

300 illegal structures demolished

Roads and Highways Department (RHD) demolished over 300 illegal structures on both sides of Dhaka-Aricha Highway in Manikganj yesterday.

Earlier, the department identified 2,000 illegal establishments in deferent areas including Manikganj Bus Station, Baniajuri, Mahadepur, Baragail and Paturia ferry terminal, said Md Emdad Hossain, executive engineer of Manikganj RHD.

All the illegal structures will be gradually demolished in the ongoing drive, he said.

Estate and Law Officer of Dhaka Zone Roads and Highways Department Md Mahbubur Rahman Farooqi led the eviction drive at Manikganj Bus Stand in the town.

Md Emdad Hossain, executive engineer of Manikganj RHD, its Sub-Divisional Engineer Abdur Rahim and Sub-Assistant Engineer Shahrukh Rashid were present along with policemen and members of Rapid Action Battalion.

United for benevolence

Underprivileged people benefit as youths at Magura's Mohammadpur contribute to welfare activities

The 65-year-old Rahima Khatun, who became visually impaired due to cataract a few years ago, has got back her eyesight, thanks to the initiative of a local platform meant for social welfare.

"I had lost all hope as I could not arrange proper treatment due to financial crisis. Finally, a group of youths came to my help and arranged my cataract operation. Now, I have got back my eyesight," said Rahima, a resident of Bezra village under Nahata union in Magura's Mohammadpur upazila.

She is one of the many beneficiaries of Nahata Union Development Society (NUDS), a platform of local youths, formed in May 2015.

The organization works against social menaces like drug abuse, stalking and child marriage and extend help for continuation of

schooling of poor students.

"My father was unable to buy books for me. When brothers of NUDS came to know about it, they bought books worth around Tk 2,000 for me," said Toma Parvin, a student of Nahata Girls' Ideal School and College.

Members of NUDS often engage in various social works like distribution of winter clothes, arranging blood donation programme, cultural programme, sports programme, treatment of poor people and campaign against deforestation.

They have set up a library with around 1,000 books, where 100 to 150 people, especially students, come for study every day, said locals.

"Currently, the organization has 301 members, mostly present and former students of different universities. They donate Tk 150 to 2,000 per month to run the organization," said

NUDS president Md Ashaduzzamaan, a former student of Dhaka University, who now serves as education and research officer at Marine Academy in Chattogram.

"Recently we have awarded scholarship to 20 students who achieved good results in JSC and SSC examinations. We have also arranged free coaching for Class X students," said Md Rezaul Karim Suruj, general secretary of NUDS.

In 2018, the NUDS arranged treatment for 1,600 eye patients, gave blankets to 470 poor people and distributed 600 saplings among the students, said NUDS joint secretary Md Sahjan Mia.

Appreciating the initiative, Mohammadpur Upazila Nirbahi Officer Asifur Rahman said the upazila administration would extend cooperation with any organisation involved in socio-cultural development in the area.

Farmer killed in Jamalpur

A farmer was found murdered at Rekhirpara village in Melandah upazila of the district on Monday night.

The deceased was Bulu Mandol, 35, son of late Abdul Hai of the village.

Quoting the victim's family members, Officer-in-Charge of Melandah Police Station Gazi Sakhawat Hossain said Bulu went out of his house around 6:30pm. He was found murdered near the house around 8:15pm.

Informed by locals, police recovered the body and sent it to Jamalpur General Hospital for autopsy, said the OC, adding that the farmer died from severe head injuries as a gang hit him with sharp weapons.

They are trying to arrest the criminals and find out the reason behind the killing, said the police official.

Sirajganj AL leader hacked

A local Awami League (AL) leader was hacked over a disputed land in Shialkhole area of Sirajganj Sadar upazila on Monday night.

The victim is Md Aminul Islam, 45, of Chak Shialkhole village and vice president of ward no 1 unit AL of Shialkhole union. He is now undergoing treatment at Sirajganj General Hospital.

Officer in Charge of Sadar Police Station Mohammed Daud said Aminul had longstanding conflict with Amir Hossain of the village over a piece of land.

The men of Amir attacked Aminul around 7:00pm when he was crossing LGED mor in the area, said the OC quoting locals.

The attackers then hacked Aminul, leaving him seriously injured, said the police official.

Locals later rescued the victim and sent him to Sirajganj General Hospital.

A case was filed in connection with the incident, said the OC.

RAPE OF SUNAMGANJ TEENAGER

Main accused among 2 held

Sunamganj police on Monday detained two people, including the key accused, in connection with a case for raping a teenage girl in Sadar upazila about eight months ago.

Following a case filed by the victim's mother with South Sunamganj Police Station against seven to eight people on Sunday, police detained Abdur Nur, 60, and his nephew Kabir Ahmed, 45, from their house.

The medical report says the 14-year-old girl, now eight-month pregnant, is expected to give birth to a child on April 5.

According to the case statement, the fifth grader victim, who left her study last year due to the family's financial crisis, was alone at home as her parents were out of home for work.

Sensing her parents' absence, Nur entered the house and raped the girl on a number of occasions and threatened her not to disclose the matter to anyone else.

Four months after the incident, when the girl was facing various health complications she disclosed the matter to her mother, who informed the village leaders.

The village leaders later arranged an arbitration and fined Nur Tk 50,000. They also told Nur to marry the victim within the next one and a half months.

Nur instantly gave Tk 20,000 to the victim's family, but he did not pay the rest of the amount and refused to marry the girl. Lastly, the girl's mother filed the case on Sunday.

Police produced the arrestees before a Sunamganj court yesterday that sent them to jail, OC of South Sunamganj Police Station Ikhtiar Uddin said.
