

48 abandoned gold bars recovered at Dhaka airport

Customs Intelligence officials recovered 48 abandoned gold bars, weighing over 15 kilogrammes, at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka in the early hours of yesterday.

The bars, wrapped in sticky tape in nine packets, were left in a trash bin at a washroom in boarding bridge area, said Shahidul Islam, director general of Customs Intelligence and Investigation Department (CIID).

However, no one was arrested in this connection, he added.

CIID officials said smugglers sometimes left gold in this manner to avoid arrest. Many with security passes work as their agents and take the gold out of the airport.

The director general of CIID said they are investigating yesterday's incident.

and district administration several times. They do take action but the tobacco sellers somehow find their way back again and again."

"The police force has to handle numerous other issues which are more concerning. Given the situation, it is difficult to prioritise this issue," Chattogram Metropolitan Police Commissioner Mahbubur Rahman told The Daily Star.

About the Bita study, he said, "The findings are alarming. We will take action as per the law. I will alert my team."

Chattogram Civil Surgeon Azizur Rahman Siddiqui said hospitals and clinics had been directed through circulars not to allow consumption or sale of tobacco within 100 yards of their premises.

"But we do not have the power to execute the law. I will request the deputy secretary to issue a directive," he told this correspondent.

Md Elias Hossen, deputy secretary of Chattogram district administration, said he had been notified about the Bita study. "Due steps would be taken," he said, adding, "Containing sale of tobacco inside the metropolitan is quite a challenge because it is a densely populated area."

Established in 1994, Bita focuses on human rights, cultural expansion and poverty alleviation.

Strategic Studies (BISS), said tax is an effective tool to reduce the usage of tobacco, and it has been proven by many studies.

"Price of tobacco products is increasing around the world due to higher taxes. But compared to people's purchasing power, the price in Bangladesh doesn't increase," he added.

In a keynote paper, Mahfuz proposed to the government to reduce cigarette's price level from four to two [high and low], remove price division among bidi with or without filters, and revoke tariff value system on smokeless tobacco products, like

jorda and gul.

He also proposed to impose a specific supplementary tax on all tobacco products and reduce the price gap between low and high category cigarette.

AAMS Arefin Siddique, former vice-chancellor of Dhaka University, said the increase of tobacco products' price is a must to protect the youths from its grasp.

Nazneen Ahmed, senior research fellow of Bangladesh Institute of Development Studies; Nasiruddin Ahmed, former chairman of NBR; ABM Jubair, executive director of Progga; and Mortuza Haider Liton, convener of ATMA, also spoke at the press conference.

the flammable objects.

The issue of relocation of chemical warehouses came to forefront once again after the February 20 inferno in Chawkbazar that claimed the lives of 71 people.

The fire -- that originated from a perfume factory on Haji Wahed Mansion -- forced the authorities to form a taskforce comprising 14 government agencies, to carry out drives. A section of traders had been protesting and creating obstacles to a number of drives.

At yesterday's programme, President of Dhaka South City Businessperson Oikya Parishad Abdus Salam demanded that the

taskforce discontinue its drives in Old Dhaka.

"We are requesting to stop the drives of taskforce... Businesspersons live in constant fear," he said just before the Rab DG's speech.

He claimed that traders of Old Dhaka have already relocated the 35 chemical items listed as highly flammable.

Dhaka South City Corporation Chief Executive Officer Mostafizur Rahman said businessmen have to be aware, and their warehouses have to be relocated to stop recurrence of incidents like Chawkbazar.

Top Rab officials and leaders of different business associations in Old Dhaka were also present at the programme.

Through the programme, Montu said, they will also protest the fresh proposal for raising gas tariffs.

He urged the people of all walks of life, including students, to participate in the programme.

Non-MPO teachers continue demo for fourth day

Teachers and employees of non-MPO educational institutions gathered in front of Jatiya Press Club for the fourth consecutive day yesterday, demanding enlistment into the Monthly Pay Order.

They took position in the area since Wednesday, demanding intervention of the prime minister in this regard, said a press release.

Leaders of "Non-MPO Educational Institution Teachers and Employees Federation" said their appeal is logical and humanitarian, and they believe that the PM is their only hope.

About seven demonstrators fell sick yesterday, and had to receive primary medical treatment.

Besides, Soyelen Chandro Mojumder, 50, who suffered a stroke during the demonstration on Thursday, is taking treatment at the CCU of National Heart Foundation Hospital.

Earlier on June 25, 2018, teachers and employees of non-MPO educational institutions started a hunger strike demanding enlistment of their institutions under the MPO facility.

On July 11, they called off their hunger strike after getting government assurance of their demand being fulfilled.

As their demand remained unfulfilled in the last eight months, they again started their programme on Wednesday.


