

# Spring rain damages huge unbaked bricks

Over 50 houses damaged in the sudden rainfall

Spring rain since yesterday morning damaged huge quantities of raw bricks that were stacked up in the open fields for drying in different upazilas of the district.

Meanwhile, over 50 houses and at least 100 umbrellas, kept at Kuakata sea beach for the visitors, were badly damaged during the untimely rain accompanied by gusty winds.

Of the 50 houses, 20 were completely damaged while the rest 30 were damaged partially.

Besides, two madrasa houses in Sadar and Kalapara upazilas were partially damaged in the sudden rain that started yesterday early morning and continued till filing of this report as of 8:00pm.

Besides, two tin-roofed houses of Bazarghona Fazil Madrasa in Sadar upazila and Musulliabad Fazil Madrasa in Kalapara upazila were badly damaged, he said.

Moreover, thousands of unbacked bricks kept for drying in at least 20 brickfields in different areas of the district were badly damaged.

Kalapara Radar Station recorded 13mm rainfall in the area in 6 hours since 6:00am yesterday, while at the same time, Patuakhali Met Office recorded 38.30mm rainfall.

Kalapara Upazila Project Implementation Officer Sumon Chandra Devnath said they asked all union parishad chairmen concerned to submit Kalapara Upazila Parishad Chairman lists of damaged houses and other business structures so that they can take neces-

#### Three cousins drown

Three cousins drowned at Pashchim Kanaimajhari village in Chattogram's Chandanaish upazila on Sunday.

The victims were Sifatul Islam Abir, 6, son of Md Helal Uddin, Md Ifti, 4, son of Oman expatriate Md Kawsar Alam, and Moinul Islam, 4, son of late Joynal Abedin of the village.

Police and family sources said the trio accidentally fell into a ditch near their house while playing on its bank. Family members later found them floating on the water.

They were rushed to Chattogram Medical College Hospital where onduty doctor declared them

A pall of gloom descended on the families after the incident, said Keshab Chakrabarty, officer in charge of Chandanaish Police Station.

## One killed, 20 injured in Sirajganj clash

A man was killed and 19 others were injured in a clash between two rival groups at Gopalpur village in Sirajganj's Belkuchi upazila yesterday.

The deceased was farmer Md Nur-un-Nabi, 45, son of Abdul Hakim of the village. The injured were admitted to the upazila health complex, said Md Anwarul Islam,

officer in charge of Belkuchi Police Station.

Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between Abdur Razzak Master and Razzak Ali Mohuri of the village over previous enmity. As a sequel to the conflict, the men of the

two rivals attacked each other with lethal weapons yesterday morning, leaving over 20 people from both sides injured. Of them, Nur-un-Nabi, supporter of

Abdur Razzak, died on way to the health

complex, said the OC. The others are undergoing treatment at

the upazila health complex. Additional police personnel have been deployed in the area to avert any further trouble as a tense situtaion is prevailing in

the area, said the police official.

# Five get life term in two districts

Tribunals in Chapainawabganj and Joypurhat yesterday sentenced a total of five people to life imprisonment in separate cases filed for abduction and murder.

A Chapainawabganj court yesterday sentenced two men to life imprisonment for abducting two boys for ransom in 2016. The convicts are Raju Malitha, 22, of Doulatpur upazila in Kushtia, and

Mohram Hossain, 33, of Chatmohar upazila in Pabna. Judge Shawkat Ali of Chapainawabganj Special Tribunal-2 also fined the

convicts Tk 50,000 each. In default, they are to suffer six months more in jail. According to the case statement, the convicts abducted Osman Ali, 13, and

his cousin Shahadat Ali, 12, from Khalsi Bazar in Nachole upazila on February 5, 2016 and demanded Tk 50,000 from their family members over phone. Shahadat managed to flee from the abductors and reach home safely

while kidnappers took Osman to Chatmohar in Pabna. On February 9, law enforcers arrested the two culprits and rescued Osman from Chatmohar Station area.

Away in Joypurhat, a court yesterday jailed three people for life in a case

for killing a night guard in Khetlal upazila in 2013. The lifers are Dilbar Hossain, 35, Mosharraf Hossain, 40, and Siddique

Hossain, 50, of Kosba village. Judge Begum Momotaz Parvin of Joypurhat District and Sessions Judge's

Court pronounced the verdict in presence of the convicts.

According to the prosecution, the convicts slit the thrat of Golam Rabbani, a night-guard of an irrigation pump at Shanipukur village, on July 3, 2013. Deceased's father Mofazzal Hossain filed a murder case with Khetlal



Police Station the following day.
