Teen, 2 women found dead

At least 15 people were injured in a clash between two rival groups of Awami League (AL) at Debtala village in Shailakupa upazila of the district yesterday morning.

Of the injured, Rabiul Islam, vice president of the upazila unit of Jubo League, Sohrab Malita, Ayub Malita, Kuddus Malita, Lutfor Malita, Sazzad Hossain, Tukun Hossain and Rezaul Hsossain were admitted to the upazila health complex while the rest given first aid.

Police and locals said there was a longstanding conflict between former union parishad chairman Shamsuzzaman Panna Khan and Zila Parishad member Monowar Hossain Malita over establishing supremacy in the area. Both are the local AL leaders of the village. As a sequel to the conflict, the men of Panna and

Monowar attacked each other with lethal weapons around 10:00am yesterday, leaving at least 15 people from both sides injured.

Of the injured, eight are supporters of Monowar and the rest are the men of Panna, said Officer in charge Kazi Ayubur Rahman of Shailakupa Police Station.

On information, police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control, said the OC.

Additional police personnel have been deployed in the area to avert any further trouble, said the police official.

UPAZILA POLLS VIOLENCE IN PATGRAM

Rivals torch 10 motorbikes, injure six

At least ten motorcycles were torched on Tuesday night during a clash between rivalling supporters of candidates contesting upazila parishad election in Patgram upazila.

Six people were also injured in the clash that took place at Burimari Bazar on Lalmonirhat-Burimari highway.

The injured were given primary treatment at Patgram Upazila Health Complex, said Officer-in-Charge Sajjad Hossain of Patgram Police Station. The clash was between supporters of

Awami League-nominated candidate Ruhul Amin Babu and his opponent Wazedul Islam Shaheen, a dissident in the same party, police and locals said. The supporters of the AL candidate first launched an attack against their opponent's

supporters. They vandalised and set fire to six motorcycles. The supporters of the opponent soon regrouped and also torched four motorcycles. Protesting the attack, Wazedul's supporters

later blockaded Lalmonirhat-Burimari highway for almost an hour till 11:00pm when they were dispersed by police. Wazedul, also an executive member of AL's

Patgram upazila unit, said "My supporters and

I are facing obstructions while campaigning

attack on them by their opponents on Tuesday night. for the polls in the upazila as the supporters of the AL candidate are always creating unnecessary obstacles."

Rebutting the accusations, AL candidate Ruhul Amin said it was the known criminals of the upazila who are ruining a peaceful atmosphere by campaigning for the rival candidate and issuing threats on his supporters.

OC Sajjad of Patgram Police Station said,

the situation in the area was brought under control by bringing in reinforcements and as of yesterday afternoon, no one filed any case regarding the clash.


