahmud termed the death "mysterious", after performing autopsy on the body on Saturday as several injury marks were found on Mahbub's head.

"Viscera samples from the body had been collected for test," he said, adding that after getting the report, reason behind the death would be known completely.

The sub-registrar of Demra Land Record Office was found dead near Airport Rail Station area on Friday. Police said Mahbub was hit by the Panchagarh-Dhaka Ekota Express around 9:40am.

Meanwhile, Abu Zafar, younger brother of the deceased, said, "We wanted to file a murder case with Dhaka Railway Police Station, but police told us to file an unnatural death case." "According to police, if the autopsy or

In response to the 2017 Rohingya exodus, FD7 clearances (clearance by NGO Affairs Bureau for work in the Rohingya camps) can take anywhere between 72 hours to two months.

"In some sectors such as education and protection, the lack of FD7 approvals continue to hold back available funds, hinder the deployment of new actors and the expansion of programmes by existing actors."

Visa application procedures are particularly cumbersome for surge capacity staff, who need to enter Bangladesh urgently, he added. Dr Cook suggested streamlining and revision of approval

processes for incoming relief goods, funds, relaxing visas for international staff and developing an approval process for INGOs that augments local capacity. He also recommended mapping local community organisations to enhance localisation with international organisa-

tions, building stronger linkages between Refugee Relief and Rehabilitation Commissioner and local governments. The expert suggested re-establishing camp committees to

govern the Rohingya refugee camps to provide greater democratic and equal gender representation in decision-making.

Dr Cook also stressed on integrating humanitarian standards and accountability mechanisms.

Prof Mohammad Tamim, pro-vice chancellor of Brac University, and Muhammad Badiuzzaman, research coordinator at the Centre for Peace and Justice at the university, also spoke at the programme, attended by NGO officials, academics and development partners.


