Haji Abdul Haque is the current "mutawally" (caretaker) of the charitable trust, but an influential person took the land from another successor, said a shop owner who purchased a possession at the building decades ago.

Abdul Haque did not respond to repeated calls made by this correspondent.

Locals and the owner of a shop at the building said the shop owners, who were forced to leave the building around two months back, were not properly compensated.

Taimur Islam, chief executive of USC, said this two-storey building was built in the late 19th century or early 20th century, following neoclassical architectural style.

This building is called "Jahaj Bari" for its triangular shape resembling a boat, he said. The nearly 100-ft long building was built as a trading centre. It has a long veranda covering the whole length of the building. Pointed arches with decorative floral motifs on top covers the whole facade of the building. With decorative cornice and extensive surface decoration, especially the two bay panels at the western end embellished with extensive decoration in neo-classical tradition, drop festoon motifs, along with cartouches makes it a very unique building.

Just for its aesthetic value this building should be preserved, Taimur added.

### Second JS session to begin on April 24

Duration of the second session is likely to be a short one, sources at the parliament secretariat told The Daily Star.

The budget session is likely to begin after Eid-ul-Fitr vacation as the finance minister is set to place the national budget of 2019-20 fiscal on June 13.

The maiden session of the 11th parliament was prorogued on March 12.

The press briefing was held after a group of students brought out a procession on campus, demanding action against the attackers.

Earlier at 9am, the protesting students led by Nur went to the Vice-chancellor's office to place their demands.

Following a meeting, VC Prof Md Akhtaruzzaman assured them of proper steps regarding the attack on Nur after investigation.

He also advised students to resolve problems through talks, and remain vigilant so that no one can make the

situation on campus unstable.

Meanwhile, Ducsu assistant general secretary and BCL's DU unit general secretary Saddam Hussain at Madhur Canteen yesterday claimed that the female protesters were not harassed at SM Hall; rather there was an effort to taint the image of Chhatra League by "staging drama".

Nur was attacked on Tuesday when he went to SM Hall to submit a memorandum, protesting assault of a resident student, Farid Hasan, by some BCL men.

The BCL men also threw eggs at Nur and Akhtar Hossen, social welfare secretary of Ducsu, and harassed other protesters, including Shamsunnahar Hall union VP Sheikh Tasnim Afroze Emi.

Farid, a master's student of Urdu department, was beaten up allegedly by some BCL men on Monday night over contesting the SM Hall union polls.

Meanwhile, the SM Hall authorities yesterday formed a four-member probe body to investigate into Nur's assault.

The committee, headed by SM Hall house tutor Prof Shabbir Ahmad, was asked to submit a report within a short time, Prof Ahmad told The Daily Star.

For yesterday's meeting, the committee invited 41 editors but none of them attended the meeting.

Asked, Shajahan said they had sent invitation letters to the editors' email addresses and even called them over telephone.

"Why don't you operate the entire city's transport system with BRTC buses? There are hundreds of bus owners who operate their buses in Mohammadpur area; they will face losses," he said.

Osman Ali, general secretary of Bangladesh Road Transport Workers' Federation, agreed with Enayetullah, sources confirmed.

Enayetullah said they are already facing difficulties to convince bus owners to operate under bus franchise system. "If the area [of the circular service] is expanded, they might be

reluctant to come under bus franchise system."

After Enayetullah's objection, the proposal was postponed.

"... At the moment, let's limit it to Dhanmondi 27. After further study, we'll think about extension," said Khokon.

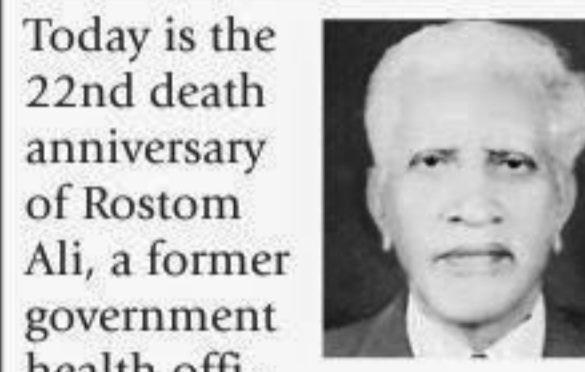
The BRTC chairman then told the meeting that they are planning to launch two more circular bus services in the capital's Motijheel and Uttara areas.

Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC) Mayor Atiqul Islam said he will sit with local councillors to discuss how to make the circular bus services more viable in Uttara.

Following the meeting, Khokon in a press briefing said circular bus service in Motijheel will be launched in the last week of this month and in Uttara in the first week of May.

Khokon said it will take two more years to make the bus route franchise system work.

Asked about the decision later, Mohammadpur resident and guardian of a student, Hasibur Rahman, said, "There are several schools, colleges and universities in Mohammadpur. Students would be benefitted."

pills inside their stomachs.

"The woman might have died from swallowing the packets," the OC suspected.

Police is trying to identify her.

Zanea Alam said several people took the woman to National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases (NICVD) on Monday afternoon but fled after doctors declared her dead. On information, police rushed to the hospital, prepared an inquest report on the body, and sent it to the morgue for autopsy.

Doctors informed police after recovering the contraband pills from her stomach during post-mortem, he added.

Police is analysing CCTV footage of the NICVD to trace those who brought the woman to the hospital.
