

Ershad flies back home

Jatiya Party Chairman and leader of the opposition in parliament HM Ershad last night returned home from Singapore, after completing treatment.

Ershad, who has been suffering from multiple health complications, left Dhaka on January 20, and was admitted to National University Hospital Singapore.

He landed at the Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport at 10:50pm by a Singapore Airlines flight, SM Faisal Chisti, a JP presidium member told this newspaper.

JP sources said he may join the parliament session within a day or two.

Abdur Rezak Khan sought the seized documents saying that scrutiny of the papers are essential for a legal, useful and proper hearing on charge framing.

The defence will present its depositions after getting the certified copy of the case, the lawyer added.

In response, Special Public Prosecutor Mosharrif Hossain Kajal said the defence should get the certified copy, according to the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure (CrPC).

However, they did not ask for it in last 12 years, the prosecutor said, adding that defence lawyers are now seeking it only to delay the trial proceedings.

"The defence lawyers have already got all the necessary documents," the prosecutor also said.

On December 9, 2007, the Anti-Corruption Commission filed the case accusing Khaleda and others of causing the state a loss of Tk 137.77 billion by signing an oil-gas exploration deal with Canadian

company Niko when the BNP was in office.

Police submitted a charge-sheet against the accused on May 5, 2008.

The others accused in the case include Moudud Ahmed, former state minister for energy AKM Mosharrif Hossain and others.

KHALEDA ZIA DENIED BAIL IN

CUMILLA MURDER CASE

Meanwhile, a Cumilla court yesterday rejected a bail petition of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia in a murder case filed over the killing of eight people and injury of many others in Chaudhogram upazila, during anti-government agitations in 2015.

District and Sessions Judge Ali Akbar also fixed February 25 for holding the hearing on charge framing.

On January 23, the High Court directed the Cumilla court concerned to dispose of the bail petition filed by Khaleda in this case.

Advocate Kaimul Haque Rinku argued for Khaleda while Public Prosecutor Mostafizur Rahman Liton appeared for the state.

Another farmer, Shamsher Ali, 70, died the next day, suffering from severe chest pain for a week. On February 2, Rahela Begum, 55, died in her sleep.

"The deceased had reasons behind their deaths," said Dr Abdullah Maruf Faruque, head of the medical team.

"Some were suffering from heart ailments, some had asthma and other chronic diseases. Their deaths are not connected... they were not taken to the right places for treatment," the doctor added.

Visiting the village yesterday, this correspondent, while talking to locals, found out that the village had no nearby medical facility. The nearest government health complex is 18km away.

When asked about such unabated illegal operation of the brick kilns, the DoE director said most of these were established on the riverbanks and in remote areas, so it is difficult to monitor them.

"If we want to conduct eviction drives, we need magistracy and police support. So, it takes time. That's why, we are not able to do so whenever we want," he added.

In Dasherhat and Jambhudip villages in Barishal's Banaripara upazila, this newspaper found most of the brick kilns being operated defying rules. Firewood was being burned in almost all of those, which the rules do not allow.

Besides, several of the brick kilns were established near schools affecting children, said Anowar Hossain from Jambhudip.

In some cases, influential people are running their business illegally by "managing" the local administration, several residents alleged.

Contacted, Banaripara Upazila Nirbahi Officer Sheikh Abdullah Sadid said they would take steps against the illegal practice as soon as possible.
