

Ctg fire dept marking risky buildings

The department of Fire Service and Civil Defence has begun marking buildings in the port city that are vulnerable to fire emergencies, putting cautionary notices in front of the establishments.

They put banners in front of Riyajuddin Bazar and Tama Kumundi Lane market under Kotwali Police Station yesterday.

Fire department also requested people in the areas to take maximum precautions while living and going into those buildings.

On Saturday, the department officials put notices on four other risky high-rises -- Karnaphuli Tower at Kajir Dewri, Mahal Market at Anderkilla, and Jahur Hawkers' Market and Municipal Hawkers' Market at Kotwali.

"We are currently putting banners in front of risky buildings that do not have proper safety measures. Later, we will conduct mobile courts with magistrates of the district administration," said Jashim Uddin, deputy assistant director (DAD) of the department.

"If the owners of the buildings do not take necessary steps to ensure safety, they will be fined and sent to jail," said Jashim.

Some buildings might be sealed off after necessary warning, the deputy assistant director added.

Purna Chandra Mutsuddi, another deputy assistant director at the department informed that high-rises up to six-storeys should have two-tiered and over six-storey high-rises must have a three-tiered safety system.

The three-tiered safety system constitutes at least one fire extinguisher weighing

minimum five kilogrammes within each 550 square feet area; a hose-reel for every 10,000 square feet area; an overhead water tank connected with the hose-reels; and fire hydrants/risers connected with the tank.

Moreover, there should be an underground reservoir with at least 500 gallons of water connected with one electric pump, one diesel-run pump, and a jockey pump, said Purna Chandra.

All these pumps must remain active all the time, he added.

The two-tiered safety system requires one fire extinguisher in every 1,000 square feet area, and hose-reels at every floor and automatic sprinklers on the ceiling of every floor.

He also informed that all readymade garment factories and 30 percent of other industrial buildings in Chattogram have this safety system, while only three percent of residential high-rises in the city have it.

Among the hotels, only Radisson Blu Chattogram Bay View, Hotel Agrabad, and Hotel Peninsula maintain the system, said Purna Chandra.

They will be conducting drives in Chandgaon Residential area, and Jolsha Market in New Market area today, he added.

Meanwhile, a team of Chittagong Development Authority led by special magistrate Mohammad Saiful Alam Chowdhury also conducted a drive at Tama Kumundi Lane market yesterday to identify risky establishments.

Officials of the Chittagong Development Authority informed that all 18 residential areas and industrial factories of the port city would be inspected for proper fire safety.

Stop land acquisition at Jhilongja Mouja: SC

The Supreme Court (SC) yesterday directed the government to immediately stop acquisition of land at the hills and hillocks of Jhilongja Mouja in Cox's Bazar over a residential project for officials and staff of Bangladesh Power Development Board (BPDB).

A four-member bench of the Appellate Division of the SC headed by Chief Justice Syed Mahmud Hossain passed the order after hearing a leave to appeal petition filed by Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (BELA) against a High Court order.

The apex court also allowed BELA to move an appeal before it, challenging the HC directive.

Following a writ petition, the HC on April 5 last year directed the Department of Environment (DoE) to examine through a committee the construction of structures in the acquisitioned area and to ensure that

hills and hillocks are not cut.

The HC also ruled that DoE can allow construction of structures in the area in accordance with relevant laws and subject to approval from a high-powered committee on the environmental impact assessment if it (DoE) feels the construction is indispensable for the national interest.

BELA recently filed the leave to appeal petition against the HC order saying that hills or hillocks are on 3.98 acres of land out of total 4 acres proposed for acquisition in Jhilongja Mouja.

The respondents of the SC directive are secretaries to the ministries of land and forests and environment; director general of DoE; chairman of BPDB; deputy commissioner and superintendent of police in Cox's Bazar; upazila nirbahi officer of Cox's Bazar sadar; its executive engineer of power distribution department; assistant director of DoE in Cox's Bazar; mayor of Cox's Bazar municipality;

BNP's hunger strike for Khaleda's release

BNP yesterday observed a six-hour token hunger strike in Dhaka, demanding its Chairperson Khaleda Zia's release from jail and proper treatment.

The programme began at the auditorium of Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh at 10:30am.

Leaders and activists of BNP and its associate bodies joined the hunger strike amid tight security.

BNP senior leaders, including its Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir, addressed the programme.

Last Tuesday, the party announced the event from a milad mahfil held at its Nayapaltan central office.

Khaleda Zia was admitted to Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University (BSMMU) last Monday with severe pain in the joints, insomnia and high sugar level.

She has been in jail since February 8 last year when she was convicted of corruption. She was later found guilty in another corruption case.

Her release remains BNP's main demand and the party has been accusing the government of neglecting her treatment.

Man shot dead in port city

A man was shot dead allegedly by his rivals in port city's Bakalia area early yesterday.

The deceased is Lokman Rahman Rony, 35, of Moulvibazar. He was a tea vendor in Golpahar intersection, said Additional Deputy Commissioner (South) Shah Md Abdur Rauf of Chattogram Metropolitan Police.

The incident took place in Bakalia's Fultola area around 1:30am, he added.

There had been a longstanding rivalry between one Joy and Anik. On Saturday night, Anik and his accomplices intercepted Joy in the area. Joy then phoned Lokman to rescue him. When Lokman and five others arrived there, an altercation ensued between the groups.

At one point, one Saiful, an accomplice of Anik, opened fire.

Lokman was hit by a bullet, said the ADC. He was declared dead at Chittagong Medical College Hospital.

OC Pranab Chowdhury of Bakalia Police Station said Saiful and his men went into hiding. Police are trying to arrest them.

Saiful is accused in several cases, said ADC Rauf.

The body was sent for autopsy. A case was filed, accusing eight persons, with Bakalia Police Station.

Return to normal life

CEC urges people involved with criminal activities in hills

Chief Election Commissioner KM Nurul Huda yesterday urged those involved with criminal activities and terrorism in hills, to return to normal life.

"Killing of seven people in Baghaichhari was a tragic incident. The Election Commission remains alert to resist recurrence of such incidents. Security during elections will be tightened in future," he said.

The CEC made the remarks while talking to journalists at Baghaichhari Upazila Complex in Rangamati.

Prior to that, Huda attended a meeting with upazila administration officials. He was also chief guest at an event where financial assistances were given to family members of the deceased and injured in the Baghaichhari incident.

On March 18, seven people, including two polling officials and four Ansar personnel, were shot dead and 23 others injured in Noymla area of the upazila. They were returning to the upazila headquarters after discharging election duties.

At yesterday's event, the CEC gave Tk 5.5 lakh each to the deceased families, Tk 1 lakh each to 10 seriously injured and Tk 50,000 each to 40 other injured.

Huda said, "Many militants and criminals have returned to normal lives. Many are facing trial. Come back and cooperate with the government in building a prosperous country."

"No one can bring peace with arms. Perpetrators behind Baghaichhari killings will be brought to trial, no matter how powerful they are," he said.

Rangamati DC AKM Mamunur Rashid chaired the event, where GOC of 24th Infantry Division Maj Gen Matiuir Rahman, EC Secretary Helaluddin Ahmed and DIG of police (Chattogram Range) Khandaker Golam Faruq also spoke.
