Schoolboy dies as picnic bus plunges into roadside ditch in Panchagarh

A bus, with 65 students and 10-12 teachers of a high school, was going to a picnic spot in Panchagarh yesterday.

On the way, one of the students of Rosea High School lost his life instantly as the bus fell into a roadside ditch in Kalitala Rowshonpur village.

The deceased, Sajib Singh (12), was a class six student. Twenty-four were also injured in the accident, said police. The accident happened around 11am as

the driver of the bus lost control over the vehicle, said Jahirul Islam, officer-in-charge of Tentulia Police Station. During the accident, the vehicle was plying on a clay road, he added.

On information, firefighters rushed to the spot, rescued the injured and took them to a local hospital.

Of the injured, head teacher Belal Hossain, was sent to Rangpur Medical College Hospital as his condition deterio-

In Patuakhali, a bus owner was killed and 30 others injured as the bus fell into a ditch beside Patuakhali-Kuakata road in the town's Kalikapur area yesterday. Of the injured, three were sent to

Barishal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College

Hospital in critical condition. The rest were undergoing treatment at Patuakhali General Hospital. The deceased -- Anando Das, 48, owner of the bus "Khan Classic" -- was from

EC officials said they are planning to hold the next two phases of the election on March 31 and June 18 respectively.

GAS CRISIS IN CTG

Rush at restaurants and electric appliance stores

Gas supply remained suspended in one-third area of port city for the third consecutive day yesterday, intensifying public distress and forcing many to buy food from restaurants. A large number of people are also buying electric kitchen

appliances and gas cylinders, prompting traders to allegedly hike up prices. Karnaphuli Gas Distribution Company Limited (KGDCL)

published an announcement in local daily newspapers on Sunday about the supply suspension but the authorities did not mention when they will be able to resume the supply. The gas supply was suspended after an excavator of Chattogram City Corporation mistakenly made a hole in

the pipeline during digging work in Maitteli canal beside

Akmal Ali Road on February 16 afternoon. M Shakil Ahmed, a Customs official from Bashundhara residential area adjacent to Halishahar, told The Daily Star that it was difficult to manage food since Saturday due to shortage of gas in the area, adding that he had been compelled to buy gas cylinder and burner for cooking.

"I bought a gas cylinder which cost Tk 2,500; it was being sold at Tk 2,100 before the gas crisis," he said.

Rafiqul Islam, gas cylinder and electric kitchen appliances trader at a shop adjacent to Enayet Bazar Mosque, admitted to charging extra, claiming that wholesalers had increased prices due to high demand.

Mohammad Sohel, a resident of Port Colony, said they were depending on food from restaurants for the past three days, adding that there were long queues and sometimes the eateries run out of food too. Like Shakil and Sohel, residents of several other areas

described similar ordeal to this newspaper.

Upon visiting some electronic shops, it was found that demand of electric ovens and rice cookers have increased.

Jatka Protection Week begins on March 10

"Jatka Protection Week 2019" will begin on March 10 and continue till March 16, across 37 districts in the country. The decision came in a meeting of the national

taskforce on hilsa development held at the Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock at the secretariat in Dhaka, said a press release.

During the protection week, use of illegal net for catching hilsa would be strictly prohibited and government will also conduct various awareness building programmes against fishing jatka (young hilsa less than nine inches in length).

State Minister for Ministry of Fisheries and Livestock Ashraf Ali Khan Khoshru presided over the meeting while Secretary Raisul Alam Mandal was present.

Chevron distributes warm clothes among underprivileged

The Bangladesh chapter of Chevron's XYZ Network and Policy, Government and Public Affairs (PGPA) department have collaborated on a winter clothing collection drive, says a press release.

29.60 acres of Dhaleshwari River grabbed: survey

A survey report by Manikganj district administration revealed that a total of 29.60 acres of the Dhaleshwari River in the district have been encroached by land grabbers. The district administration yesterday submitted the

report to the High Court (HC) bench of Justice Moyeenul Islam Chowdhury and Justice Md Ashraful Kamal, through the office of the attorney general. According to the report, two private companies, a non-

government organisation and 46 individuals have grabbed the land. Two illegal structures have been built in the area and rampant sand-filling is also taking place. The HC on October 23 last year ordered the district admin-

istration to submit a survey report following a writ petition filed by rights organisation Human Rights and Peace for Bangladesh.

Advocate Manzill Murshid yesterday submitted another petition to the court seeking necessary orders on the government to evict all grabbers from the river.

The bench fixed February 25 for hearing and passing order.



Supreme Court lawyer JR Khan Rabin submitted the petition and prayed to the court to ensure adequate living facilities for the inmates. According to the petition, only nine doctors are provid-

ing treatment to 89,000 inmates in 68 jail hospitals across the country -- while 120 posts are vacant. "Treatment to inmates is being hampered due to short-

age of doctors in jail hospitals," the lawyer also argued.
