Academic activities of CU sociology dept at stalemate

Concerned committee didn't meet in over three months

The academic committee meeting of the sociology department of Chittagong University has not been held for more than three months due to quorum crisis, hampering academic activities.

Usually, such meeting is held once a month. Decisions on all sorts of academic activities -- including examinations, class schedules and study tours -- are taken at the meeting, university sources said.

The final examination of honours third year has remained postponed, while first and second year classes are yet to start.

Moreover, fourth year final examinations were not held, which were scheduled to begin on February 7.

Students of the department expressed their concern over the issue, and blamed the teachers for the crisis. The meeting has not been held as the teachers have been divided

into two factions, they said.

One of the factions is loyal to the department head while the other is not, they added.

A student, requesting not to be named, said, "Our third year final examination was supposed to be held on January 3, but it has been postponed."

"We do not see any initiatives from the university authorities to resolve the problem," he said.

"Our batchmates from other departments have already attended their exams," he added.

The students said they requested the department chairman to resolve the crisis, but he blamed the teachers for the situation.

Many students questioned why they should suffer due to the internal problems of their teachers.

A senior teacher, wishing not to be named, alleged that the chairman did not

BGB member arrested with 480 yaba pills

A Border Guard Bangladesh (BGB) member was arrested from Sadarghat area in the capital with 480 pieces of yaba pills on Sunday night.

The arrestee, Mazful Islam, is a Nayek of BGB who works at BGB Regional Headquarters in Cox's Bazar. He was on a one-month leave, police sources said.

Following information gleaned from the BGB member, police also arrested two of his accomplices from Hatirjheel area that night with 35 yaba pills, police said.

KM Ashraf Uddin, officer-in-charge of Sutrapur Police Station, said acting on a tip-off they searched the BGB member at Sadarghat Launch Terminal area at 8:45pm

and found 50 yaba pills in the pocket of his pants. Later, they found 430 more yaba pills in his bag and arrested him.

During interrogation, Mazful informed police about his two accomplices -- Siddiq and Mrs Nayan. Police launched another drive in Hatirjheel and arrested Siddiq with 20 yaba pills and Nayan with 15.

OC Ashraf Uddin also said the BGB member and his two accomplices were produced before a Dhaka court with five-day remand prayer for each. Court sources said the court sent the arrestees to jail.

Five killed in road accidents

22 injured

Five persons, including a schoolgirl, were killed in separate road accidents yesterday.

In Khulna, an eighth-grader was killed and 20 others injured after a picnic bus skidded off the road and overturned in Dumuria upazila yesterday, UNB reports.

The deceased was identified as Meghla, a student of Shyamnagar Girls' High School in Jashore sadar upazila, said Aminul Islam Biplab, officer-in-charge of Dumuria Police Station.

Around 11:30am, the bus carrying 60 students, teachers and staff of the school, skidded off the Khulna-Satkhira highway, killing Meghla on spot, the OC said.

The injured were taken to Khulna Medical College Hospital.

In Munshiganj, three persons, including a couple, were killed and another person was injured in a road accident at Bhaberchar Bus Terminal under Gazaria upazila, reports our correspondent.

The deceased were identified as Siddiqur Rahman, 70, a retired officer of Grameen Bank; his wife Jesmine Sultana, 55; and Abdullah Sarkar, 33, the private car driver; said Harun Ur Rashid, officer in charge of Gazaria Police Station.

Around 12:30pm, a private car collided with another vehicle on Dhaka-Chattogram highway, killing the three on spot and injuring the couple's domestic help, the OC also
