**CUMILLA MURDER CASE**  
**HC to decide on Khaleda's bail today**

The High Court will deliver its order today on a petition filed by BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia seeking bail in a murder case filed in Cumilla in 2015. The case was filed for killing eight persons and injuring 25-26 by setting a bus on fire in Chouddagram upazila on February 2, 2015. The bench of Justice AKM Asaduzzaman and Justice SM Mozibur Rahman set the date after concluding hearing on the petition yesterday. Khaleda Zia's lawyer Advocate AJ Mohammad Ali told the HC that his client's name was not mentioned in the first information report (FIR) and there is no specific allegation against her. Attorney General Mahubub Alam opposed the petition, saying there are specific allegations against Khaleda of provoking the torching of a bus, in which eight persons were killed and 25 injured.

**Withdraw plans to hike gas price: CPB**  
**Sit-in staged at Narayanganj**

The Communist Party of Bangladesh in Narayanganj yesterday protested the government's plans to hike gas price. At a sit-in at Central Shaheed Minar in the city's Chashara, party leaders also demanded that Wasa supply clean water to the city dwellers. During the two-hour programme, CPB Narayanganj district president Hafizul Islam said the government is "conspiring" to increase gas price in the name of a public hearing on March 11. He said gas price was increased several times earlier. However, people are not getting sufficient gas, he added. "If gas and electricity prices are increased again, people will suffer more. Because such a move will eventually

impact other issues like prices of essential commodities and house rent," said Hafizul Islam. The "decision" should be withdrawn immediately, he said, adding that otherwise, the masses will conduct a strong movement. Meanwhile, the speakers also said although water price has been increased, the city dwellers are getting dirty water. Abdul Hai Sharif, president of CPB city unit, and Sujoy Roy Chowdhury Biku, its general secretary, were present among others on the occasion. On Saturday, State Minister for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Nasrul Hamid said the government might raise gas prices, mainly for commercial and industrial consumers and for power plants.

**Man to die for triple murder**

A Dhaka court yesterday sentenced a 30-year-old man to death for killing his mother-in-law and two others in the city's Chawkbazar. Judge Farhana Ferdous of the Eighth Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court of Dhaka handed down the sentence in presence of the convict, Md Al Islam Jibon. The victims are: Jibon's mother-in-law Rasheda Begum, 60; her daughter Seema Akhter, 30; and her granddaughter Shraboni Akhter Bonna, 23. According to the prosecution, Jibon's wife Sumi Akhter had died, leaving their son Sunny and daughter Jui in Rasheda's custody. Jibon wanted to have custody of his children. When his in-laws did not agree, the matter went to court. The court had given Rasheda custody of the children, but Jibon had been trying to take them back. Jibon went to Rasheda's home around 2pm on July 4, 2016 and asked his mother-in-law to let his children go with him. When Rasheda declined, Jibon picked up a sharp weapon and started hacking her haphazardly. He also hacked Rasheda's daughter Seema Akhter and granddaughter Bonna, when they tried to stop him. Rasheda died on the spot, while the two others were declared dead after being rushed to DMCH.

**POST-BREXIT**  
**Outgoing UK envoy assures of continued trade preferences**

Outgoing British High Commissioner Alison Blake reassured that Bangladesh would continue to enjoy European Union's Everything But Arms (EBA) like trade preferences until an even better deal is being worked out between the two countries. She made the assurance on the Bangladesh foreign minister AK Abdul Momen's reference to post-Brexit trade preferences for Bangladesh, when she paid a farewell call on the minister at the foreign ministry yesterday morning. The high commissioner presented her letters of credence to the president on January 19, 2016 and is scheduled to depart the country on March 7, after end of her tour of duty. Highly appreciating Alison Blake's dedicated and hard work to further strengthen and broaden bilateral relations between the two countries, Foreign Minister Momen sought her continued support to encourage more investment by UK companies in Bangladesh. Referring to more than half a million

strong British-Bangladeshis in the UK, he further urged the high commissioner to make UK visa processing easier, said a foreign ministry press release. The foreign minister also thanked the British envoy for playing the pivotal role in mobilising a strong UK leadership at the global level for finding a sustainable and peaceful solution to the Rohingya crisis. High Commissioner Blake also called on State Minister for Foreign Affairs Md Shahrar Alam and thanked him for all the support during her tenure in Bangladesh. They exchanged views on current political relations including high number of incoming visits from the UK over the past few years, Rohingya crisis, countering terrorism and upcoming Cricket World Cup in the UK. Meanwhile, Foreign Secretary Md Shahidul Haque hosted a farewell lunch in honour of the outgoing British High Commissioner at the State Guest House Padma yesterday, where senior government officials, members of the diplomatic corps and business leaders were present.

**ATROCITIES ON ROHINGYA**  
**Int'l Criminal Court team arrives today**

A team of International Criminal Court (ICC) arrives today for a week-long visit for "preliminary investigation" into forced deportations of hundreds of thousands of Rohingya Muslims from Myanmar into Bangladesh. Chief ICC Prosecutor Fatou Bensouda is leading the seven-member team, which will visit Rohingya camps in Cox's Bazar and speak with refugees. The delegation will also call on Law Minister Anisul Huq, Home Minister Asaduzzaman Khan Kamal, State Minister for Foreign Affairs Md Shahrar Alam and Foreign Secretary Md Shahidul Haque. The Dhaka Power Distribution Company Ltd. (DPDC) invites applications from eligible candidates from the bona fide citizens of Bangladesh for immediate appointment for the position of Medical Officer on contractual basis for an initial period of maximum three (03) years at a time (inclusive of 01 year probationary period). The contractual appointment may be renewed every three (03) years up to the age of 60 years subject to satisfactory performance. Brief job description and job specification of the post including other relevant information are as under.

**1.0 Medical Officer: Number of post 01**  
The Medical Officer is the entry level position of the company, primarily engaged in examining patients, making diagnoses and prescribing medication or other appropriate treatment, and to conduct clinics, surgeries, field rounds and house calls. He/ She is also responsible to meet emergencies and other critical incidents, oversees the work of subordinate medical staff to ensure the determination and maintenance of high standards of health care in the company, arranges, provides relevant training, issues medical and death certificates, produces reports on health standards and services in the company, supervises the functions of health facilities, ensures proper administration and control in the office, including financial control, ordering and supply, and condition of stocks and equipment, assist in formulating medical policy, instructions and guidance. Ensures plans and policies are implemented and maintained, coordinate with govt. body and other offices regarding Medicare related issues etc.; reporting to the Senior Medical Officer. - Must have strong communication skill in Bengali & English (written & oral) including working experience using computer.
