

RUCSU POLLS 10 student orgs submit papers

Ten student organisations of Rajshahi University (RU) yesterday submitted their organisational constitution and others relevant documents to authorities to participate in a discussion over Rajshahi University Central Students Union (Rucusu) polls.

On January 22, RU authorities asked the student bodies to submit the documents within seven days.

Bangladesh Chhatra League, Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal, Samajantrik Chhatra Front (Marx), Samajantrik Chhatra Front (Lelin), Bangladesh Chhatra Moitree, Biplobi Chhatra Moitree, Bangladesh Chhatra Federation, Bangladesh Chhatra Union, Bangabandhu Prajanma League and Islami Shasantantro Chhatra Andolan submitted their documents.

The discussion will be held next week, said Prof Lutfur Rahman, convener of the discussion committee.

Anti-VC panel wins Juta polls

The anti-vice chancellor (VC) panel has won the Jahangirnagar University Teachers' Association (Juta) election that was held yesterday on the campus.

Out of 15 executive member posts, the panel won 10 including president and general secretary, while the VC-backed panel won five posts including vice-president.

A total of 549 teachers out of 581 exercised their franchise at the polls held in the university's teachers' club. Voting started from 9am and continued till 1:30pm without any break.

The anti-VC platform, an alliance of pro-Awami League, pro-BNP and left-leaning teachers is named "Sammilito Sikkhak Samaj", while VC-backed teachers contested the polls under the banner of "Bangabandhu Adorsher Shikkhak".

Prof Ajit Kumar Mozumder of statistics department became president for the fifth time, defeating Prof Md Abdur Mannan Chowdhury of physics, by 293 votes.

Prof Sohail Rana of pharmacy won the general secretary post defeating Prof Bashir Ahmed of government and politics.

Prof Jugal Krishna Das of computer science and engineering, Assistant Prof Laizu Nasrin of English and Prof Monwar Hossain Tuhin of zoology department were elected vice-president, joint secretary and treasurer respectively.

Newly-elected president Prof Ajit Kumar Mozumder, also president of the AL faction of teachers, said, "We made an alliance with all parties, as we always stand against irregularities and indiscipline of the university administration."

Meanwhile, left-leaning students of the university staged a demonstration on the campus during the polls, demanding JU Central Students Union (Jucusu) election. The university units of Samajantrik Chhatra Front and Bangladesh Chhatra Union observed separate programmes pressing the demand.

Chhatra Front's central president Imran Habib, general secretary Nasiruddin Prince and Chhatra Federation central president Golam Mustafa also attended the press conference.

Malaysian firm to be sued

meeting with the company and the Bangladesh and Nepal embassies, where an agreement was reached regarding a payment schedule.

It said payment of wages for November 2018 started on January 28 while overtime was paid on January 29. December's wages would be paid latest by February 1 while overtime would be paid by February 15 and January's pay and overtime would be paid on February 28.

On January 29, it was reported that some 2,000 Nepalese workers went on a strike at the company's factory in Bandar Baru Salak Tinggi in Sepang.

After investigation, the company was found to have committed labour offences including not paying workers' wages for three months, not paying overtime, unfair pay cuts and wrongful working hours during break and public holidays.

The issue first came to light in early December last year when UK-based newspaper The Guardian reported that thousands of Nepalese and Bangladeshi workers were allegedly indentured at two Malaysian rubber glove factories -- WRP and Top Glove -- with forced overtime, debt bondage, withheld wages and passport confiscation.

Around one million Bangladeshis work in Malaysia, but allegations of fraudulence, non-payment and underpayment are rife. Malaysia suspended labour recruitment from Bangladesh since September last year on charges of monopoly by a syndicate of 10 Bangladeshi recruiting agencies.

Under that mechanism, Bangladeshi workers had to pay fees up to Tk 4 lakh for a job in Malaysia, although as per the G-to-G Plus agreement signed in 2016 stipulated the recruitment fees to be no more than Tk 40,000.

He hoped that the EC will be able to hold a "flawless" mayoral and councillor elections.

REUTERS REPORT PROTESTED

Election Monitoring Forum (EMF) yesterday termed the national election participatory, peaceful and fair. The observers at a press conference at Jatiya Press Club also appreciated the EC's role in this regard.

EMF Executive Director Mohammad Abed Ali, however, said they cannot comment on the allegations of what happened the night before voting day.

"The policy [for election observers] allows us to monitor the election from 7am on the day, and therefore the comments we are making on the election is based on that. We cannot or even are not allowed to say what took place the night before election," he said.

The forum is an alliance of 31 local election observers registered under the EC. They fielded 5,811 observers to monitor 17,165 voting centres.

At the conference, Abed, also secretary general of Saarc Human Rights Foundation, protested a Reuters report.

Reuters on January 22 reported that a top official of the foundation and its foreign volunteers regretted participating in the election observation process, casting doubt on the credibility of a polls won overwhelmingly by Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina and her alliance.

Abed said Reuters "distorted" the comments of the foundation's president Mohammad Abdus Salam and Canadian observer Tanya Foster and produced "false, fabricated and baseless" news. He claimed that both of them protested the report.
